Why US is silent on the Palestine Conflict?

Strategic Interest:

US has many strategic interests in the region. That's why the US is silent on this issue. The US wants to maintain its hegemony on the middle east and accompanying the resources like the pro-strategic location of Gaza. US wants to make a more standard port on the Mediterranean sea near Gaza. He thinks if the Palestinians are weaker.

Economic Interest:

Despite repeated war crimes committed by Israel in Gaza US is silent. US is seeking its economic interest which does not take any advantage of GREEC which was recently announced. He wanted to make a trade deal through the Gaza. Therefore he is silent on the war.

Testing the GCC countries:

US is testing the capabilities of the GCC countries. Mr. Blinken, a US secretary of state made repeated visits to the GCC countries to encourage them to speak against the plan. Some remain silent. GCC countries had some anger but did not take any steps to address this issue.

US wanted to maintain a Rift in Middle East:

This is a long term planning of the Britain after giving a place to the Jews in the Palestine. And later in forcing US to handle the situation. US maintained a rift in the region and constantly supplied weapons to the Israel like Assad, Kadhafi is an historical bone of contention of Britain. The Palestine is also a bone of contention made by US in middle east.

Contain Influence of Russia and China:

US wanted to maintain an iron clad nation with Israel to exert the influence of China and Russia. Although both countries have shown a soft stance even in the UN but the US vetoed it by maintaining friendly relations with Israel - US will be in a better position to contain Russia and China.

Strong Influence of Israeli Lobby on American Foreign Policy:

Israel had significant positions in the US parliament and the business community and in the educational institutions. These lobbies influence the US foreign policy. As it was evident during the crackdown of US forces on the University students. They demanded to divest from Israel but of no vain.

Affect of US Policy on the Relation with the Muslim World:

Relations with Egypt:

Egypt was the first Muslim country to recognise Israel and build relations that now due to Israel-Gaza conflict the US has repeatedly called on Egypt to open its crossings but Egypt worried when almost every Palestinian refugee is taking refuge in Rafah and the Israeli soldiers bombing Gaza. Rafah

In this situation Egypt warned US of deploying its nuclear weapons when Israel proceeds further.

Relations with Syria and Jordan; and Lebanon:

When the Israel has started its offence in Gaza, Houthi Rebels gave tough time to US Navy in Mediterranean sea. In addition to this Hezbollah is in continuous war with Israel by direct missile attack. So that the US relations with these muslim countries remain tense.

US Relations with Saudi-Arabia

US's foreign policy to remain silent on the issue of Palestine has annoyed the King Salman. When Anthony Blinken visited KSA, King Salman set him half on boat late. Moreover, on the repeated assertions of US to influence the KSA to remain silent on the issue of Palestine bore no fruit. Relations further deteriorated.

US Relations with Iran:

Iran has always remained in tense relations with the UN because of sanctions moreover, Iran also lacked progress in Syria and Lebanon which further escalated the situation in the Israel-Gaza war. US seen Iran as its biggest rival in the region.

Conclusion:

As of repeated human rights violations by the Israel and repeated silence of US even in the UN has annoyed the Muslim world. When South Africa brought a legal suit against Israel in the I.C.T. almost all the Muslim countries including Pakistan welcomed the decisions of I.C.T. In this year US is holding its general election and we hope for the best of the new foreign policy of US.

Sanctions on the Russian Economy:

US has sanctioned the Russian economy and frozen its foreign assets worth \$60 b. Mr. Putin claimed this as stolen money and vowed to retaliate. In the fiscal year of 2023-2024 Russian economy grew at 2.1% and then the advent of war.

NATO will Dominate in Ukraine

This year the G-7 summit was held in Italy all the member states vowed to support Ukraine in the war. In the recent move the leaders decided to the give the money of frozen assets to the Ukraine. It shows that the member states are ready to support Ukraine in every hook and crook.

Show of strength in support to Ukraine during Switzerland peace summit.

