A: Introduction:

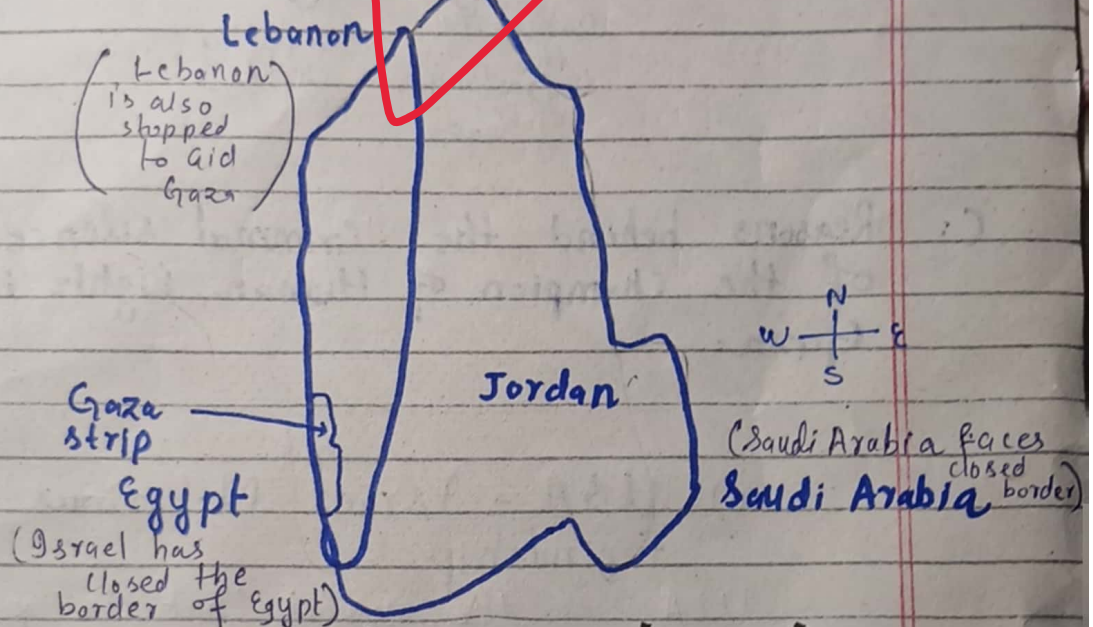

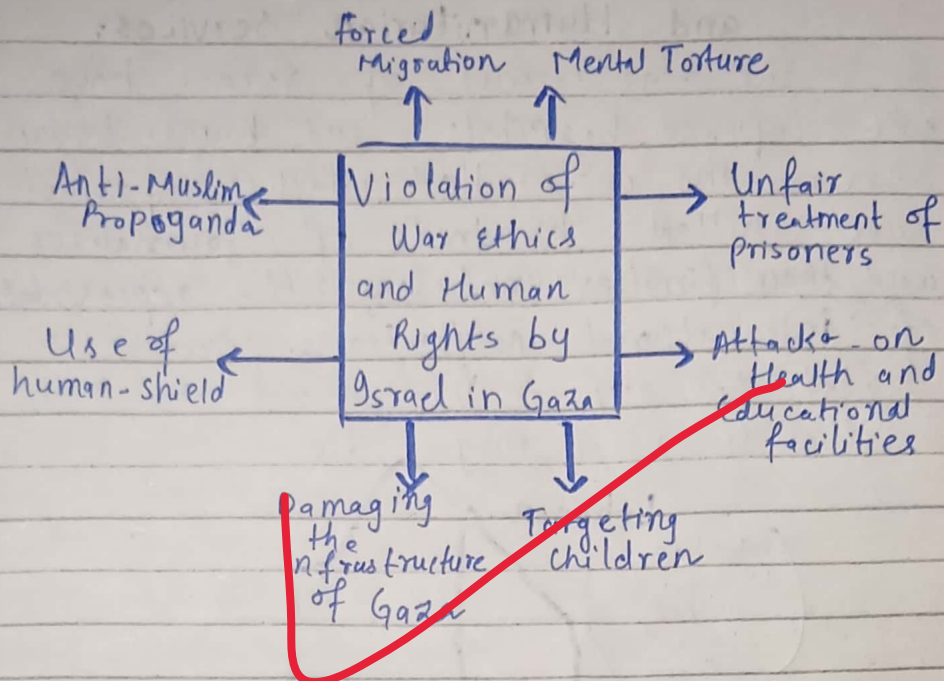
e) Inhumane attacks on Hospitals and Humanitarian Services:

A lot of other countries have recorded strong protest over the silence of USA in the war-crimes. Hence, these bold actions are the result of bluntness of USA towards Israel.

