China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) started in 2015. It was termed as the game changer especially for Pakistan. Both the countries were very excited at the start and work on the projects of CPEC started in a very efficient manner. However, after some years it was observed that the work on the projects of CPEC was getting slow day by day. There are many reasons behind this slow pace of the work including the security reasons, political reasons, and international concerns.

Security Reasons:

The main reasons that are slowing down the process of CPEC projects are the security reasons and the concerns of Chinese authorities over the safety of the project. Balochistan has been the main place for the

attacks on the Chinese engineers and the projects. Every month there take place an attack on the Chinese in Balochistan. Last month by four Chinese engineers were killed by the terrorist attacks in Balochistan according to a news report published by Dawn newspaper.

Besides Balochistan, other provinces also witness attacks on the Chinese engineers. In the last month a bus in the Bisham region of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa was blast by the terrorist in which a Chinese engineer was killed. Tehreek Taliban Pakistan (TTP) accepted the responsibility for this.

Chinese authorities are watching these matters and are now reluctant to send their engineers to Pakistan. This has resulted in slowing down the work on the CPEC projects.

Political Reasons:

Besides security reasons, political reasons have

also been the hurdles for the CPEC slowing down. There is an impression that CPEC is designed in a such a way that it mainly benefits one province and give little share to other provinces that is the reason that politicians that have a vote bank in other provinces, that are thought that are less benefited, take little interest in CPEC and hence, affect the speed of the projects.

International Concerns:

There is an impression in the international community that CPEC has been launched to reduce the economic power of West especially United States. Therefore, they do not see it with a welcoming eye. Pakistan being dependent on the west financially, feels reluctant to show aggressiveness in CPEC and thus the speed has become slow of the projects of CPEC.

Solutions:

① CPEC is very crucial for Pakistan and immediate

measures are mandatory to speed up work on the projects of CPEC.

First, there is a dire need for the peace in the country. All these terrorist activities should be stopped either through dialogue or operations. Furthermore, Chinese authorities should be convinced that their engineers would be safe in Pakistan from now.

Second, Political consensus should be developed among the politicians of the country and the representatives of the provinces is getting some benefits should be decentralised through dialogue.

Third, Internationally community especially UN should be convinced also CPEC that Pakistan is about default due to energy shortages and its forthcoming economy can only be saved through trade and economic activities in the country.
