Human rights in the context of farewell sermon of prophet (S.A.W).

Introduction:-

Human rights are the fundamental, instinctive and natural rights, given to all men by birth. They are non-violable and are equally given to all human beings of all the times without any discrimination of color, cast, creed or race. In all societies of the world, in all nations irrespective of geographical and territorial boundaries, men of the world, regardless of gender can enjoy those rights. Since Almighty is the creator of this universe, thus these rights are granted by Almighty. Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) - the last messenger of Allah has conveyed these rights to humanity.

Historical Context:-

Since the time known, men are ill treated by some

conflicting, opposing or dominating people who maltreat other fellow human beings and deprive them of their rights. There are many instances in history where people were unable to enjoy their rights.

ﷺ As a Prophet of Peace:-

Nazrat Muhammad (P.B.U.H) came as a prophet of peace, love for humanity, affection and equality to all and gave the message of peace and equality to all.

End of discrimination:-

Nazrat Muhammad (P.B.U.H) ended the concept of discrimination and awarded the status of equality to all in the light of Quran and Sunnah.

Khutba Hajja-lul-Wida of Prophet Muhammad (P.B.U.H) :-

On His last pilgrimage to the house of Allah on 632 / 10 AH, Holy Prophet (S.A.W) delivered His farewell Sermon and delivered the

“Foremost charter of Human History”

He addressed a large gathering and instructed them about their religion

إِيَّاكُمْ أَسْمَعُونِي، خَاتِمُ الْأَدْبَرِ

لَعْنِ الظَّالِمِينَ بَعْدَ عَامِ حِزَايْرَا

لَهُوَقْفٌ أَبَدٌ

O People! Listen to me; what I say. I don't know whether I will ever meet you at this place after this year.

In his last sermon major area of focus of prophet was human rights in all aspects. Fundamental, equal and basic rights were discussed and instructed.

Human Rights:

(1) Right to sanctity of life and property, wedlock and parentage:

Right of life and property of every human being is valuable and should be protected by all in any condition.

"^{لَيْسَ الْحُرْمَةُ بِالْأَنْوَارِ}
Your blood and your property are as sacred as are this Day."

(2) Riba was abolished;

Riba in all of its forms and conditions was banned. Actually, the philosophy behind the abolishment of Riba is that it promotes exploitation and accumulation of wealth.

"^{وَالْفَرِصُ لِلْكُفَّارِ}
Usury is forbidden"

(3) Rights of wives is protected:

Women of ancient days of ignorance were maltreated. They were given honourable and respectable place.

"^{وَالْمُنْتَهَىُ مَعَ الْجِنَاحِ}
O People! fear Allah concerning Women"

(4) Killing each other is prohibited :-

As life of each and every individual is prohibited and protected by Divinity, violation of this protection is will be a great sin and the killer will be punished on the Day of judgement.

فَلَا تُرْجِعُوهُنَّا مِنْ حَيَاةٍ - جَنَّةٌ لِّلَّذِي

So, do not turn into people who go astray and kill one another.

(5) Right to equality and brotherhood of Muslims:

Equality of human beings before law and in the face of Islam is ensured. No discriminatory treatment is allowed. and all muslims are just like

“ اَوْلَوْمَعْ ” “ اَوْلَوْمَعْ ”
like united ; United Ummat
body ”

At another place prophet said
“ Every muslim is the brother of another muslim and that all muslims are brethren ”

(6) Equality of all races was proclaimed.

Prophet (S.A.W) elaborated the concept of Quran, which states that all human beings are equal and there is no any discrimination on the basis of cast, creed or race. In the same way Prophet Muhammad (P.B.U.H) mentioned in his farewell sermon as;

الْفَضْلُ لِلْعَرَبِ إِلَيْهِ عَجَمٌ وَالْأَسْعَادُ عَوْنَوْنَ

The Arabs are not superior to the Ajamis (non-Arabs), or the Ajamis to the Arabs.

(7) Right of slaves to kind treatment:

Slaves are human beings and they demand the just treatment by the owner. Maltreatment of slaves is prohibited and they are instructed to be equally on humanitarian grounds.

"And your slave, see that you feed them with the same food as you eat yourselves,"

(B) Right to inheritance:

Inheritance is a due share from property, given to the individual justly as per his/her due right. Islam has fixed due share of every individual in the property rights and Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) commanded all individuals to grant share of each in the property.

God has ordained to every man the share of his inheritance: a testament is not lawful to the prejudice of heirs.

(C) Burden of crime is onto the criminal:

It was customary in Arabs that replacement was offered in place of crime. In this way, they used to save and protect the actual criminal by giving an alternate innocent person to be killed or women were given to the affected party. Prophet (S.A.W) abandoned this custom and affirmed that the penalty of crime will lie on the criminal and none else will be punished.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Any wrong doer does not wrong another except himself.

(10) Observation of religious duties was made mandatory:

Observance of duties was made mandatory. Because, the fact is obligation or duty of one person is the right of some other person. Thus if a man fulfill his duty, rights of others will be met.

Conclusion

Khuuba Hajja-tul-wida or the farewell sermon of prophet (P.B.UH) is the foremost and perfect charter of human rights. Many countries reproducing human rights came later but none of them was so perfect, authentic and complete as was this charter. It granted human being all encompassing and complete rights that human being gained its true grandeur and peace forever.

Question - 2

Islamic Civilization has a unique identity. Elaborate its characteristics.

Introduction

Islamic civilization is the most ancient, complete and on all encompassing civilization of the world. It emerged with the birth and landing on earth of Adam and Eve. It is the most constant and persistent civilization. Due to its dynamic nature it will be the last civilization on earth. Perfection, beauty and completeness of Islamic civilization lies in its Divine nature and natural basis. It provides an umbrella to the blooming Islamic thoughts and cultures and refine them by springing waters of purity, flawlessness basis and completeness.