E: Conclusion:

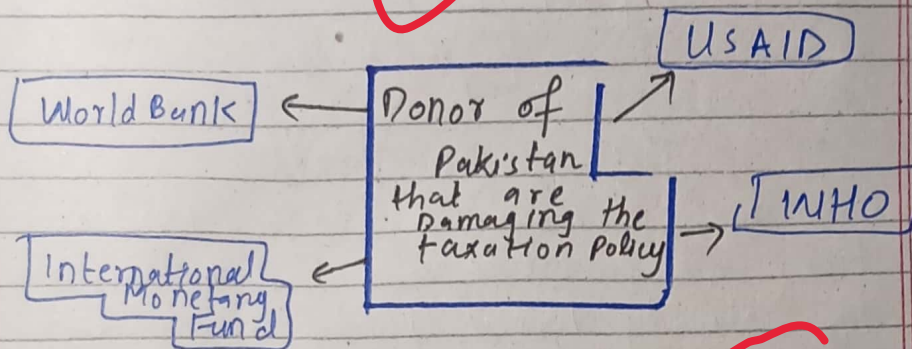
c) Disappointing Performance of FBR:

d) Politics of Interest has overtaken the Politics of Conscience:

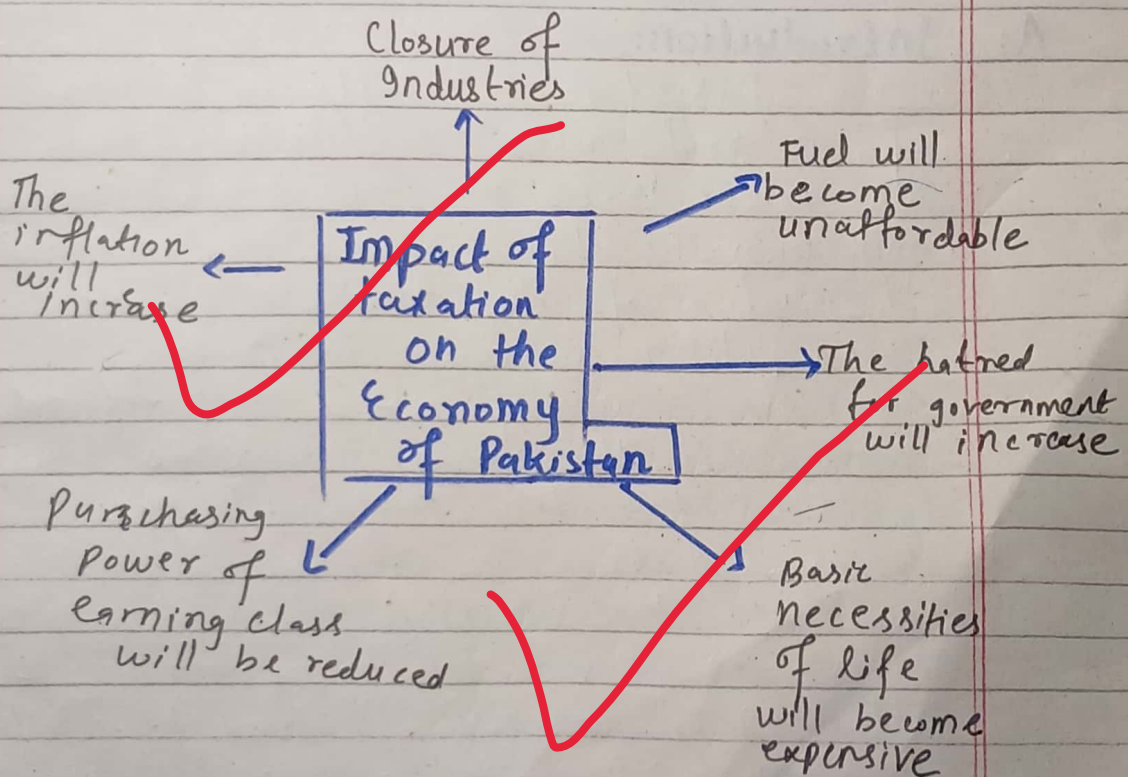
The taxation policy of the budget shows that the government of Pakistan has prioritized its subjective progress over the progress of the nation.

