Nothing for women without the involvement and inclusion", a remark by "Joyce Banda" echoes the paramount importance of shifting women's role from the conventional home sustainer to a much broader contributing figure to national security, growth and stability. Empowering women's transition from traditional caregivers to multifaceted leaders, capable of driving national and global security is the need of presently evolving world. Previously, a woman designated to provide for sustainable home environment and emotional support of husband and

children was believed to be the angel of the house. This monotonous role had constrained her diverse capabilities and better future prospects. Women has been bestowed with multitasking, strong decision making and captivating communication skills through which she can act as agent of change challenging the traditional thinking and contributing to larger national interests. Over the years, women's role has been continuously evolving from the angel of the house to the warrior at the national front contributing in the military, ~~bureau~~ bureaucracy, law enforcement, foreign policy, disaster management and other areas bolstering national security and stability and thereby adding to global security with effective outcomes.

There have been ample instances that traces women's inclusiveness casting a profound impact on national and global security and stability. No nation can claim progress without providing equal socio-economic and political opportunities to all sections of society. Numerous instances from history elucidates how nations achieved glory by effectively incorporating both genders during the time of turmoil and crisis.

The Pakistan Independence Movement is a classic example of men and women joining hands to free its nation from the shackles of slavery and achieving much aspired independence.

From the Civil rights movement to the larger arena of State security and stability, women's inclusive participation and their services cannot be denied.

The first instance demonstrating the need of women representation to larger national interests is evident in the global efforts by international organizations.

The United Nations Security Council long ago realized the paramount necessity of women's equal participation towards conflict resolutions and peace-keeping missions. It is illustrated by the ~~World~~ United Nations Security Council UNSC Resolution. UNSC Resolution¹³²⁵ on

"Women, Peace and Security" abbreviated as "WPS" was adopted on 31st October, 2000 as a part of international effort to increase women inclusiveness in UN peacekeeping pursuits. It realized the urgency to provide women with equal footing by ensuring her presence in peace resolutions. Consequently, several resolutions were adopted later on in different years to achieve the target of WPS of incorporating women's unique

stance on security concerns.

Secondly, with globalization and technological advancement, the traditional notions ~~had~~ have been so somehow changing realizing the importance of gender equality. There has been a growing demand for diversification of women's role into a larger spectrum of national security affairs. Considering, her larger population constituting half of world's population, they cannot be ignored in terms of decision making processes. "According to World Bank Data Report, "Women share of Global population is under 50%." Such a large contributor to world population cannot be ignored, paving the way to supporting her role as peace builder in the prevention of conflict. Hence, women's large numbers increase women's impact on national security and stability.

The third instance of women's contribution to national interests and security matters is reflected in the plethora of services provided by women in different vast range of fields. Military, one of the most prestigious ~~fields and~~ determining factor of national security as has now many women in it. In Pakistan, female ~~are admission~~ ^{are increasingly} joining military forces of Navy, Army and Airforce. The passion to serve national interest

has surpassed the bounds of Conservatism with increase in women participation every year. "Women make up 4% of Pakistan's military officer corps" (The News, 2020) Although a seemingly less percentage, still it shows women's interest in securing national interests. The spirit of serving the country and promoting national security sees no bounds as shown by Lieutenant General Nigen Grover. Similarly, another contributor to Pakistan's national interest is Bureaucracy. Here also, women are seeking career options by appearing in CSSE exams. There is an equal craze and passion for joining civil services among boys and girls, with girls not only joining CSSE Civil Services but serving in administration departments, Police forces etc. The recent incident of mob lynching and persecution of a woman due to misperception of mob was a storming issue, however, valently handled by ASP Sherbano Nagwi, who prudently and bravely dismissed the situation by rescuing the lady and handling the mob, spreading the message of women's power to preserve national stability during adverse situation.

