The most worst forms of child labor include child trafficking, sexual exploitation, doing kofficking using children, debt bondage is bonded labor, forced labor, organizational child begging and slavery. Even though child labor is one of the major reason of various social problems, it is still negle ded.

There are various factors leading to the command neglect of childr. The foremost factor is Overpopulation and poverty associated to it. Over population results in demand of more good resources. These resources can not be provided by adult members of society alone so cheldren are competted to perform paid work; in order to meet the needs of family. UNICEF report suggests that "in world's poorest countries more than one in five children are an work. For anstance, in countries leke Somalia and Ethopia their is extreme poverty hence cheld labor cases are most commonly reported

in these countries. So, overfigulation and poverty streetly influences the child labor in society. Another major cause of the ignorance regarding child labor is the tate lack of implementation of laws and policies due to poor political and administrative structure. Bs Daren Acomuglu and James Robinson argue in their book "Why Nations Fails?" that there is a 19ble between extractive state institutions and the various social problems like unemployment, poverty and rnequalities etc. in the developing world The rise of so weal political and administrative structure of a state leagh to various problem including poverty which to creates a conducine environment for child labor. For example, Pakistan lags behind in The administrative and political reforms so there is for increase in social problems and Child labor is one of the symptoms of these social problem. Hence, flawed political and administrative structure leads to mayficient implementation of laws regarding child Labor.

Apple, Samsung and Microsoft claim that whenever they find an underage worker in their supply chain they ensure the safe return of that 4 child to their his home and glo fund his he education. But ironically the Armesty International uncovered a number of cases of child labor among suppliers linked to these companies. The report severale of that child labor is being used to make lithium-son batteries used in teach products ton So, the negligence by the gaint companies result in more cases of child labor.

Moreover, the consumers are also ignorant of the ethical information. The consumers are not aware of the practice of child labor in the mantificator manufacturing of a product or as a study conducted by University of Texas revealed that even if consumers have product's ethical information right in front of them (e.g. whether this made using child workers) they will still by buy that product As consumers continue to buy products ignorant of harsh reality of child labor, the manufactures and supplies continue to here child workers there are also supplies continue to here

regarding the practice of child labor in supply chain leads to the criminal neglect of child labor. The ignorance towards the issue of child labor yelld altre consequences. Firstly, it poses a serious threat to the physical and medial well-being of children. The cruel and borsh employers after influence the fung psychological healths of children. Moreover, the hard working conditions and expough exposure to harardous chemicals also affects their physical health. For instance, in 2016 Thomas Reuters Foundation revealed that in India from where majority of

Mica to product used in make up rems) comes, the deaths of children have been reported. As child there were involved in mining of Mica, that causes lung scaring and shortness of breath. Also the well-being these child is often not prioritized as They belong to lower class and cannot afford energy expensive healthcare facilities. So, cheld labor mental health of children.

Secondly, children are more prone to abo abuse in the guise of work. They are physically, sexually and emotionally asused by owners and co-workers. For enstance; in August, 2023, a gerl named Faterna was abused and killed. She way ten-years old and was working as dorner tic maid in havele of local fendal m. khaipur sindh, other cases in-cylde, Tayyaba Abuse: Case (dodo), and Rezwona Torture Case (2023) etc. All these cases of violence against minors are proof of the fut that child labor paves way for the physical and emotional abuse of children. Due to this abuse these children suffer from lasting physical and mental sceres and In extreme cases the tresult is death that is often not reported.

In case of children, they are forced into bonded lasor by family or society. Ac According to UNICEP, two-fith of two-third of all the working children in Pakistan tost in brick kilms". The owners force The innocent kids to production of bricks under inhuman conditions where they are exposed to all sorts of violence . Hence, bond-labor is increasing due to the normalization of child labor.

Furthermore, child labor exposes children to exportant activities. Children get involved in various ellegal crimes to earn more money. The International labour Ofganhation ruraled that children might get involved in illicit activities eng the production and trafficking of drugs. Children might do this against their will or with the belief that this will goe their status and money Children who are mulled in this act dre at increaced visle of abuse and drug addiction. These Relate it to the neglect, not just the labour shoplifting , buglary, pocket picking etc. etther willing or by threat and violence. The most significant organizations in Purijab Child Protection Bereau; Edhi homes; Pakistan Sweet Homep and Sos Village etc. But still Pakistan needs to further improve its child protection system in order to safe children from the clutches of poverty, insecurity, violence and child labor. Education, in addition to child protection system, & can be beneficial to deal with child labor. The Article 26 of the Universal Declaration of theman Rights states that "Everyone has the right to reducation". But statt stoday, many children are unable to afterd schools and acquire aducation due to child labor associated with poverty. Convernment and private sector should join hards to increase the unrollement rates

by offering free education and meentaves to children and families who attend school. Moreover, the effective implementation of laws and policies must be ensured in order to curl the child labor- Many nations across The globe have laws for child prote those against child latour, but they lack in implementation due to lack of sesources and stable at Administratino structures. For instance, Arts de 11.3 of the Constitution of Pakistan states "No child below the age of forteen years shall be engaged is any factory more or any other hazardous employment. But due to Frequent political upheavels these laws are seldom implemented in their enterity - As WAICH UNICEF esternates that about 3.3 million of Pakistani Children are trapped in child labor. So, effective and transperent implementation of laws is need of the hour to deal with itseld labor and the metaltions and personnels presponsible shall be held accountable in case of the violation of these laws particularly by remployers. In a mutshell, the metances of cheld labor are increasing across the world due to the poor socio-economic tod condition

There are number of the coursing causes of the criminal neglect of the child labor. The poor economic condition outpociated to overpopulation compel families to send their children to work - The lack of implementation of laws primarily due to the flawed political and administrations setup, result in the multiplication of the cases of child labor. Also the neglect on the part of Companies and Egnorance at the odby consumers' end regarding the presence of cheld labor in supply chain, also leads to the strengthing of child labor in society. The professed distinction between good and bind work ite. good work is work in domestic setting and bad work is the work in commercial setting, also leads to the increased child labour and exploitation in domestic settings. The enimand negelect of child labor results in the threat to the physical and mental of hearth of child. It also expose children to crimes and all forms of abuse and exploitation.