Hence, the expensive agreements with IPPs is one of the causes of loadshedding and highly expensive electricity in Pakistan.

c) Import of Expensive Hydrocarbons:

The power production involves the use of hydrocarbons which are imported. Their import demands a handsome investment. So the government increases the power tariffs in order to buy hydrocarbons.

d) Faulty Transmission Lines:

Pakistan is the ^{only} country in South-Asia in which highest amount of electricity is wasted in the transmission lines. The faulty transmission lines cause long hours of load shedding and because of loss, the remaining electricity is given to users at a high price.

e) Scarcity of Resources:

Due to the over-population and climatic changes, the sources of energy are becoming rare. For instance, the life span of water in Pakistan is of only 30 days as compared to the international standard of 120 days.

⌘: Hike in Electricity prices in Pakistan:

a) IMF's SAPs demands Hike in Price of Electricity:

The ballooning of electricity prices is done due the terms

terms and conditions of IMF. The packages granted by IMF demand high energy tariffs.

b) End of Energy subsidy by Government due to Budget Deficit:

The feeble economy of Pakistan has caused the end of subsidy granted by government. The end of subsidy has increased the prices of electricity and it is becoming unaffordable.

c) Unequal Distribution of Electricity:

The 18th amendment is not practiced by the federal and the units that are resulted in the unequal distribution of electricity. The preferred zones get full access to power while the neglected zone suffer due to the unequal distribution.

D: How Load shedding and Ballooning Electricity prices have hit the Economy of Pakistan:

There are numerous strategies that can help the economy of Pakistan which is hit by the loadshedding and highly expensive electricity.

a) Increase in Regional Disparity:

The long hours of loadshedding have surged the regional

disparity. For instance, rural areas are suffering loadshedding of 10-12 hours while urban areas are having load shedding of maximum 5-6 hours.

b) These practices have given fuel to the fire of insurgency:

The rise of insurgency is due to the unequal distribution of power which neglects the areas of insurgents and they are given a genuine reason to stand against the nation. The highly expensive electricity is fuelling the fire of insurgency.

c) Blazing Relations between the Federal and Units:

Furthermore, the differences between the units and the federal is the main cause of power issues in Pakistan. The consumers of K-Electric are suffering more as compared to the ^{national} consumers.

d) Increase in Inflation:

The highly expensive electricity is being produced by Pakistan due to the increase in inflation. The overall collapse of the growth has resulted in the production of expensive power.

e) The Machinery of Textile is damaged badly:

Due to the long hours of loadshedding and highly expensive energy, multiple textile units have stopped working. These power crises has crippled the industry.

b) Adoption the Politics of an Conscious:

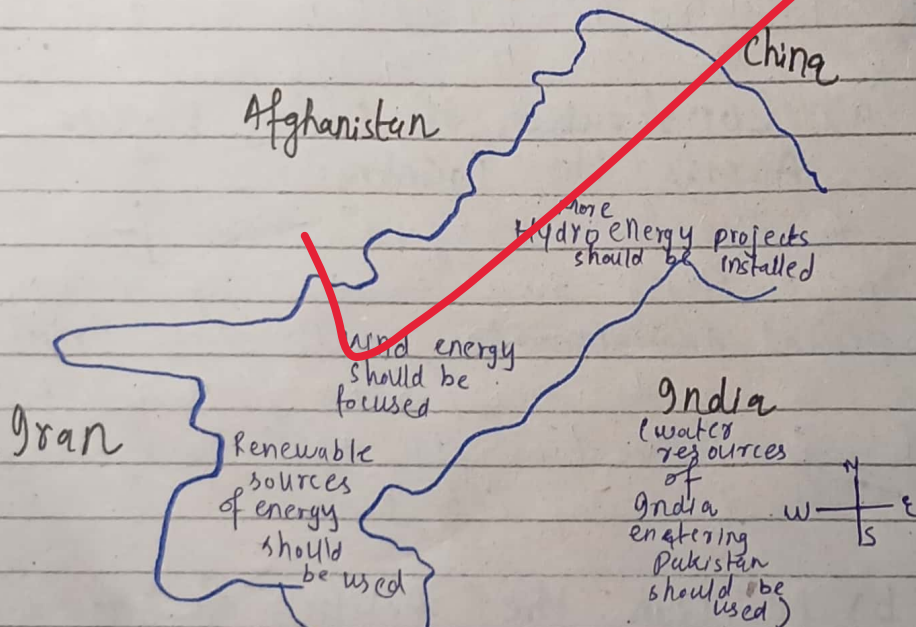
Additionally, the government of Pakistan needs to shun its subjective policies of self.

Pakistan holds a great geo-strategic location. This should be should in solving the energy issues by joining hands with the regional countries.

