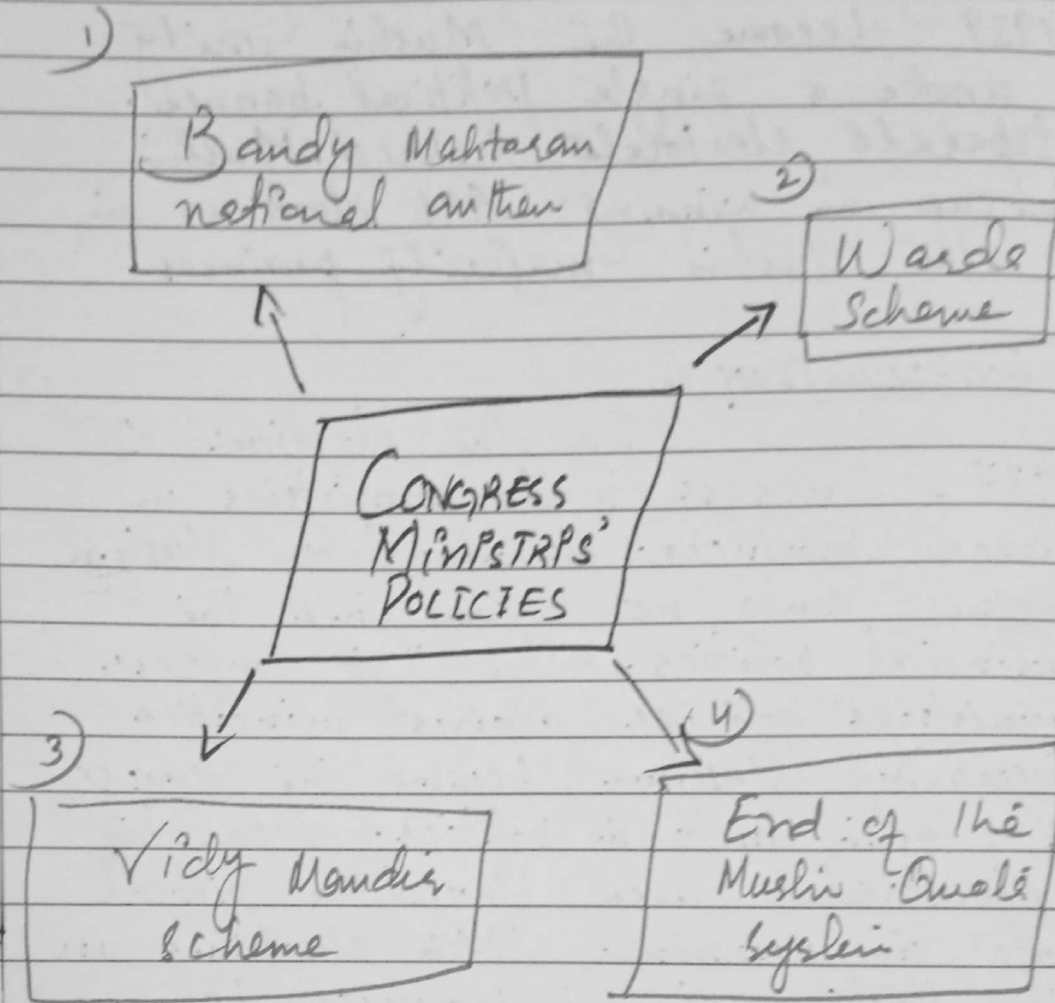
Ans: (1) INTRODUCTION &

(1) Bandy Mahtaram was declared the national anthem of united India.

Along with that Aligarh Movement also played an important and instrumental role in forming the political ideals of Muslims in the 20th century because it paved the way for Muslims to understand the British politics and gave the solution to the problems which Muslims of the subcontinent mainly confronted.

(2) INFLUENCE OF RELIGIOUS REFORMERS IN SHAPING MUSLIM IDENTITY IN UNITED INDIA :-

Sheikh Ahmed Sirhindi and Shah Waliullah were the religious reformers who shaped the Muslim identity in united India at the

Directors of Maghals - Muslims of that time were away from the true spirit of Islam. Bigg's and missionaries were trying to convert Muslims into the Hindus and Christians. Religious reformers played a vigorous role to reorient Muslim society and made conscious Muslims to know the true spirit of Islam.

(3) Aligarh Movement :-

Aligarh movement was started by Sir Syed Ali Khan which was based on the "Trinity of ideas".

Trinity of ideas

(1) Aloofness from politics :-
Sir Syed Ali Khan advised Muslims to remain aloof from politics until they learn the politics and western education.

(2) Loyal to British :-

He also advised to the Muslims of India to be faithful to the British as its allies will reduce and Hindus can not get chance to manipulate the situation.

(3) Get western education :-

As Muslims did not want to get western education due to the British atrocities and they considered it as blasphemy. So, Sir Syed wanted to persuade them that do not be emotional but rational.

(4) Aligarh Movement played an instrumental role in forming the political ideals of Muslims in the 20th Century :-

After Aligarh movement, the Muslims of Indian subcontinent came to know that they can win after the adoption of rational behavior which was the major objective of Aligarh movement.

(1) Simla Deputation 1905 :-

In 1905, the students of Aligarh college and Sir Agha Khan went to Simla for meeting the viceroy for the demand of separate electorates for the Muslims which was also demanded by Sir Syed in Aligarh movement.

(2) Lucknow Pact 1916 :-

Muslim League brought the demand of

(3) 14 Points of Jinnah: Jinnah also demanded separate electorate in his 14 points.

(4) In 1946 elections Muslim League got separate electorate.
