Elaboration of meaning

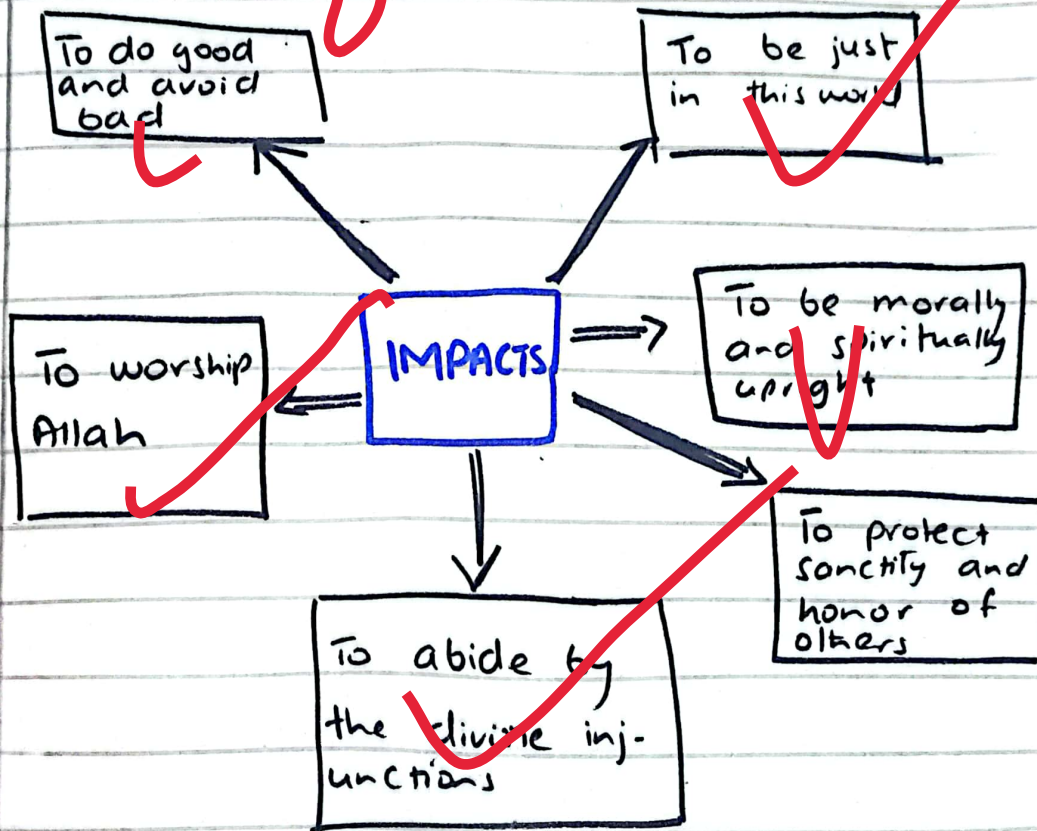

5. To worship Allah and abide by injunctions of Islam

Allah in Quran has obligated upon man to worship him in the ways mentioned in Quran and practices of Holy Prophet P.B.U.T. The purpose is not superficial, its purpose is to keep one's self away from sin and bad deeds. Imam Gazali said, "fast does not mean only to control on food and water but to control oneself from evil thinking, evil looking, evil listening, and evil taking." Those who worship Allah will stay away from evil and eventually would be rewarded by Allah.

Al-Baqarah - 43

Zakat and sadkat is one of the five pillars of Islam. In Quran Allah Pak has ordered to give Zakat Allah says, "

"واقبوا الصلوة والتواذكرون"

"And be steadfast in prayers, practice regular charity."

Furthermore, a Japanese scholar of comparative philosophy, Sachiko Murata said, "Just as ablution purifies body and Salat purifies soul, so Zakat purifies possession and makes them pleasing to God."

Zakat and charity has both temporal and spiritual benefits. Some of these impacts are as following:

1-Impact on social life

i- Alleviation of poverty

The concept of system of Zakat is wholistic with major aim of circulation of wealth from those whom Allah has given to those who does not have enough. This pose tests for both classes which Allah will reward; for the wealth belongs to Allah.