Introduction:

CPEC is a \$60 billion investment of China in Pakistan signed in 2013 and started the construction of infrastructure. CPEC has divided into three developmental phases. First phase has been completed and now the second phase has started started with a greater pace but now the projects have become increasingly slow. Slowing down of these projects finds the root causes in the political instability, economic crisis and security concerns. So certain steps should be taken to tackle these issues.

Reasons of slow Progress of CPEC projects:

1. Political Instability

Political instability in the country leads to the slowing of CPEC projects. As the first phase has been initiated in the 2010 and the second phase started in 2014 with 4 years late. This happens because of political turmoil in the country as the PTI Khan's government has toppled and a new PDM government took power with weak mandate to negotiate the Chinese government.

2. Economic Crisis

Pakistan's economy was on the brink of default. It seeks loans from the IMF with the tough conditions and already a debt ridden economy. So the because of above mentioned reasons Pakistan was not able to take the projects at greater pace. It re-negotiate many projects like H-07 due to economic recession.

3. Terrorism

Terrorism has been a major issue in slowing the projects of CPEC. Due to this workers are not willing to work at the sites. Recent attack on the Chinese workers in the Dask Dam and in Gwadar mackes urge the Chinese authorities to express concerns to Pakistan. As the communist leader in his recent visit expressed concerns only on terrorism.

4. Bureaucratic Hurdles:

CPEC projects have witnessed a slow in their pace because of the bureaucratic hurdles also and red-tapism. Late approval came from the bureaucracy and land acquisition issues are common. As one ~~recalled~~ said that when a foreign investor came for Pakistan and go to DC office for approval. After waiting for a his life the country.

5. Blasphemy Related Issues:

Some Chinese workers are involved in the blasphemy some of them were indicted from the courts also. This poses a major halt in the progress because the work at these sites. Recent incident came at the site where a Chinese worker was rescued after from the site in fear of mob attack.

6. Soaring Debt of these projects

As the US once said that the Chinese BRI is the debt trap strategy of China. As it served the Sri-Lankan Hansantota port because of the default of Sri-Lanka because of its debts so Pakistan should re-negotiate some of the projects as these projects are incurring debt paving the way for other projects to go on.

Solutions to increase the pace of CPEC Projects:

1. Bring Political stability

Political stability is necessary for the greater pace of the projects. Therefore all the political parties should form a consensus and like SIPC form a body to only monitor the issues related to CPEC. Without the consensus and political stability the projects of CPEC would not complete on time.

2. Bring Economic Prosperity:

Economic prosperity is essential for the overall going of CPEC projects. Therefore, to bring economic prosperity it is necessary to increase exports and earn foreign exchange reserves. Not only the infrastructure will improve but also go at greater pace.

3. Combat Terrorism:

Combating terrorism is one of the biggest challenge to the Pakistani government. Recently many terrorist attacks are carried out by the TTP and the Chinese government termed it one of the biggest challenge to CPEC. So the government has started Alm-e-Dostekan operation to combat it.

4. Remove Red Tapism:

Remove the bureaucratic hurdles and red tapism because these hurdles are the delaying tactics. CPEC should be free from any such difficulties and form an independent and neutral body to look in these projects.

5. Accimatize the Chinese Workers:

Before going the side Chinese workers should be educated about the basic Islamic principles and aim which hurt the feelings of common citizens so that the smooth working should be ensured.

6. Restructure Debt:

A committee should be formed to re-negotiate the debt which are soaring. This will ensure the less economical debts also easing the economy. A recent example is NL-OI whose initial estimate was 995 which brings down to 86-76 after negotiation. Easing the economy and prospects.

Conclusion:

Although there are certain challenges related to the political instability, economic crisis, terrorism, red tapism and ~~bureaucracy~~ debt soaring yet the government is striving to address these challenges like to combat terrorism Govt. started Alm-i-Istikam. We hope for the best in future.
