Load shedding and ballooning electricity prices badly hit the economy of Pakistan. Critically evaluate the statement and give possible recommendations.

Energy crisis is neither new issue nor the settled one. Developed countries are dealing with it successfully while developing countries are trying to deal with this issue and had to face many problems. Unfortunately, Pakistan is one of them who is facing energy crisis. In Pakistan the intensity of energy crisis is far away reaching. When energy demand does not meet with energy supply it led to energy crisis. This is what actually happening in Pakistan. Load shedding and ballooning electricity prices badly hit the economy of Pakistan. Due to power cuts businesses halt to its operations, agriculture, industrial sector

Import and exports and inefficient working of people would led Pakistan economy to its chaos. Major causes behind

load shedding and its ballooning price is ^{use of non-renewable sources} infrastructure damage during transmission of electricity. These immediate solution would be to rebuild new

infrastructure, use of renewable resources and usage of modern technology to meet meet supply and demand need.

First of all, Load shedding and ballooning electricity prices are due to several reasons. causes such issue these causes are as follows

- (i) Using non-renewable resources
- (ii) Infrastructural damages due to faulty transmission lines
- (iii) Dependency on other foreign countries
- (iv) Overpopulation
- (v) Huge Gap between demand and supply chain

(i) Using non-renewable resources:

Pakistan's economy is badly hit by load shedding and ballooning electricity prices because of usage of reliance on non-renewable resources through which electricity is generated. Firstly, non-renewable resources are already less and too much reliance on

non-renewable resource causes these issue.

Non-renewable resources are (Coal, Gas and fossil fuels). Secondly, Pakistan buy these fossil fuel from other countries which charges alot of money in return. It is also burdening Pakistan's economy. When govt make electricity through the resources that are already purchased from other country they will put extra/high prices on bills. Therefore, load shedding and ballooning electricity prices is badly hitting the Pak economy.

ii) Infrastructural damages due to faulty transmission lines:

Another major cause is infrastructural damages due to faulty transmission line that led high electricity bill and load shedding in Pakistan. Firstly, energy that is generated faces alot of line losses before reaching its destination. Secondly, Transmission lines through which electricity is supplied to public are of power quality that damages due to w-changing weather condition. Therefore, infrastructural damages also contribute to load shedding and price hike of bill.

(iii) Dependency on other foreign countries:

Too much dependency on foreign countries also contributing to hit Pakistan's economy. Firstly, there are best option of using renewable resource e.g solar, wind, hydroelectric, geothermal and tides and waves for generating electricity. Renewable resources are even cheaper than non-renewable resources. Secondly, Govt buy huge amount of fossil fuels from other countries for electricity production. Therefore, this much reliance on foreign country is damaging Pakistan's economy.

(iv) Overpopulation:

Growing population also contributing to hit Pakistan's economy badly. Although, overpopulation is world's issue but its intensity in Pakistan is far away reaching. Its continuous growth could lead Pakistan's economy to its chaos. When due to growing population shortage of everything will rise then there will be no option for Pakistan to move back. Therefore, overpopulation is also causing to hit Pakistan's economy badly.

(v) Huge gap between demand and supply chain:

Pakistan is facing severe issue of huge gap between demand and

supply chain crisis in the energy crisis that is hitting badly Pakistan economy. This supply and demand chain not meet due to several reason as above mentioned also. e.g. overpopulation, line losses, infrastructure damages, poor policy by government authorities and many more. Therefore, gap between demand and supply chain contributing to hit Pakistan economy.

Impact

Above mentioned causes led to

many serious consequences that will hit Pakistan economy badly. As follows

(i) Business to halt operation:

Due to load shedding businesses would halt operation. Almost every businesses need electricity for working properly. It can be through sending email, online meetings etc. These all require electricity to run. When businesses working stops again and again it will delay working and will impact badly to Pakistan economy.

(ii) Agriculture sector:

As Pakistan's GDP is based on agriculture when a lot of load shedding happen it

would stop working process in agriculture sector. Electricity is required for proper working. Therefore, it would impact Pakistan economy.

Impact (iii) Industrial sector:

Working in industries is totally based on electricity. Because all the working happens through machines which require electricity. When load shedding happens again and again it will slow down the process and it would severely impact the economy of Pakistan.

(iv) Decline in Imports and Exports:

Load shedding would lead to decline in import and exports of Pakistan. One's country prosperity and well being is totally dependent on countries import and exports. When Pakistan industrial and agriculture sector faces load shedding it will severely hit Pakistan economy and cause decline in import and exports of Pak.

(v) Decline in efficiency of worker:

Load shedding would impact on the working efficiency of worker. When a person is totally concentrated with work and his/her working is linked with electricity then load shedding severely impacts on his efficiency. Therefore, load shedding would cause decline in efficiency of

workers would badly hit the economy of Pakistan.

Recommendations:

There are few recommendations that would help Pakistan to come out from the crisis of load shedding and ballooning price of electricity bills that are severely affecting Pakistan economy.

- Shifting toward renewable resource for production of electricity (solar, wind, geothermal etc) that are cheaper than non-renewable resources.
- Need of changing and modifying faulty infrastructure for transmission of electricity.
- Underground transmission lines would be build to avoid weather conditions.
- Strong action against power theft
- Government needs reforms in making policy related to electricity bill.

In a nutshell, Govt needs to play necessary steps by shifting toward renewable sources, changing infrastructure and in policy making to lower the burden on people of Pakistan. Only by imposing high electricity bill and load shedding is not the solution of problem. Therefore, Govt needs to take action for well being of Pakistan's peoples and Pakistan's economy.

CPEC project was one of the best project in the entire history of Pakistan. If it would be implemented efficiently it could produce fruit full impact / results for both countries. But Unfortunately, it could not produce that much fruitful results as those were expected. There are many reason behind this loss such as political instability, energy crisis, water crisis, governments lack of attentive role and many more which lead to Chinese to invest with other countries instead of Pakistan. There were different phases in CPEC that must be achieved to reach its target. In first phase infrastructure and energy crisis should be resolve that completed to some extent but energy crisis lowered its process rate.