Allah says in Quran, Surah Ath-Nur

"And bestow upon them from The wealth of God which He

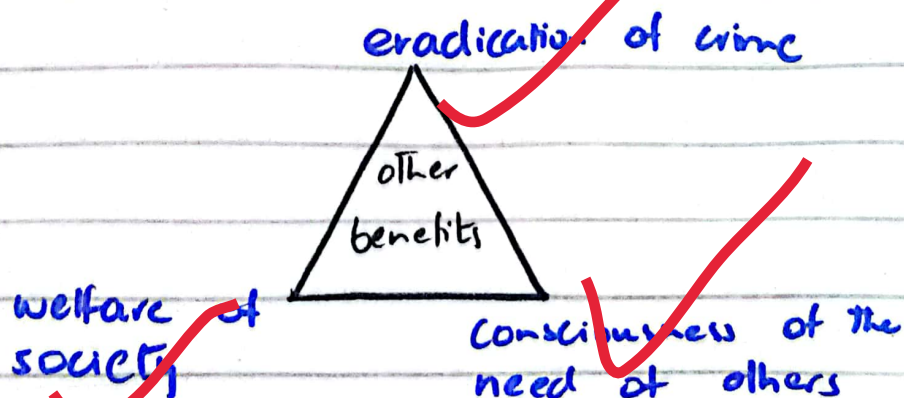
bestowed upon you."

The reason is quite simple, it is that helping others and sharing ones wealth with the beneficiaries of zakat gives an internal satisfaction and contentment which develops a sense of brotherhood. Hence, those who seek satisfaction in life shall share their possessions and wealth with the needy.

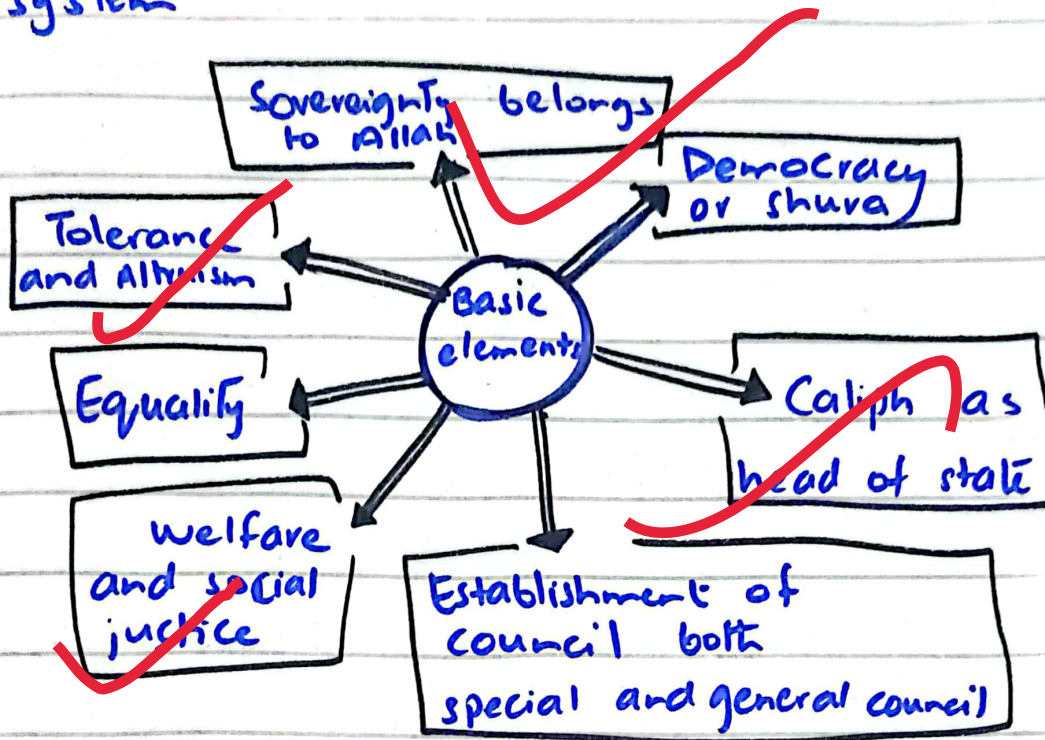
Political system of Islam guarantees

Ways in which Political system of Islam guarantees prosperity of state and society

1 - Accountability and justice

The political system of Islam emphasized on the importance of accountability and justice. Holy Prophet PBUH set example by accountability when he said, "By Him in whose hand is my life, even if Fatima daughter of Muhammad were to commit theft, I would have cut off her hand." Islamic political system did not favor selective justice. Hence, if this principle is applied in society then the accountability and justice would bring more prosperity.

