Economic, demography, and environment will shape the future

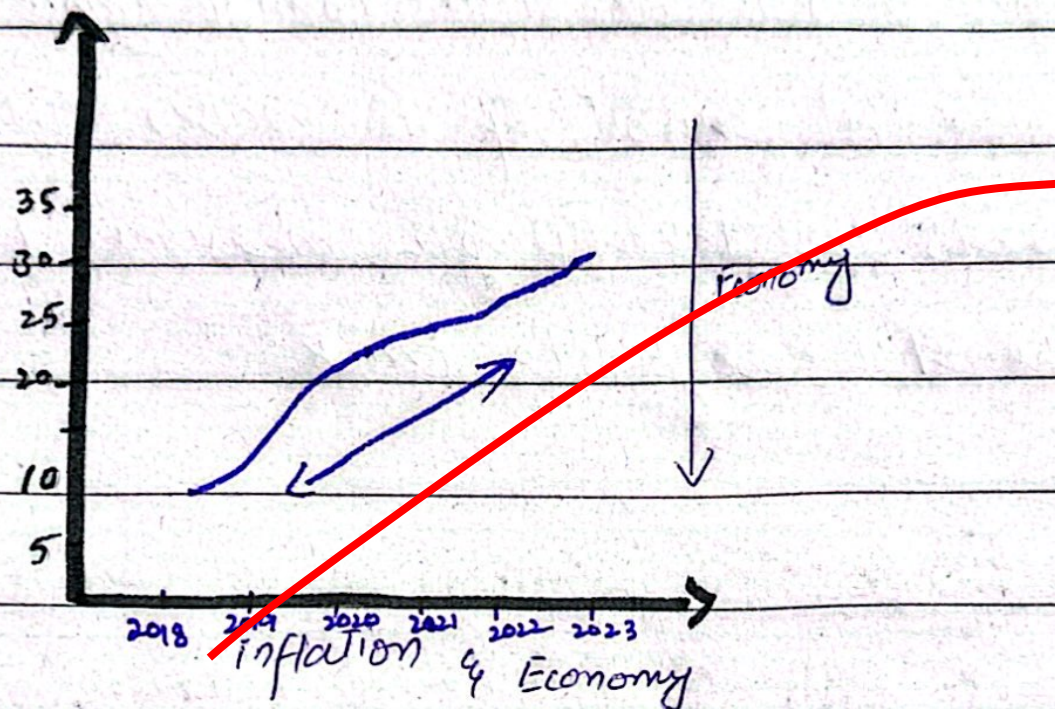
Economic instability can push state backward

