In Pakistan and other developing countries, resources are not being distributed equally among public which causes

lack of facilities and opportunities. People do not get opportunities to improve their lifestyle, by getting education, which causes unemployment and poverty. In Pakistan about 45% of population is uneducated because of decline in resources distribution.

Lack of resources and opportunities causes poor sense of self-care among people. Then they start labour work, rather than education. Their focus shifts from education towards getting income to meet their basic necessities. This is how poverty is caused by unequal distribution of resources.

Poverty as being a major barrier, for students to get education, is because of increase in population.

In Pakistan, according to World Bank, poverty has been recorded at 37.3%.

37.2% as of 2023. In 2019-20, more than 2 million people went below the

poverty line in Pakistan. Annual population growth rate in 2022 was about 1.9%. This

inclined population is leading poverty. Growth in population causes less availability of facilities for education such as transportation, books, infrastructure and skilled staff in schools. This is how population growth per year becomes the reason of poverty which challenges the education system of Pakistan.
