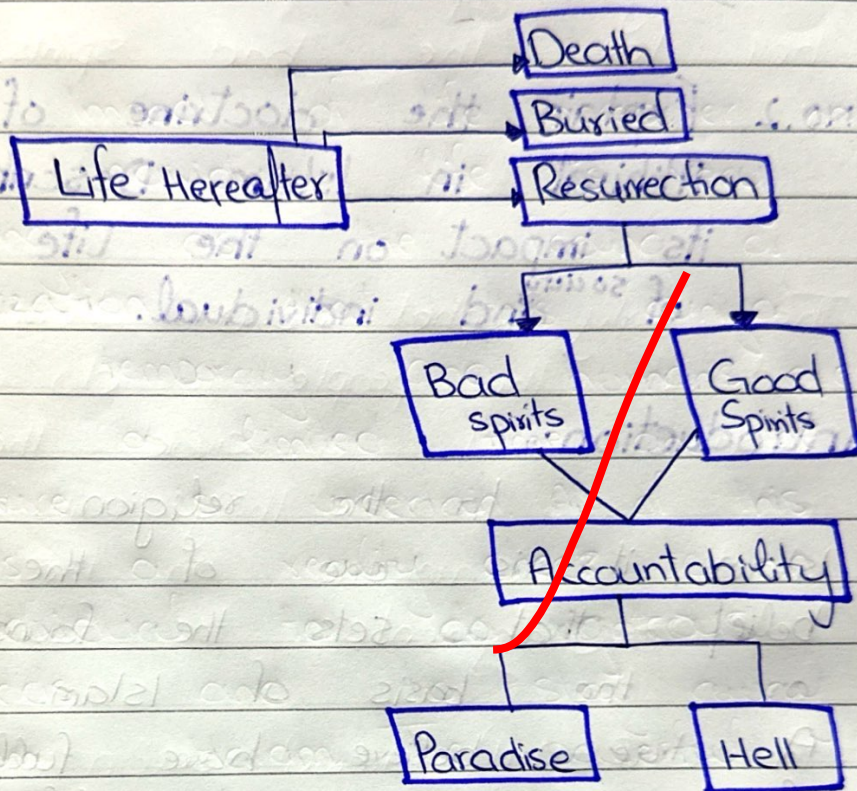

Qno.3 Describe the concept of character building through education in the light of teaching of Islam. How

