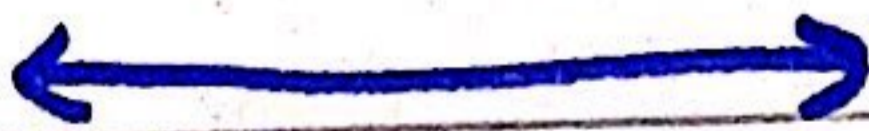
The Cycle of Development
