

Q2. INTRODUCTION



THE UNIQUE IDENTITY



Unique Set of Ideas in Islamic


Civilization include the concept of an afterlife, a day of judgement, dual accountability, and divine punishments. These ideas are unique to Islamic civilization.

1. Political Organization in Islamic Civilization

In Islamic civilization, the head of state is also the leader of prayer. This is a unique feature of Islamic civilization.


iii. Elections
