

The distance between the Centre and periphery area is increasing. This meens that the periphery areas are undeveloped, marginalized and do not have representation in the provincial assembly. To filfill this gap, creation of new provinces is required.

3. Empowering Local Governments

For smooth functioning between centre and province, local governments should be empowered. They must be given financial autonomy, a share in the revenue and powers to implement policies.
