Definition of 'public policy'

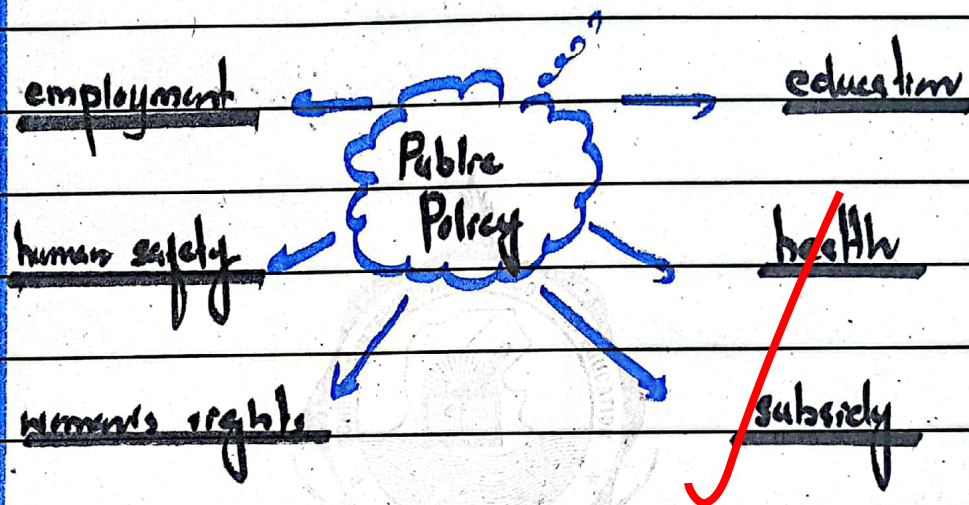
'The government's response to public demand,

3. Process of public policy making in Pakistan

Public policy making process in Pakistan goes under PM's authority with his cabinet members. Following are its evidences:

a) Identifying a problem

Identifying public problems is the first step. The premier calls his cabinet to frame an effective public policy.

b) Agenda setting

Secondly, Premier with his cabinet sets a particular task. This helps to frame a sound public policy.

This shows value of agenda setting.

c) Policy formation

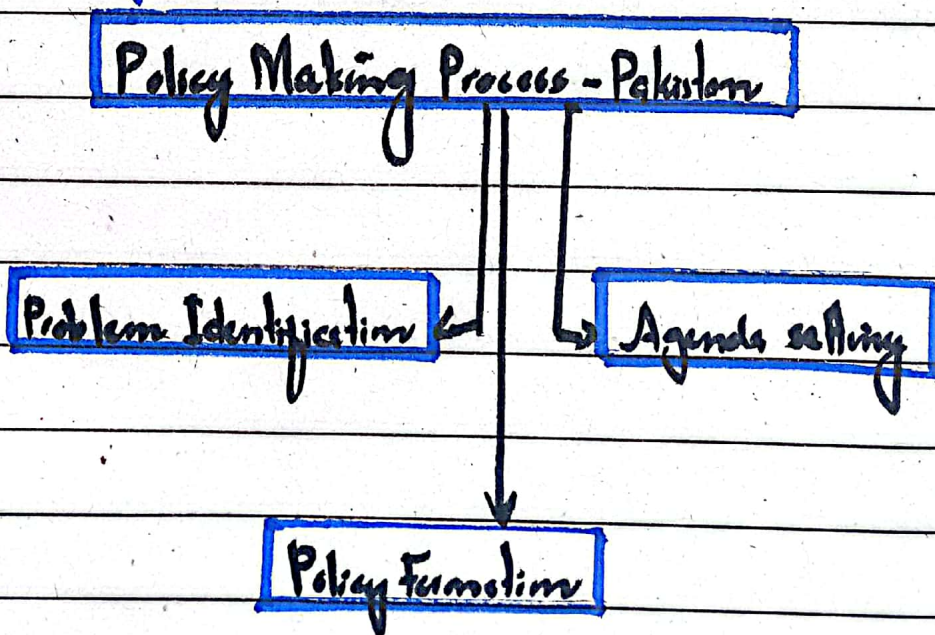
In Pakistan, several policy formation are well-defined. In fact, it aims to promote national cohesion and public development.
