It is commonly

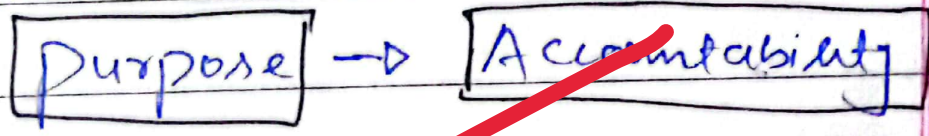
known as the "Day of Judgment."

After this, humans will get a permanent place of residence.

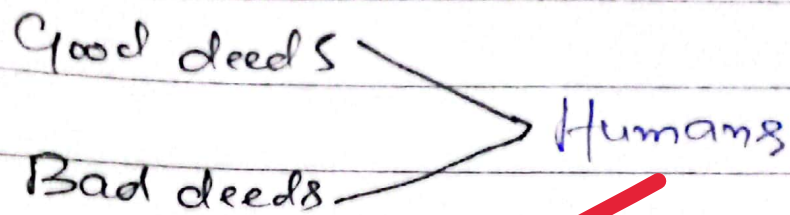
3- i) Purpose of Akhirah

ii) Process of Accountability



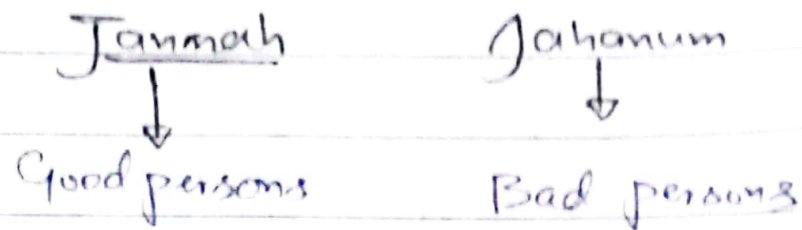
On this day, all deeds of humans will be brought before them. As it is mentioned in Quran:

Under the influence of this verse, man establishes peace to prevent himself.

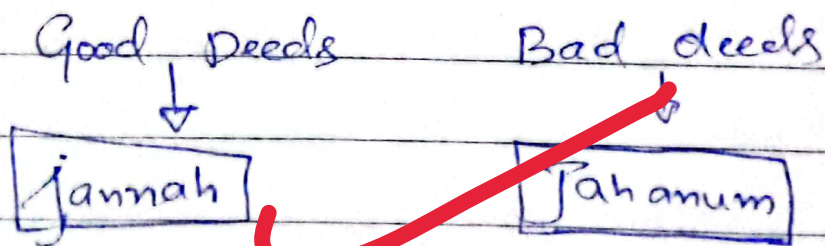
iv) Establishes Connection between Man and Allah

Islamic Economic order and equal distribution of resources

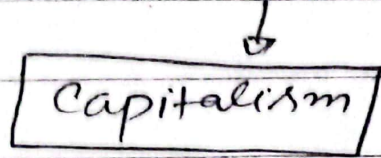
1- Introduction

The Islamic economic order establishes a just and equal society by distributing equal resources. It has various parameters of dividing resources such as system of zakat, ushr and inheritance.

