Besides, in the era of General Zia-ul-Haq, value of local government increased in 1979. Three tier system such Tehsil Nazim, District Nazim and Divisional Nazim was introduced by General Zia. Last but not the least, in 2002, Gen Mushraff enhanced the system of local government and conducted election. However, local government is a sign of best dictatorship in the Pakistan.

Additionally, local government system has lost its value in civilian government. Civilian governments have failed various time to conduct local government election whereby poverty has increased at grassroot level. Firstly, from 1988

to 1999, there were not conducted local government election in which economic of the country decreased.

According to World Bank report from 1988 to 1999, Pakistan lost \$3 billion due to political instability and weak structure of local government. On the other hands, first time order was passed for conducting local government election in 2009. But, it was not conducted due to political instability and lack of budget. The biggest province of Pakistan, Punjab's local government election was held in 2019 during Imran Khan government. Therefore, democracy has failed to eradicate the problems at grass root level in Pakistan.

Furthermore, increasing agricultural growth in the country was a best initiative of Pakistani military leaders. Agricultural sector is a main sector which helps to boost the economic growth and enhance national and

international trade of the country.

The best dictatorship of the country helped to enhance the agricultural growth of the country. For instance, during the era of General Ayub Khan, green revolution was brought for strengthening agricultural sector.
