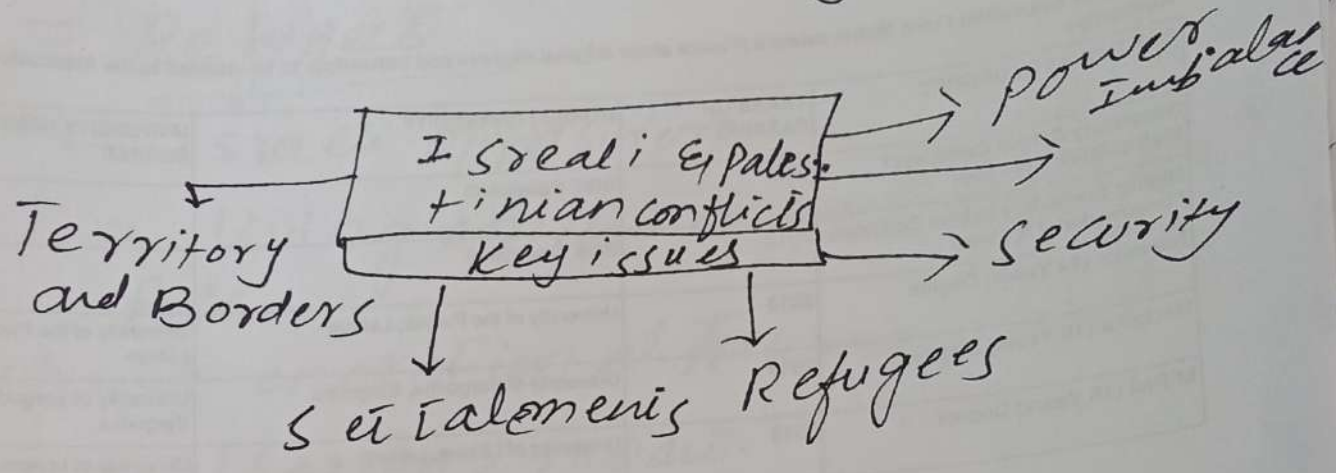

The David and Goliath analogy captures the power imbalance between Israel and Palestinians - Israel military superiority, economic strength and substantial international support, particularly from United States contrast sharply with Palestinians limited resources and fragmented leadership.