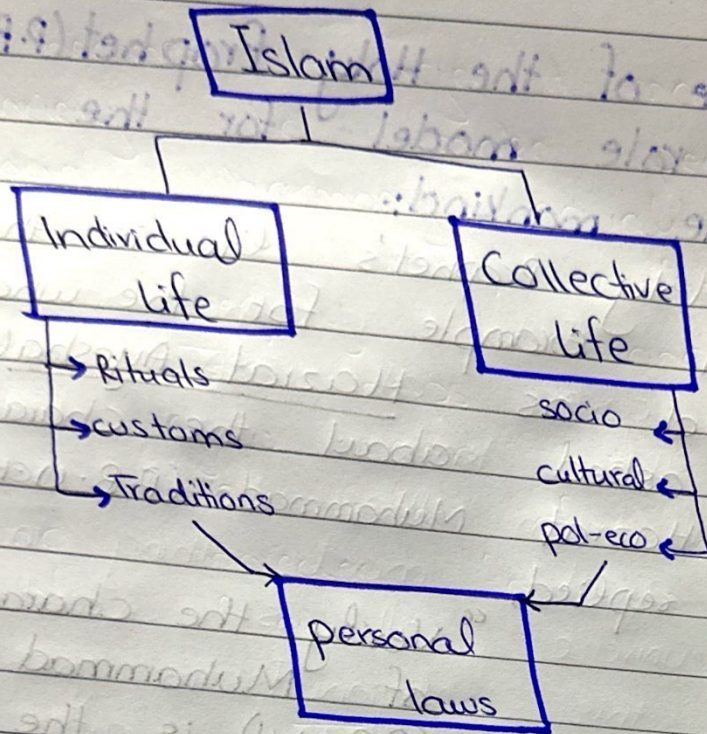

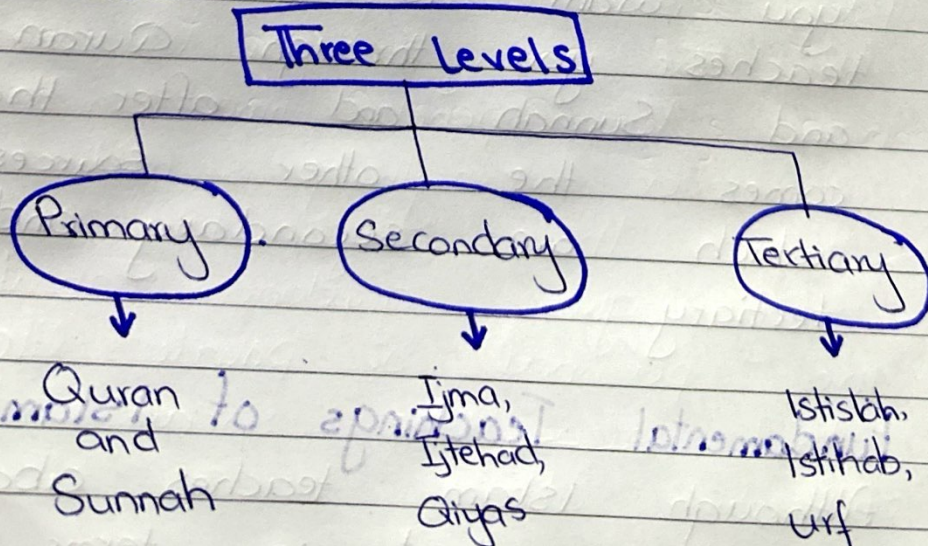
Islam: Complete Code of Life :-

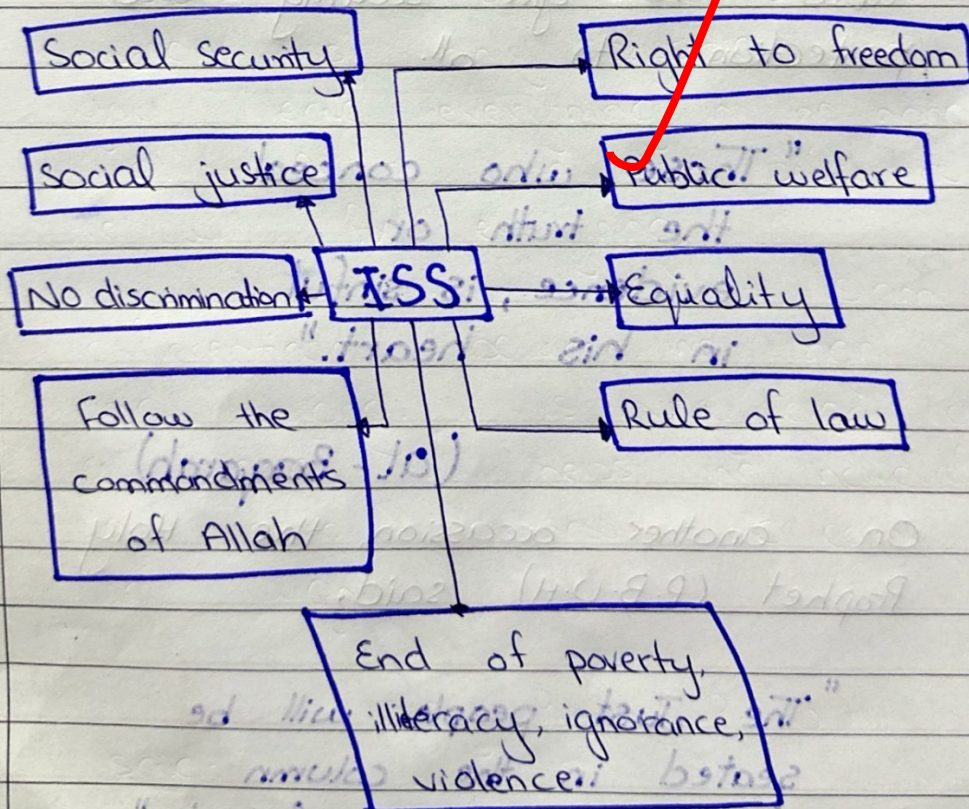
Write down the main principles and features of Islamic social system. How can we address the challenges and problems being faced by contemporary situation

"The Just people will be seated in the column of light in front of Allah."