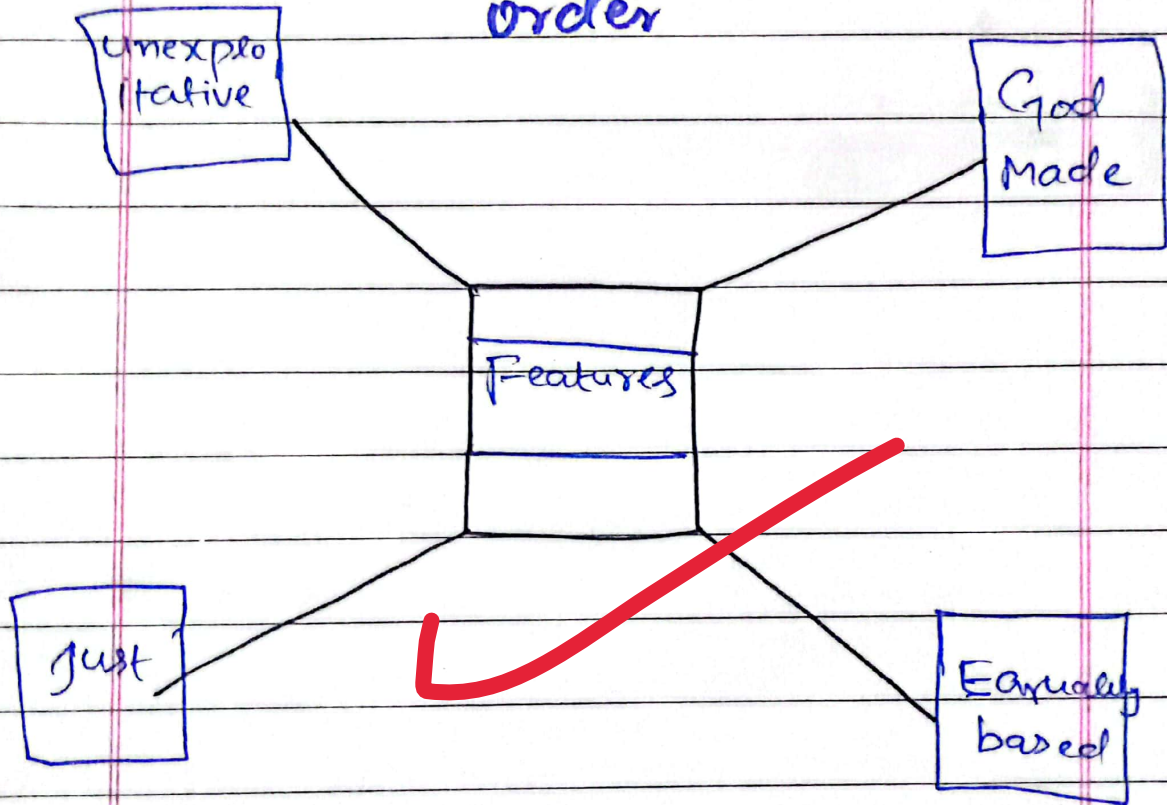
2- Economic order

4- Establishing Equality through Islamic economic order: Summary of Factors

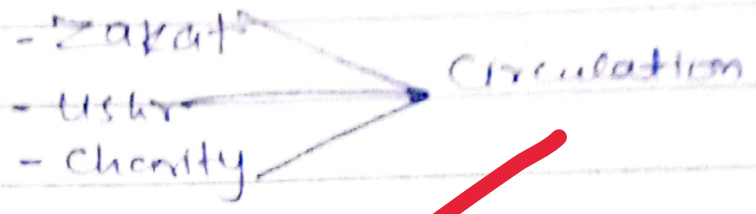
i) System of Zakat

iv) Condemned Usury: A real cause of inequality

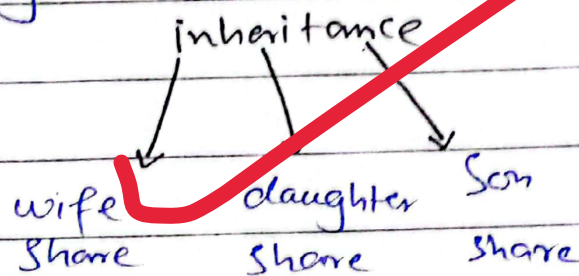
Usury is condemned in Islam. AS it is mentioned in Quran:

(Abstract from Quran)

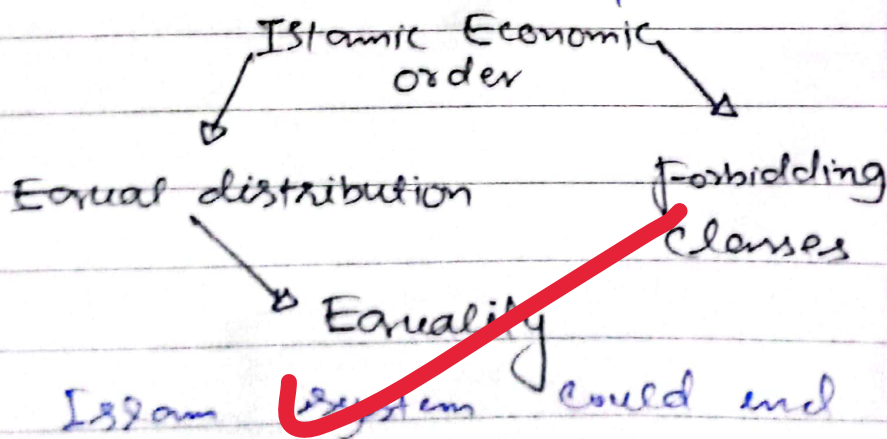
5- Equality in Islamic Economic order in comparison to contemporary economic order

 Adam.