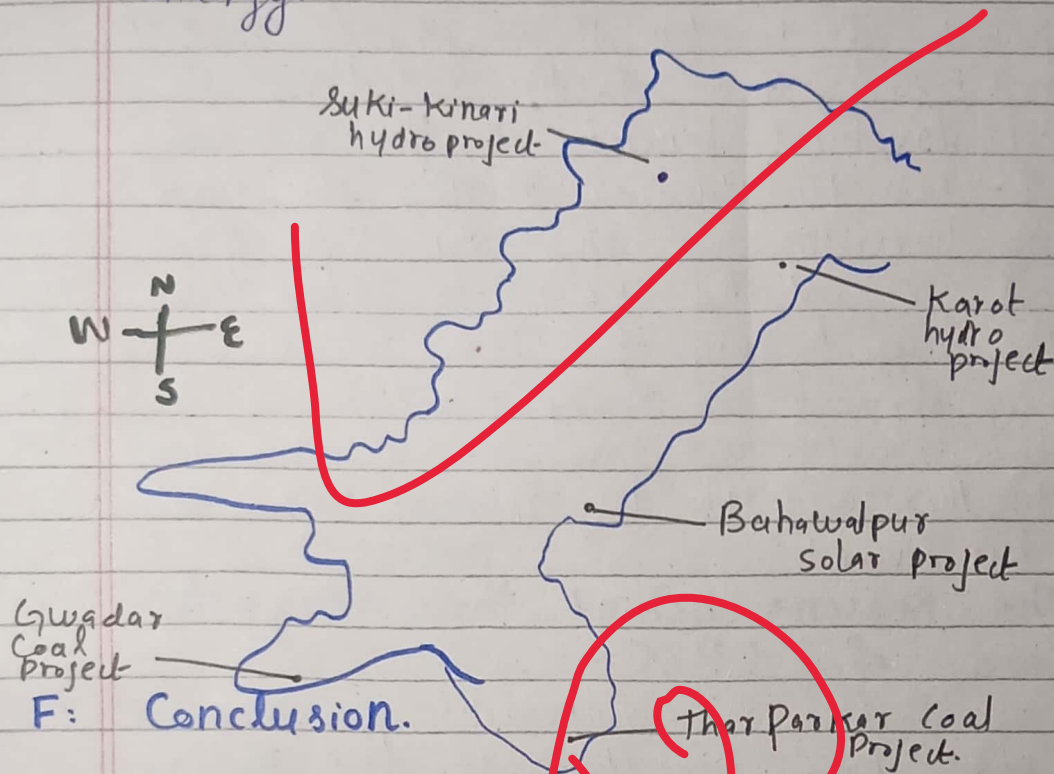

d) Political Instability in Pakistan:

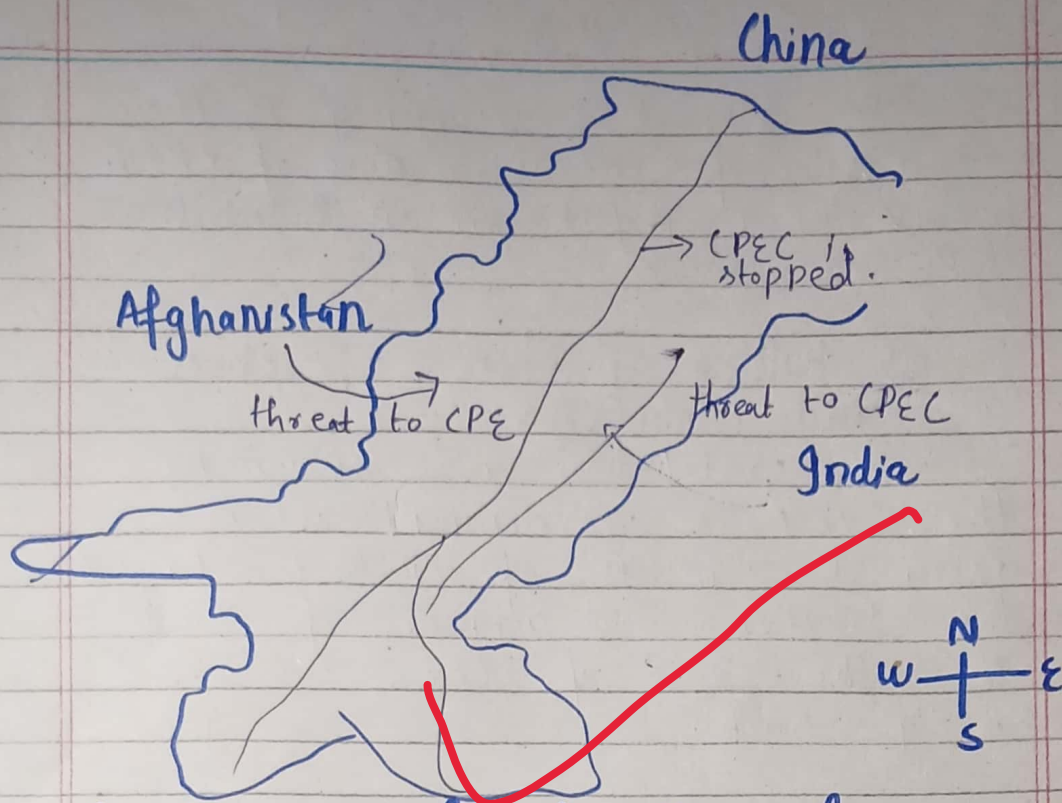

c) Guaranteeing Foolproof Security to Chinese Officials and Workers:

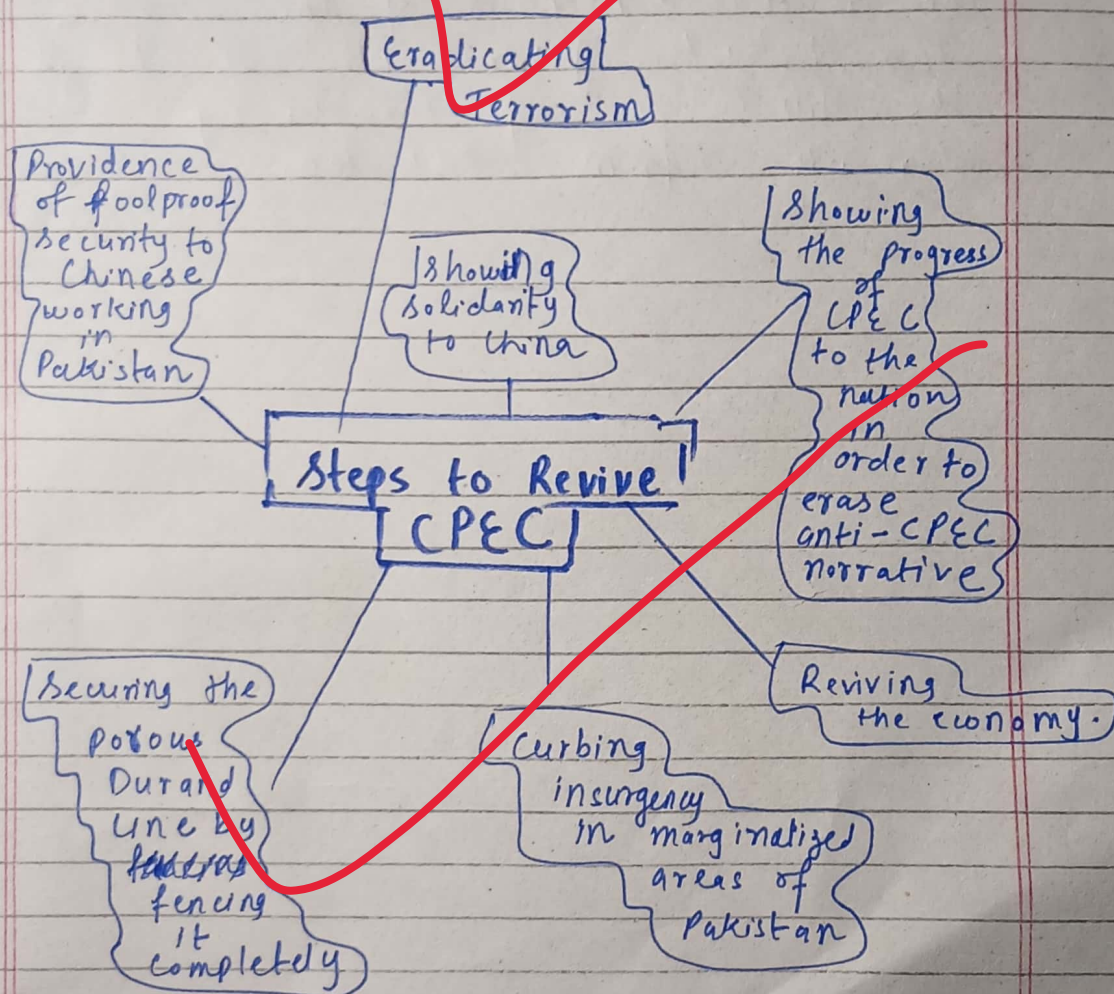
