The USA, recognized Jerusalem as Israel's capital in 2017, spacking widespread international condemnation. The international Criminalcovet launched a war crimes investigation into alleged Israeli crimes in Gazain2020. However, USA, often considered as champion of human rights, has been critisized for its perceived silence on the issue. Reasons for U.S Silence: i) Strong diplomatic fies with Israel: TheUS has a long-standing strategic alliance with Israel based on shared interests, sequeity concerns, and historical ties. This relationship can make it difficult for the US to publicly cutique Israel's actions. The US has strategic interests
