Qno#8 Humanitarian Crisis in Gaza The Israeli- Palestinian conflict began in the late 19th and early 20th contury, with the development of political Zionism and the arrival of zionst settlers to Palestine. The goal was to establish a Tenjah state in Palestine. Land purchases, the eviction of tenant Arab peasants and armed conflicts contributed to the Palestinian population's growing year of territorial displacement and dispossesion. In 2022, when Benjamin Netaryahu, came repratedly to power, he exacerbated the greater political strife in Israel and clashes in Palestinian regions. This led to Israel - Hamas War in 2023, when Hamas led - millitant groups launched a surprise attact on southern Israel from the Gaza strip, Killing more than 1200 Israeli civilians and military personness.
