(Question: 2)

How congress ministries and rigidity of congress -----

Introduction:-

After winning the election, Congress ministries started atrocities on the Muslims of Sub-continent. They even deny the right of separate electorate of Muslims. The atrocities of Congress ministries and changing Muslims thoughts :-

Hindi became national language → Congress Flag was National Flag

→ Bande Matram became the national anthem → Prohibition on cow slaughter

→ Construction of new mosque banned → Harassment of Muslims during prayers

→ Wardha Education scheme was introduced → Policy of discrimination

(i) **Hindi became national language:-**

Congress declared Hindi a national language after winning elections.

Whereas on that time, sub-continent have many nations and they spoke different languages, but because in congress, most of the leaders were Hindus, so they believed that Hindi should be national language of whole sub-continent. Due to this step, they showed muslims that this is the state of Hindus only.

(ii) **Congress Flag = National Flag:-**

One form of congress atrocities was, they made congress flag national flag of the sub-continent. Muslims supported ^{All} India Muslim league, but this harsh step of congress forced them to accept Indian National congress is the only national platform of the sub-continent.

National Anthem converted into Bande Matram :-

Bande Matram was declared national anthem by congress ministries. Congress wanted to change Muslim's identity due to this step. They even spread Indian nationalism from these steps. This behavior of Hindus impacted on Muslims, and they started think about Iqbal's dream / vision.

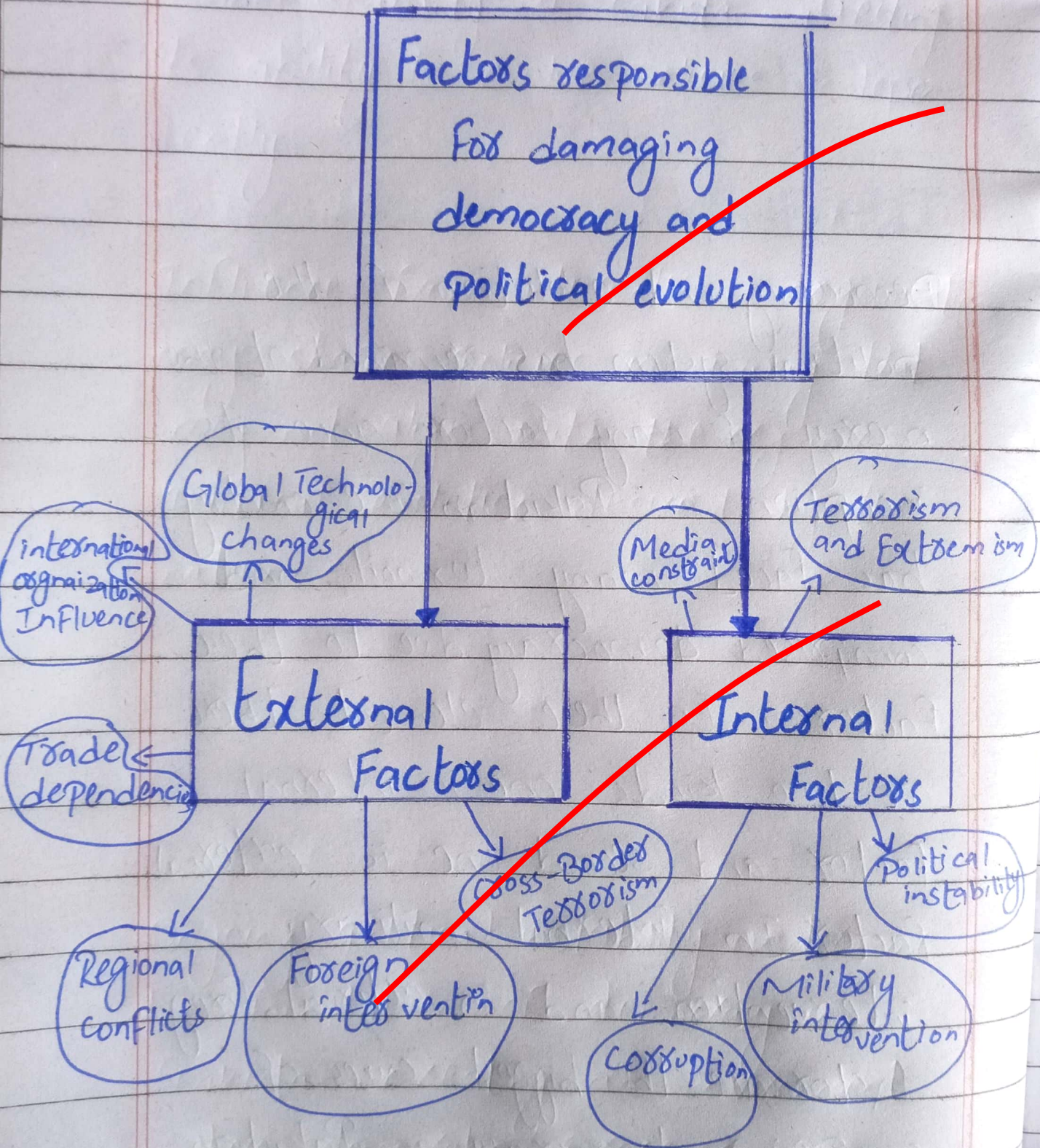

Evolution of the political system and democracy-----

External Factors:-

(i) Foreign Intervention:-

External powers exerting influence on Pakistan's political landscape can compromise the country's ability to independently determine its political evolution.

(ii) Regional conflicts:-

Proximity to conflict-prone regions can divert political focus and resources away from domestic development, hindering the evolution of a stable political environment.

(iii) Cross-Border Terrorism:-

Terrorism emanating from neighbouring countries can destabilize internal politics, diverting attention from long-term political evolution to immediate security concerns.

(iv) Trade Dependencies :-

High dependencies on specific trading partners may limit the political maneuverability of Pakistan, affecting its ability to evolve policies independently.

(v) International organizations' Influence :-

Influence from international organizations may shape policies in a way that may not align with the organic political evolution desired by the nation.

Internal Factors :-

(i) Political instability :-

Ongoing political instability undermines the foundation of democracy in Pakistan, creating an environment where democratic processes are often disrupted.

(ii) Military ^{to} interventions:-

Historical instances of military coups and interventions have disrupted the democratic order, affecting the stability and continuity of democratic governance.
