### 3- Religious Extremism

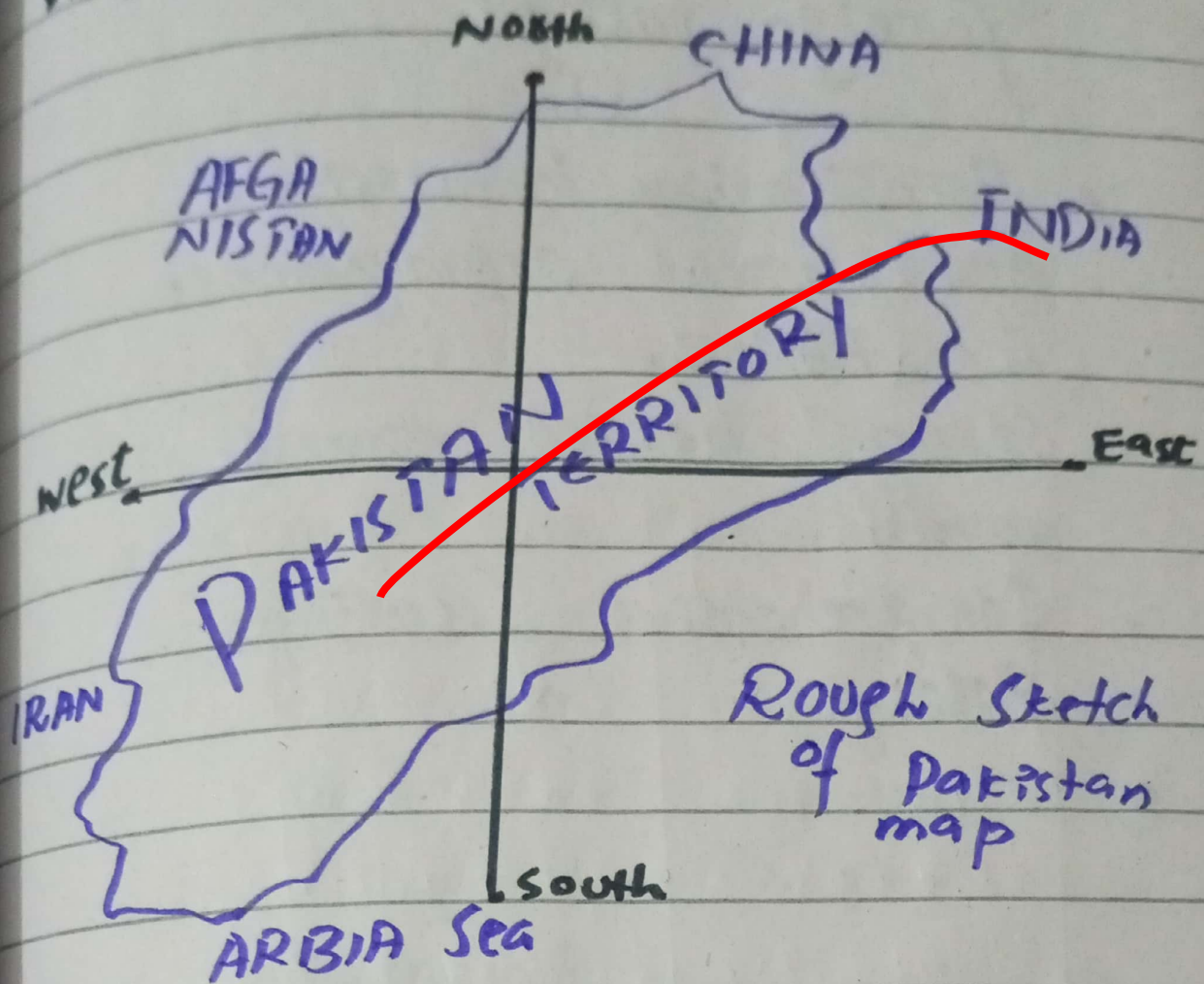
Pakistan is a muslim country. Most of the

## Conclusion

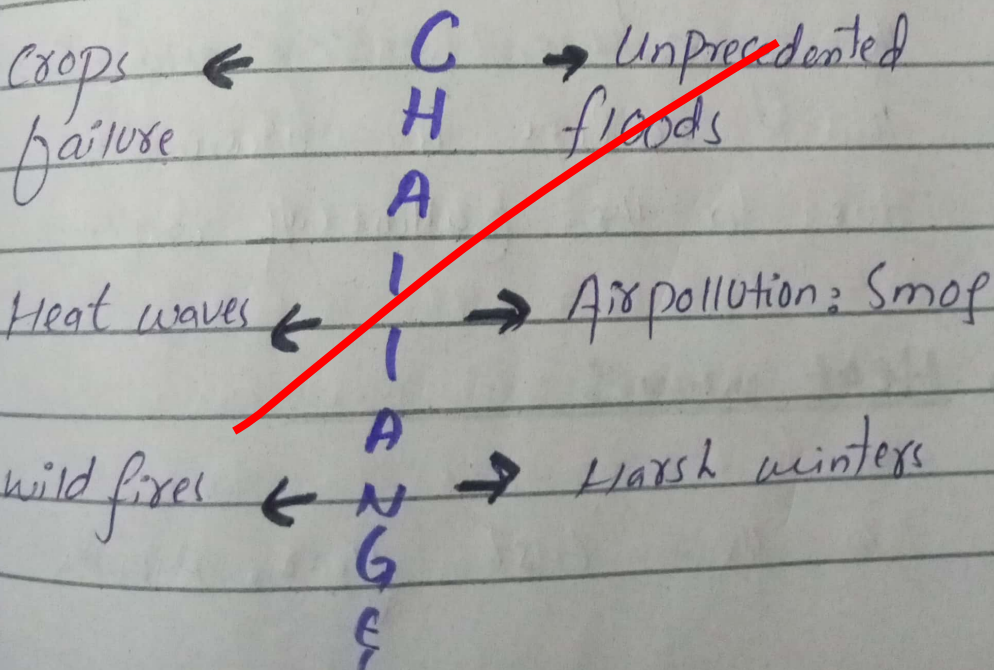