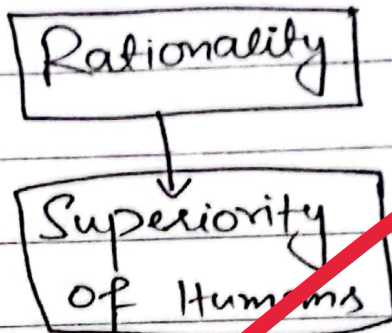

has also been mentioned in Quran:

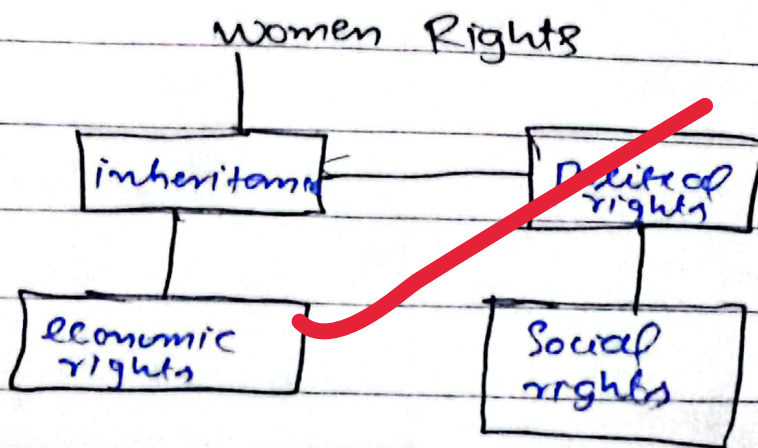

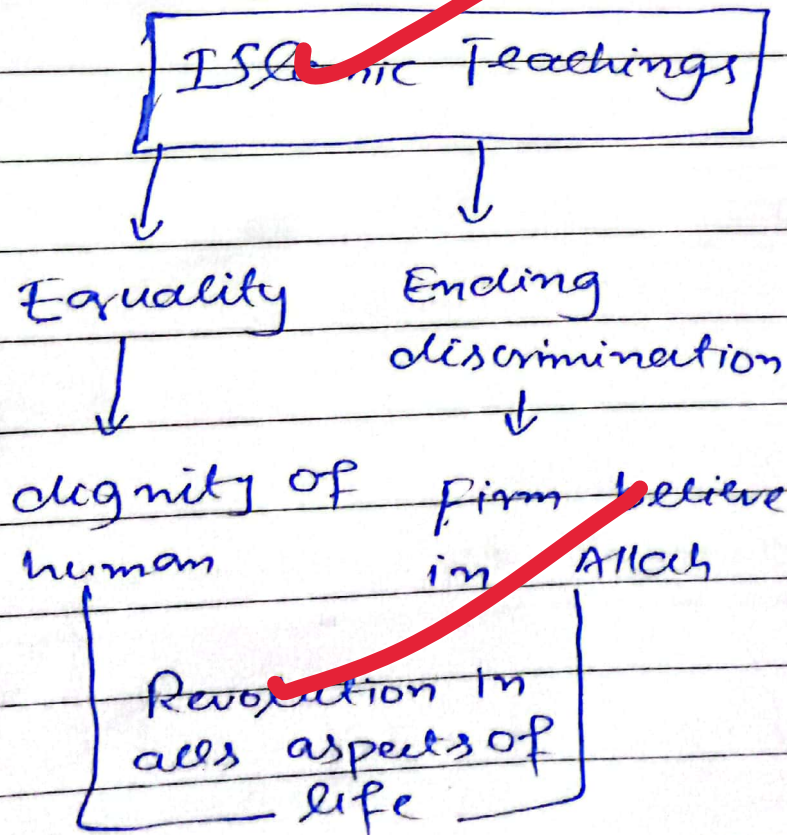
v) equal right to women

Good Governance in the Era of Pious Caliphates. Main Principles of Government

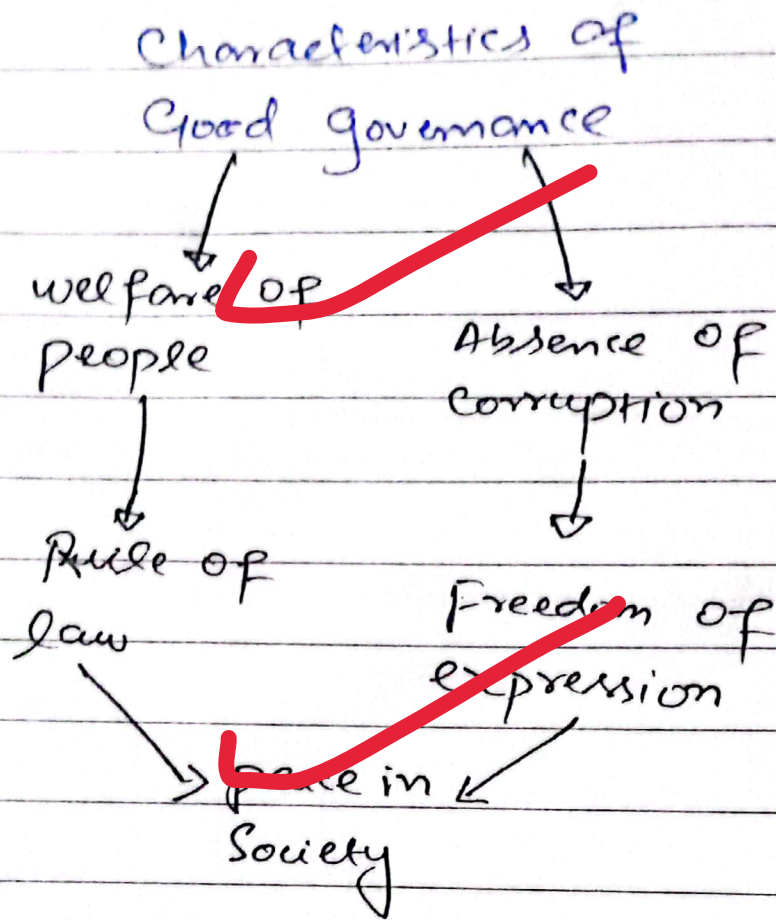
1- Introduction

