Pak-Afghan relations Introduction:

After the take over of Afghanistan by the Afghan Taliban in August, 2021, there has been an increase of attacks by the Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan (TTP). For most parts, the Afghanistan land has been used by the TTP. According to Pak Institute for Peace Studies (PIPS) Security report TTP and ISK-P Islamic State Khorasan accounted for 82 percent of terrorism related deaths and conducted 78 percent of terrorist attacks in 2023. This has deteriorated the relations between Afghanistan and Pakistan because there have been reports that TTP is using Afghanistan's

lead to destabilize Pakistan.
 Pakistan has asked the Afghan Taliban to play a role in curbing these attacks but the Afghan interim government has denied all of his claims.

Due to these increased militant attacks, Pakistan government announced the deportation of illegal and undocumented Afghan refugees. The Afghan government termed this as "unacceptable" so the relations have been further deteriorated.

i An environment of uncertainty and discomfort
 Due to these attacks, Pakistan has been dealt with an environment of uncertainty and discomfort. There has been a loss of precious lives and the internal peace

2.1.5 How this deportation will hurt Afghanistan

(i) Afghanistan's Capacity building will be tested.

An estimated 1.7 million Afghan refugees are undocumented

meaning that Afghan ^{government} need some sort of capacity building to settle this refugees.

Afghanistan is already facing severe humanitarian crisis. According to UN, almost 69% of people of Afghanistan are under the poverty line. So settling these refugees will be a massive challenge for Afghanistan.

-ii Deportation poses risks to Afghan's stability

Many refugees will likely to adjust to life in Afghanistan, especially if they have no foreseeable prospect. They might join some violent or extremist groups in order to have a profitable earning.

IV Recommendations - what needs to be done to tackle TTP and to have better relation with Afghanistan

Pakistan need to understand Taliban psyche :

Pakistan need to understand Taliban psyche. For example instead of handling Osama Bin Laden in 2001 to America they let their government to fall. So these Afghan Taliban would never hand out TTP leaders to

Pakistan And instead of asking them that give clue about their bases, they should take strict actions and attack the ~~military~~ militant bases through intelligence operation.

-ii Pakistan needs to dismantle the leaders of TTP

Pakistan needs to dismantle the top leaders of TTP. We have examples from the past that by dismantling the top leadership breaks the network of such violent groups. We have seen that the founder of TTP

Baitullah Megeed was killed in 2009 and after that somehow TTP was not as effective as they were before.

diplomatic, economic and military action

Pakistan first need to engage Afghanistan with diplomatic ties efforts are currently been made at Muleana fest-ur-Rehman may bent to have talks about the mutual cooperation. But as of now no progress has been made. If diplomatic ties fail Pakistan need to exert pressure through economic policies like

enhanced duties, high tariffs and a tight policy regarding the transit. Smuggling along the border and influx of refugees must be closely monitored. Also there needs to have a military operation against the TTP but not of the kind of Zarb-e-Azb we had in 2016. This time a new one with a perfect operational strategy - a operation is required.

-v Afghanistan need to respond positively to Pakistan's demand in order to gain her geo-political depth

Afghanistan need to help Pakistan in order to get his geo-political goals. As there is already a humanitarian crisis so in order to have a world's interests

Committee they must remain adhere to the Pakistan's demands. **China** can play her role in initiating comprehensive and effective dialogue. This is also important for China because regional peace is crucial for China's flagship projects like the CPEC and the BRT and if there is peace in the region means China's ambitions as a world's economic leader would be fulfilled as far as this region is concerned.

US - India Strategic Partnership Introduction :

India and USA are extending their strategic partnerships through some economic and defence agreement. Over the past few years USA has invested a lot in India and both have committed to extend this to a new level. One primary reason for that is containment of China and as both India and USA do not want the hegemony of China, they are making agreements in almost all spheres of the geo-strategic and geo-economic domains. Beside China this has also created problems for Pakistan in its security and economic spheres.

II A glance at the growing strategic partnership of India and USA

US-India have been the strategic partners in almost all the domains since the visit of President Clinton in 2000s. But these relations have been further extended to a new level. India and USA have signed multiple defence, technology and economic deals. In the defence sector the US-India Defence Technology Trade Communication was signed in the 2018. It was a security agreement and
