Winston Churchill said, "Democracy is the ^{other} worst form of government; except all the forms of governments that there have been." It means even the worst democracy is better than any other form of government. Best dictatorship is worse than worst democracy as dictatorship is based on suppression of fundamental rights and prohibition of dissent. Democracy ^{on the other hand} is based on protection of fundamental human rights. It promotes accountability of government, brings economic and social stability and ensures smooth transfer of power. However, certain weaknesses of democratic governments might make a way for military interventions. Democratic governments might be involved in corrupt practices. Inability to devise welfare policies and to provide equal opportunities to public might lead to civil unrest and ultimately to military intervention.
