1) Introductory Remarks

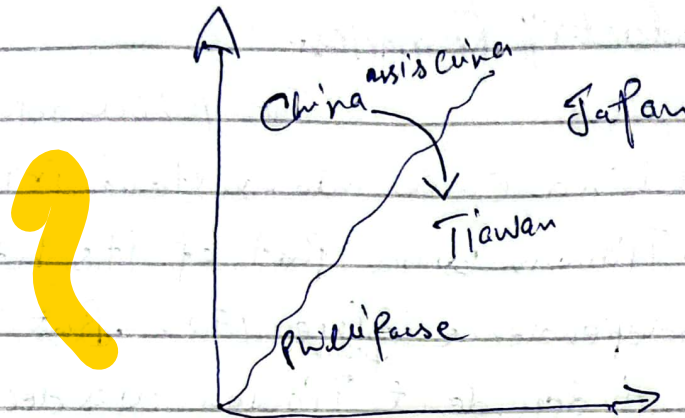