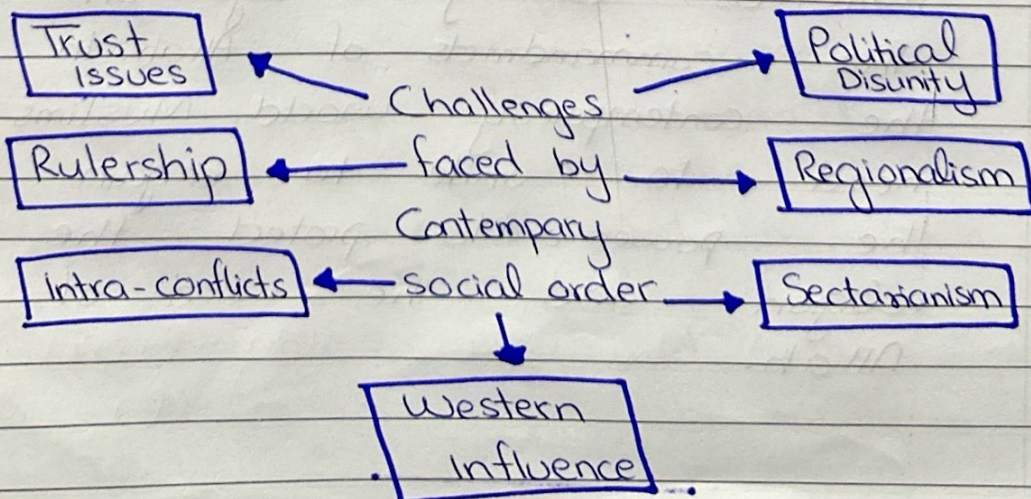
2. Equal treatment for everyone:

Describe the rights, role and status of women in Islam.

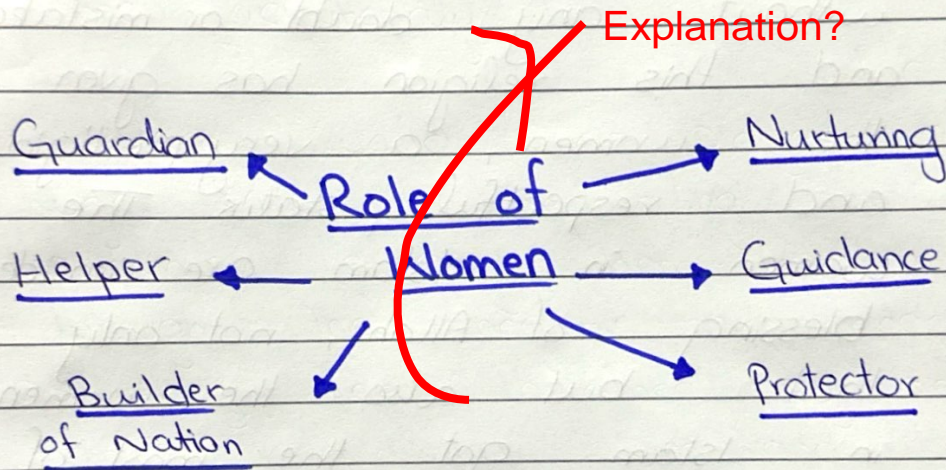
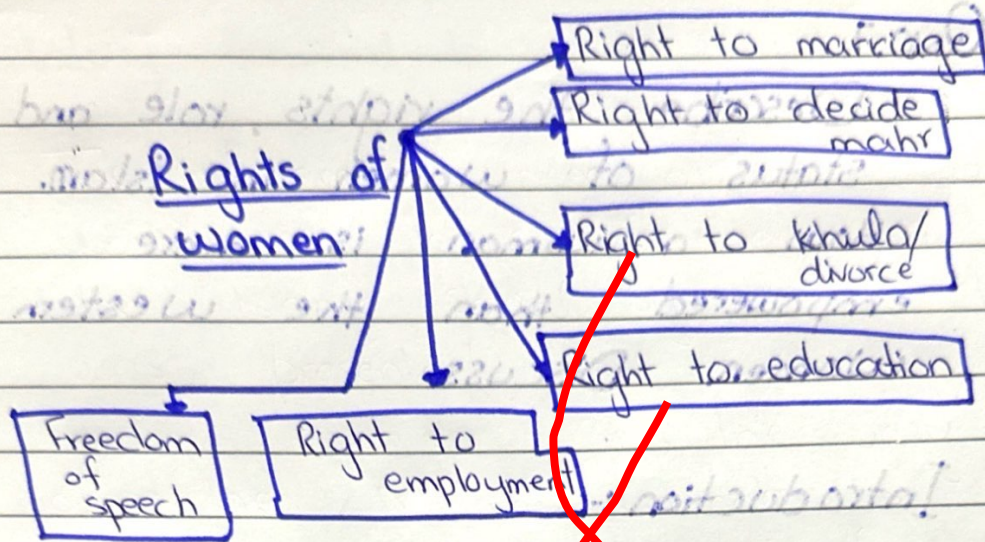
How a woman is more empowered than the western women. Discuss.