2. Welfare of society

Political system of Islam provides principles for the welfare of people of state. It means that state would work efficiently to provide a peaceful environment in order to aid and support marginal sections of society. Zakat system for this matter is well-integrated part of political system of Islam.

An advanced state of intellectual, cultural, material development in human society marked by progress in art and sciences, including writing and appearance of complex political and social institutions.

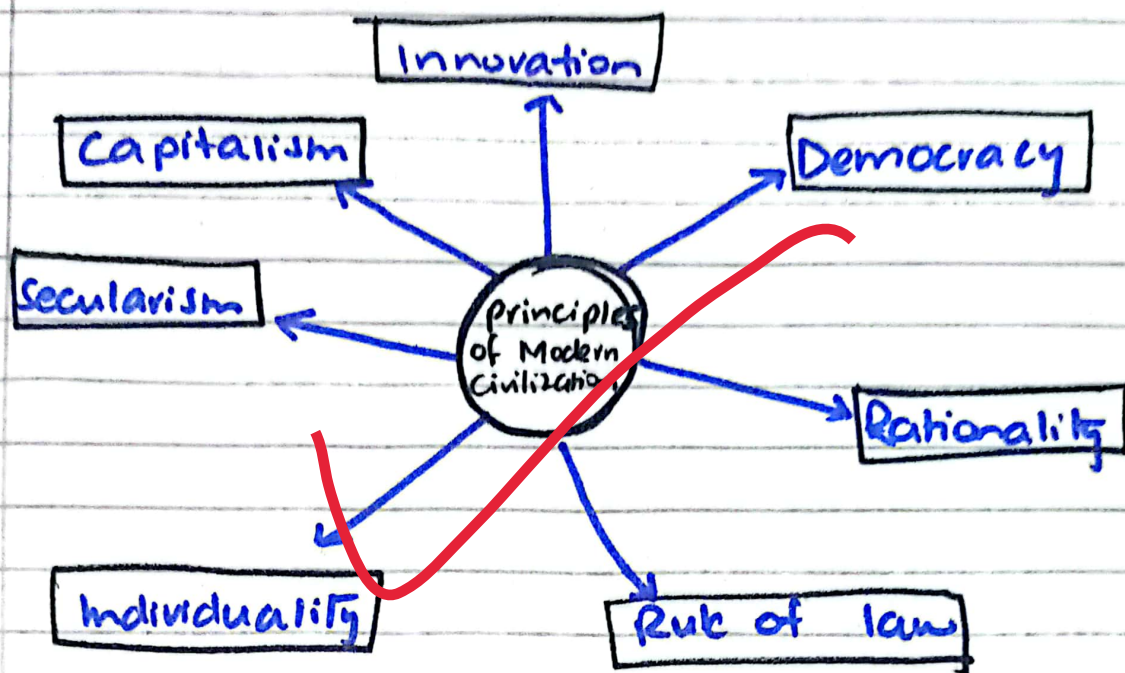
Will Durant defined civilization as

Effects of Modern Civilization on Muslim Ummah

1- Materialistic Approach

Modern civilization has affected Muslim Ummah by inculcating materialistic approach. Muslim Ummah has lost the vigour of spiritual gains and has become indulged in worldly gains. As a result, the Ummah has gone astray - from the direction towards righteousness. The materialistic approach is quite evident amidst Gazan catastrophe, more than 20,000 Gazans have lost life with the building razed to ground whereas Muslim Ummah, the torch bearer of courage, have not taken enough measures. Instead, they are engaged in more materialistic gains that are linked with western powers.

2- Individualism and selfishness

Individualism underscores importance of personal autonomy and protection of personal rights. It does not regard collective approach to be progressive. The concept of individualism leads to a selfish pursuit of success with personal growth and autonomy. This contradicts to Islamic civilization which emphasizes not only on individuality but also on collective benefits which is fundamental to the concept of muslim Ummah. Holy Prophet said, "Muslims are like a body, when one part aches the entire body is in unrest."

3- Minimizing role of family unit

Family unit plays an important role in muslim civilization as it lays down the foundation of muslim society. A strong family unit is vital for a healthy society. Modern civilization on contrary does not give regard to family unit. Dysfunctioning of family has a negative impact on the culture and generation. Despite, economic prowess and development, the social building is on a downward trajectory. This principle of less regard to family has been adopted by Muslim Ummah.