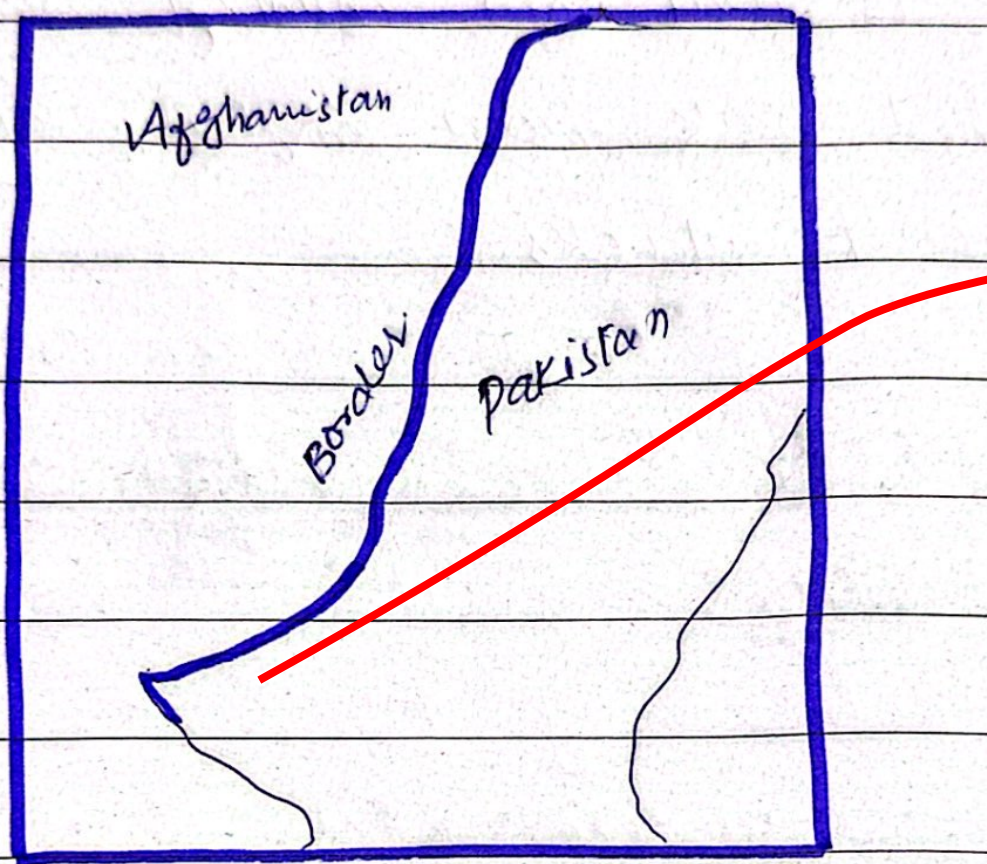

New factories and industries will be built

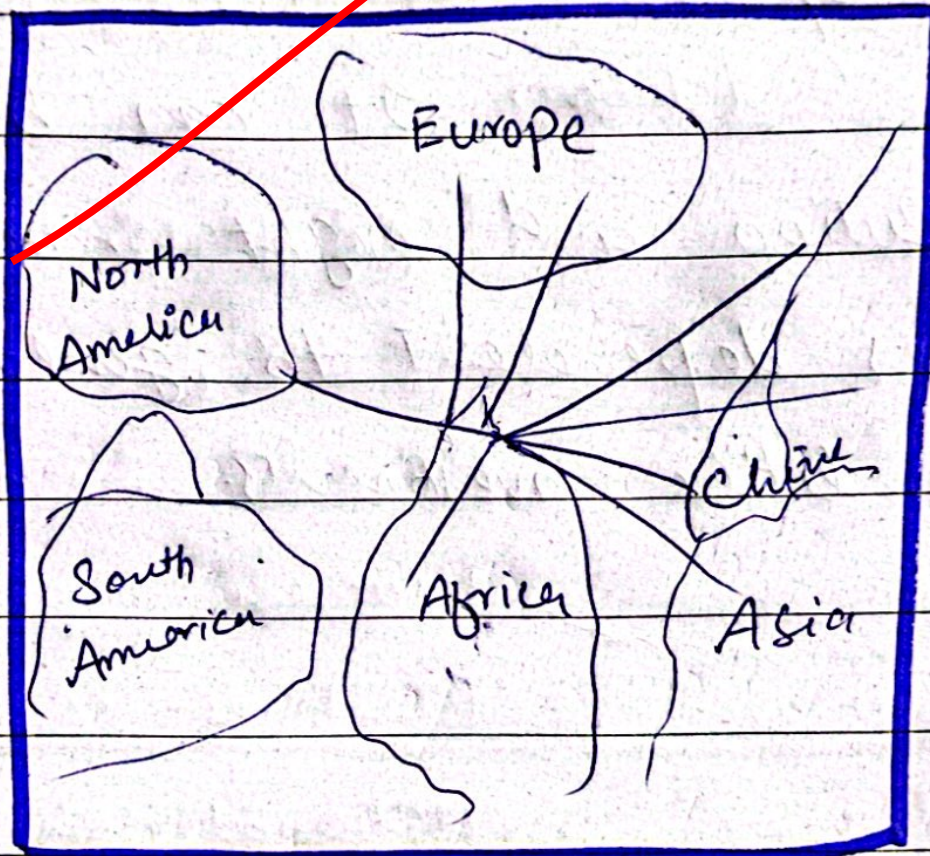
CPEC and BRI will introduce more factories and industries to the project which could be a game changer. As, at one end it will increase the export of the state and employment.
