The world is surrounded by myriads of harrowing challenges with climate change ranking on first position on that list. Climate change is having devastating impacts all across the globe that include floods, droughts, tropical storm, heatwaves and many more. These catastrophic effects are resulting in loss of life, property, livestock, agriculture, infrastructure etc. Climate change pose a threat of existential crisis all over the world. The world is being responsive toward this grim situation by holding many meetings all across the world with COP-28 being the recent one. One of the grim reality is that the lack of awareness is the major impediment in the way toward betterment. Tangible actions will only work if people are aware of the threat posed by climate change. Lack of awareness is the irksome factor which is rationale for the failure of our policy action towards climate change.

Peoples of globe are being subjected to the harrowing impacts of climate change. In 2023, Greece and Canada are being subjected to wild fire which caused danger to life and property. In September 2023, Libya became the victim of climate change with devastating floods.

In 2022, Pakistan faced catastrophic impact of climate crisis through floods. Pakistan

faced the loss of thirty billion dollars as per world Bank. In 2023, Pak again became the victim of floods in the southern part of Punjab. As per Provincial Disaster Management (PDM) of PA (August) Pakistan, August 2023 was the driest August in the history of Pakistan. Afghanistan has been the victim of droughts which leads to food insecurity in Afghanistan.

These harrowing impacts of climate change is contributed by many factors out of which fossil fuel emission is being the prime factor. Fossil fuel emission cause the release of carbon dioxide (CO_2), Sulphur dioxide SO_2 , and many other gases which is very dangerous for climate change as well as human health. Fossil fuel includes coal, diesel, gas, petrol. Energy sector, agriculture sector, industrial sector and transport sector is among the major consumers of fossil fuel. As per **Inter governmental panel of climate change (IPCC)**, energy sector sector is responsible for 35 percent (emission) emission from fossil fuel, agriculture sector is responsible for 25 percent emission from fossil fuel, Industrial sector is responsible for 21 percent and transport sector is responsible for 15 percent of emission by fossil fuel. Fossil fuel has been widely used all across the world in different sectors which leads toward the climate change crisis.

In addition to fossil fuel, one other factor which is responsible for the most of emission is the use of electric appliances which cause the release of chloro-fluoro-carbons. Such electric appliances include air-conditioners

and refrigerators. Chlоро-fluro-Carbons pose a grave impact on the climate change which contributes to irregular pattern of climate.

Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and UAE are among one of the major producers of carbons due to hot weather and vast tourism.

In addition to above factors, deforestation pose a great threat to climate change. As per **global (wato) Forest watch**, more than 10 millions of hectares have been deforested in last four years only. Forest are the major source of carbon sinks. They maintain the level of CO₂ in environment. But with increase deforestation, carbon sinks has been reduced due to which environmental pollution has been increased. As per **National Ocean and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA)** carbon dioxide level has been raised to 424 ppm. Deforestation leads toward depletion of carbon sinks and burning of forest lead toward further pollution and emission into the atmosphere.

Furthermore increase in population is another major factor which contributes to catastrophic climate impacts. Increase in population will leads toward increase deforestation, increase urbanization, increase consumption and emission of hazardous gases.

As per **US census Bureau**, in 1960, the global population was 3 billion which increased to 6 billion in 2000. In Nov, 2022 the population grew to 8 billion and currently it is more than 8 billion with prediction that it will be (60) increased.

to 9 billion in eight to ten years. As per "2023 (ests) census of Pakistan", the current population of Pakistan is 241.19 million with growth rate of 2.5%. It means we are adding 6 million people each year. In comparison to Denmark, Finland and Norway, their population is less than the number of people we are adding per year. India is the most populated country followed by China which clearly paints the picture as the population is the rationale behind their major contribution in global emission.

Moreover, another most important factor which is responsible for excessive emission is heavy traffic. People still use old model of car which is run by diesel. The diesel combustion by old model results in mass emission. Everyone uses personal cars and vehicles for transport rather than using public transport which results in excessive release of carbon. In the era of modernization where majority of countries are shifting towards electric vehicles, there are still many countries that are using cars that runs on diesel, petrol. Heavy traffic and (excessiv) private use of vehicles is one of the major factor responsible for climate disaster.