Islamic Civilization:

A civilization is a complex society, culture or group

having its unique political system of government, education system, moral belief, language and art and culture.

According to will Durant:

"Civilization is a social order promoting cultural creation"

Terminology of Civilization is derived from Latin word Civil which means a city or citizen.

Islamic civilization has all the characteristics of a superb civilization.

Difference between Islamic and Western civilizations is that Islamic Civilization endorse Islamic and Divine perspective of culture, government, people, language, art and architecture.

Features of Islamic Civilization:

Islamic civilization is shaped by many prominent factors that influence its basis;

(1) Tauheed - as basis of Islamic Civilization:-

Tauheed is the fundamental and basic principle of Islamic civilization. It is the basic tenet and fundamental principle of Islam. The philosophy behind tauheed as a basic tenet of Islamic civilization is that it provides unity and authenticity. Tauheed is the basic component due to which the universe is surviving.

لَوْلَا كُلُّ أَنْجِلٍ لَّا يُؤْمِنُ بِهِ

If there would be "more than one God", there would be anarchy in the universe.


Islamic civilization is sustaining on the same pattern. Israel is maintaining its dignity and stature because of the principle of unity.

(2) Ehsan - Prevalent feature

Concept of Ehsan is elaborated in the following verse:-

"That you worship Allah as if you are seeing him; and if you are not seeing him, then He is seeing you"

Reward of Ehsan:

The idea of the reward of Ehsan is elaborated in the following verse:

أَفَلَا يَرَوْنَ أَنَّ اللَّهَ يَعْلَمُ مَا يَعْمَلُونَ

Is there any reward for Ehsan except Ehsan?

Commandment of Almighty:

سُرِّعْ لِلْجَنَاحَيْنِ
Surely, Allah enjoins the
doing of justice and the
doing of good.

Being the fundamental pillar
of Islamic civilization, it
urges people to do their to
maintain a unique and
perfect civilization.

(3) Tazkiyah al-Nafs is mandatory:-

Tazkiyah-al-Nafs is the
Purification of Soul. Residents
and people of Islamic
civilization are motivated
to attain

“Tazkiyah al-Nafs
Purification of soul”

Tazkiyah in human personality

“To beautify it, and
to remove from it
all evil traces and
spiritual diseases
that are obstacles in
experiencing Allah's
closeness”

Commandment of Almighty:

هُوَ الْفَلِحُ مَنْ زَكَّاهُ وَمَنْ خَابَ مِنْ دُسُّهَا -

He who purifies it will indeed be successful, and he who corrupts it is sure to fail "

Tazriyah is a source of Forgiveness:

يَوْمَ الْقِيَامَةِ لَا يُنْفَعُ الْمَالُ وَالْبَنُونَ - لِمَنْ أتَى اللَّهَ بِإِيمَانٍ

On the Day of judgement, neither wealth nor children will be of any benefit, only he who comes with a sound heart before Allah.

Stages of Self-Purification -

There are 3-stages of self-purification in the light of Holy Quran.

① Nafs-al-Ammarah

نَفْسُ الرَّاغِبَةِ

② Nafs-al-Lauwamah

نَفْسُ الْمَأْمُودَةِ

③ Nafs-al-Mutmainnah

نَفْسُ الْمُطَمِّنَةِ

Why Self-Purification is needed:

Self-purification and purification is very important to attain a sacred place in heaven.

Our Prophet (P.B.U.H) has reaffirmed this concept of self-purification as;

الْأَنْجَلِيُّونَ
The attachment to this
world is the source
of every wrong.

Tasriyah in Islamic Civilization:

It is mandatory to live with a
clean and pure soul in
Islamic civilization so that its
criteria may be met and
harmony may sustain.

(4) Dignity of man is ensured in Islamic civilization:

Human being is the most
important and valued
creature of the universe as
is mentioned in the Holy
Qur'an;

- ﴿إِنَّا جَعَلْنَاكُمْ لِلنَّاسِ أَنْوَعَةً﴾

Verily, we made man
in the best possible
form.

It is the basic fact that
in Islamic civilization, honour
and dignity of man is
ensured and their equality
and grace is preserved in
all acts. Human being is the

The vicegerent of
Almighty,

عَزِيزٌ

Thus his dignity is preserved in Islamic civilization.

(5) Equality of all is ensured:

Islamic civilization provide equality to all men and women, regardless of color, creed and race. They are not discriminated on the ground of gender or social status. As Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) said:

الْأَفْلَقُ (١٢) إِنَّ الْجِنَّةِ وَالْأَرْضَ وَالْأَنْوَارَ

The Arabs are not superior to the Ajamis, nor the Ajamis to the Arabs nor the whites have any superiority over blacks but through piety.

(6) Social Justice is provided:

Oppression, tyranny and cruelty in any form is nevertheless allowed and social justice is provided to all people at all the times. As in the lesson of Holy Quran;

-سُبْرُ عَوْرَجَعَ

Do justice, for justice is close to piety,

(7) Tolerance is promoted:

Extremism, impatience and violence have become the new normal of the world.

But in Islamic Civilization, significant emphasis is laid upon the tolerance among the people of civilization. Several references are found in Quran:-

لَا كِرَاءٌ فِي الْدِينِ -

There is no compulsion in Islam.

- جو اپنے بیان کرنے والوں کے ساتھ
and argue with them
in good manner.

(B) Rule of law is the order;

Dominance and superiority of the rule of law is appreciated in Islamic civilization. And this order is actually the order of Allah and his messenger.

And whosoever disobeys
the commandments of
Allah and His prophet,
he has clearly wandered
into error.