Police forces considered a field typically suited to men, is now increasingly occupied by female police officer as according to report Women constitute 5% of Police forces (2020)

Not only in military, and bureaucracy, and law enforcement agencies, women are also stepping ahead in conflict resolutions and peace keeping missions. The United Nations efforts ~~and~~ in this prospect has positively added to women's inclusive participation in the cause of national security. As shown in report, In 2002, women participated in conflict party negotiations or delegates in four out of 5 active UN lead peace processes (16% participation) (UN Report). Women's shrewdness and problem solving skills offer a greater stimulus to conflict resolutions helping in strengthening national security.

Along with participation in international organizations' missions, women do not even lag behind in the realms of international relation by providing diplomatic services. This international participation provides a striking contrast to her image as submissive and a doormat housewife who cannot even leave the house without husband's permission. In the global arena, 2 women have emerged as leading diplomats representing Pakistan at international level. The diplomatic services of Maleeha Lodhi and Sherry Rehman are noteworthy to mention.

Every the past 6 Pakistani ambassador to UN was a woman. Her women's unique stance, patiently impressive and persuading communication skills facilitates better dialogues between the states, leading to increased cooperation among states. When different states are politically tied in foreign relations and counter every anti-state elements through dialogues, chances of conflict are meagre, increasing states' security and stability. Hence, women have successfully played their part in diplomatic missions.

Besides, women are well-equipped to cope with national disasters. In National Disaster Management, women are offering valuable services helping the afflicted with coping mechanisms to rehabilitate and emerge as great models of resilience. In this area, the contribution of Meeteek Bachhi Kashif Foundation and Pakistan Red Crescent Society (PRCS) are praiseworthy where women leaders are providing socio-economic support to oppressed women. Women are also engaged in national disaster management program to mitigate the loss. So, the services of women associated with disaster management programs are also helping to national security and stability.

So far, women's inclusive activeness towards increased national security measures have been brought to the front-~~for~~ fore-front. But with every positive side of the picture, there is also gloomy side exhibited in the form of hindrances and manifold affective filter in women's contribution to national stability measures.

The very first hindrance encountered by women is the predominantly patriarchal societal structure with man emerging as the sole decision maker and financial support of the family. It is this patriarchal setup, which is posing a challenge to women's independence and a future career prospect. Confining women within the boundaries of the wall deteriorates her intellectual capabilities.

On the contrary, even within patriarchal family structure, if the father is supporting his daughter's ambition, her services towards national security are eminent.

Another obstacle is presented by prevailing gender stereotypes and conservative mindsets, which denies women participation in life changing

State interest measures. The psychological practice of assigning certain roles to specific genders obstructs women's path to national security concerns.

Besides, there is a typically wrong perception of considering women ineffective in decision making processes. National Security and Stability, a decisive factor of state prosperity is considered to be a hard nut to crack by women. This is what the dominating men at the front forefront of prestigious social positions deem, however, this mentality needs to be replaced keeping in view the large number of women actively engaged in all economic spheres.

In Pakistan, the religious dogmas and misinterpretations constrict women's way to national security. Certain old school of thoughts misinterprets religion, and in the name of religion curbs women's independent dreaming to be West oriented approach. Such religious misinterpretations needs to be get rid of in our society.

In addition, to further probe into the hindrances in women's inclusiveness, a great concern among women is

Women, although subjected to many multifaceted hindrances can still raise their heads through certain leading to positive agents of change. In this way, certain recommendations can be kept in consideration to

increase women's impact on national security and stability.

Additionally, an increase in women quota in the fields of military, law enforcement and intelligence agencies can stimulate and positively encourage them forward. Furthermore, certain gender sensitive training and capacity building programs need to be introduced to enhance women skilled. Their participation in such programs must be ensured. Creating supportive infrastructure can also be a good measure so that mothers can take benefit from childcare facilities and also good working conditions to single girls can help out. To add further, gender mainstreaming is equally important in national strategies policies. Lastly, seeking international cooperation can also facilitate women's inclusive participation in national security.