Caliph would look after the affairs as a rightful successor of Allah.

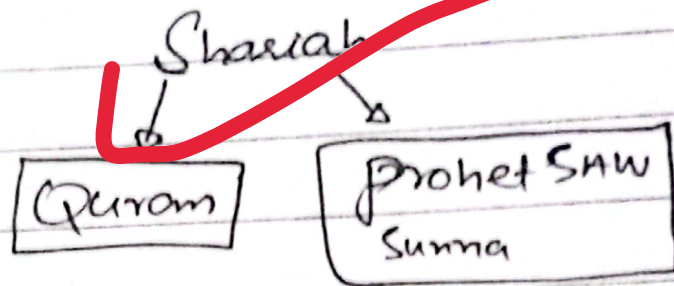
Al-Mawardi has said that he was chosen by Allah.

Ministries

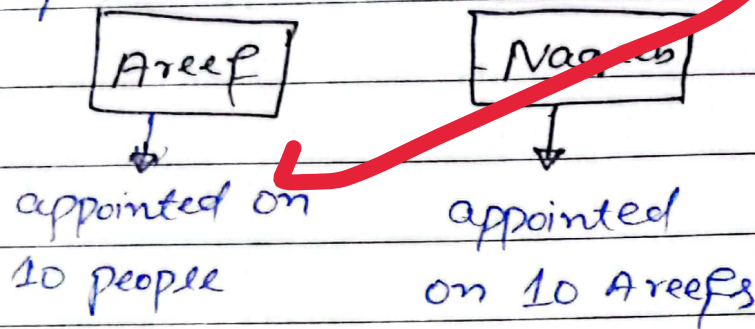

ensuring welfare of people.

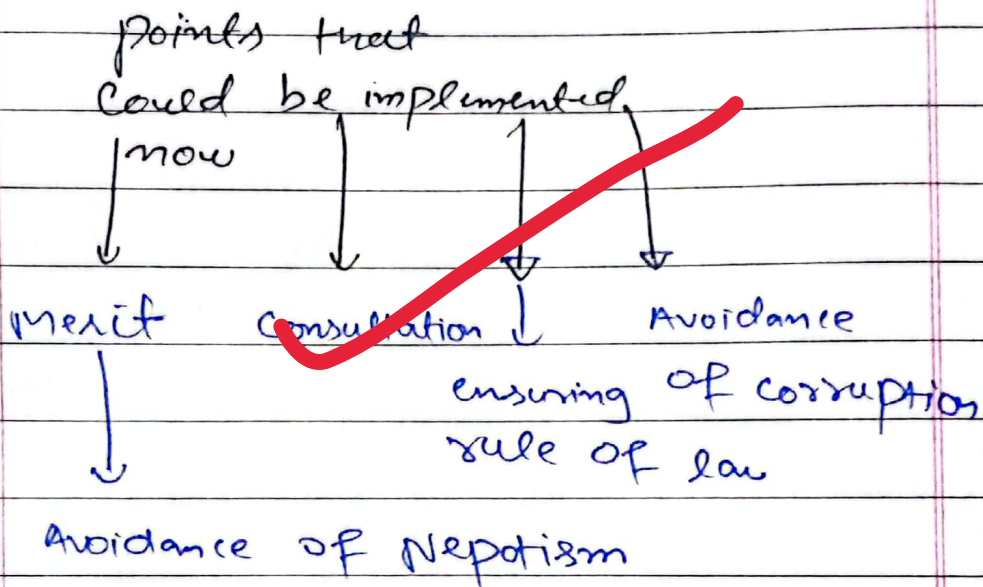
Hazrat Umer used to walk at
