Democracy is the root of any country. If the country has a strong democracy then definitely the whole infrastructure of the country is smooth and well organized. Pakistan also needs a strong democracy so that it may be able to face all the serious problems which are leading the country towards darkness swiftly. Our neighbouring country China is a crystal clear example of democratic government, characterized by one party rule by Chinese Communist Party (CCP). Whereas Pakistan has a list of hundreds of political parties.

Bad governance is a hindrance in the solutions of the prolonged problems of the country. A state is run by Judiciary, Executive and parliament, if any of the major wing does not function appropriately then it is futile to expect a smooth balance from the government. The governance in Pakistan can be judged by its **GDP growth rate** as it was **3.3%** in 2019, **0.38%** in 2020, **5.97%** in 2021 similarly **0.29%** in 2022-23 but the target was of **4.5%**. How then a country can progress if the situation is like this.

A stable economy can combat the multi-pronged problems in Pakistan. The economy of a country manifests whether the state can alone stand or is dependent on the other states. Pakistan is in the complexity of economical situation for a long time period. **Even the Industry contracted this year**

is 2.94 per-cent compared to 6.38 percent growth last year. and similarly, the Agriculture growth shrank to 1.55 pc from 4.27 pc in last year.

This shows the economical condition of Pakistan is very fragile.

A stable politics can lessen the severe problems in the country. Politics is meant to be in the welfare of masses and Pakistan is facing problems in field of the politics. The large number of political parties has jumbled the real politics in Pakistan. Countries with well stabilized politics often have strong institutions, a transparent legal system and effective governance. Examples include like Canada, Germany, Switzerland which are known for their stable political environment, robust democratic system and well functioning institutions. But Pakistan is still deprived of some

robust political system.

In addition, boosting the literacy rate can be a valid solution in solving the attacking problems in Pakistan. The youth of any state bulges in the progress of the country. Pakistan can facilitate its youth as Pakistan has the 60% youth in its total population, who are below than the age of 25 years (according to the census of 2023). The literacy rate should be boosted which is now 62.5% among which male: 73% and female: 51% are literate. This number should be boosted as much as possible.

Elections, in Pakistan, can bring a strong democracy undoubtedly. All these bulging problems have the simple solution which is indeed elections. The occurrence of elections will bring the new government in the country which will be the result of the elected leaders.
