ANSWER #3:

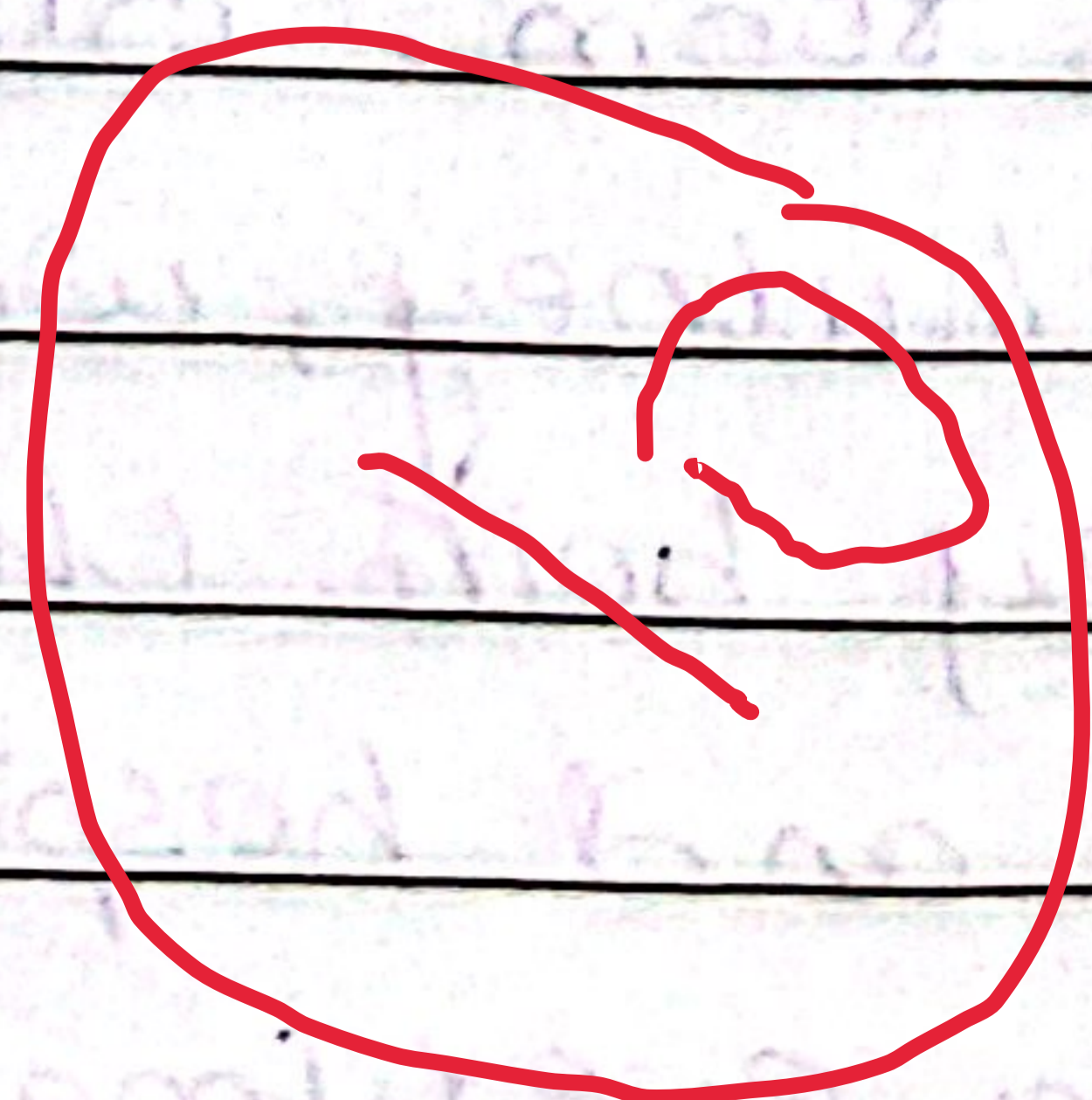
