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QUESTION-2

PAK-AFGHAN

The recent increasing attacks of TTP and ISKP on Pakistan have great concerns related to Pakistan's sovereignty and security. These attacks have the potential to increase cross-border tension, diplomatic deadlock, Refugee pull out, proxy chances, regional unrest. It can also effect the relations of both countries, which is already not very good in the late 20th and 21st century. Islamabad should work for new and strong policy measures like increase border security, joint military operation of both countries, electric fence and biometric recognition initiative, Peace process working for Afghanistan government and Taliban, increasing regional and financial co-operation so that Pakistan's border could be make

secure at least from one side.

Let us critically evaluate the tensions rise on the international border and what are there results.

Security concerns

Due to the increasing wake of terror attack from Afghanistan, Pakistan's security is effected the most. The porous borders and uncheck cross-border movement cause a grave threat to Pakistan.

Not only TTP and ISKP, the land of Afghanistan can be used by other global powers and economy for proxy war or for destroying the national image of the country. The decision of Pakistan after the war on terror about fencing the border and biometric recognition fell on deaf ears at that time. And today this issue is not only a threat to security of the country but a

serious violation of Pakistan's sovereignty.

Accusation and Anti-Accusation

The attacks give rise to diplomatic tensions as Pakistan allegedly blame Afghanistan of it's non-cooperation, lack of intelligence and non-seriousness of the matter. As these attacks are putting not only Pakistan but also Afghanistan at the verge of chaos. This blame game results in anti-accusation on Pakistan regarding its inability and vice-versa.

Diplomatic Deadlock:-

Due to the increasing attacks, chance of diplomatic breakdown and returning of foreign ambassador should also be possible. Pakistan; a country who has an evergreen enemy India, recently got air-strike wfrom cIran and even China is not that much

co-operative in recent time, do not want to make all its border vulnerable to attack. But these kind of attacks are becoming a limiting factor for Pakistan to continue its stability process with neighbours.

Refugee pull out & Proxy chances

It is the consequences of increasing wave of attacks by TTP and ISKP and government of Pakistan decided to pull out refugee that not only result in public unrest but also a lot of refugee who lived in Pakistan for decades have to start new back in Afghanistan again. Another thing which can be possible or may be is happening is the use of proxies on Pakistan soil to make the country's image bad or to not let lead its way towards stability.

This is a high time for Islamabad to work for its regional stability

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and to work to overcome the crises. Here are some key policy measure that need to be adopted:

• Increased security implications on Pak-Afghan border

It is the time, Pakistan has to take this matter seriously and work for security of border. This can only be possible by posting high-alert military and by adopting a proper check and balance process to avoid future attacks. These military should be make accountable for any cross-border mismanagement. A 24/7 physical surveillance is necessary so that nothing could be left hidden from Pakistan.

• Joint Military ventures of Pakistan and Afghanistan

To avoid future attacks and

causalities, it is necessary for both the countries to destroy the root-cause which is waging operations against terrorist organizations. Although this is a little risky but it will eradicate the problems and will save both the countries from future attacks ever happening. A joint military operation for security purposes should also be taken into considerations. If both sides effectively work to maintain control on their sides, these kinds of attacks should be prevented.

Peace-making process between Afghan government and Taliban

Pakistan should have to continue its efforts for peace making process between Afghan government and Taliban. It also have a benefit for Pakistan in a way that if there internal matter will be negotiated, Pakistan can freely

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negotiated to them related to refugees. As refugees are a great burden for a nation like Pakistan that remain budget deficit.

Electric fencing & Biometric recognition

Pakistan should not forget the idea of Abdul Sattar about electric fencing and biometric recognition which he mentioned in his book 1991 to 2001: Foreign policy of Pakistan.

Both the governments have to take initiatives for this. Although this project require a handsome amount of budget But, this is best possible solution to overcome the crises and also to improve relations with Afghanistan.

If Pakistan really wants to get rid of Terrorism and to make good relation with her neighbour. It is obligatory for Pakistan to start working on the above suggestions.

IMEEC is only present in conceptual thoughts and is lagging far behind. If IMEEC is started today, it will take couple more years than BRI to be into existence. Whether both the projects will get existence or not. It is clear that the rule of survival for the fittest will be applied and only one of them will take the lead.

Another threat noone is taking about is Increased threat from India and dream of taking back Kashmir will be remain as a wish for Pakistan. India, who always want to take back Pakistan and tried to weaken it through every way possible by

using proxies, fake websites i.e using fifth generation warfare and by openly blaming Pakistan for the attacks happened in India. If GMEEC will become a reality, India will become a greater and stronger enemy and economy. QUESTION-5

The relations between Pakistan and Afghanistan was not very good from the beginning. From the dispute of Durand line to war on Terror and recently the repeated attacks by TLP and ISKP, the relation of both the countries seem stuck. Whenever the implications are made to make the relations better, it become more complex. The issue of cross-border attacks by groups like TTP (Tehrik-i-Taliban Pakistan) and ISKP (Islamic State Khorasan Province) has strained ties further. Tensions between the two nations

Due to the attacks, Pakistan's security was undermined and it became a challenge for Pakistan to secure itself from foreign strikes. This not only affected the security of the country but the sovereignty of the state was also undermined. In return, Pakistan decided to pull out Afghan refugees of WOT, which became a new tension for the Afghan government to accommodate them. All of this results in geo-political tension between both the countries.

Pakistan's threat to stability

These attacks represent a serious and significant security challenge and a threat to its stability. The presence of militant groups on Afghan soil not only undermines Pakistan's security but also complicates its efforts to combat terrorism and extremism domestically. Islamabad

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has repeatedly called on Kabul to take action against these groups to prevent them from using Afghan territory as a safe haven for launching attacks into Pakistan.

Pakistan's step for security

The government of Pakistan has taken steps to address its security concerns. One such measure has been the decision to repatriate Afghan refugees, many of whom have been living in Pakistan for decades. Pakistan argues that this move is necessary to prevent militants from hiding among the refugee population and to enhance border security.

Humanitarian implications

Afghanistan has expressed concerns about the humanitarian

implications of Pakistan's decision. As, many of the Afghan refugees are facing uncertainty of their future and potential hardships upon returning. Kabul may view Islamabad's action as punitive and may perceive them as emerging tensions between the two countries.

Risk of Future Strain

Pakistan's actions risk further straining relations with Afghanistan, potentially hindering co-operation on shared security challenges and complicating efforts to foster stability in the region.

Pak-Afghan Relations will only be stable if both the countries work under a cooperative approach and doing joint ventures to eradicate the issue from its root.

QUESTION-7

"One China Two systems policy" was initiated by China focusing on reunification of China and Taiwan. This policy was first applied on Hong Kong and Macau to retain their autonomy while safeguarding them from foreign invasions. But in case of Taiwan, US policy is a big hinder for the smooth application of one china two system policy.

US policy may rise diplomatic tensions between Taiwan and China and between US and China and could also result in regional instability or even in war (in case of extreme situations). All the three countries should play a constructive role to avoid any future bad implication and this can only be done through co-operation.

One China Two System policy refers to that the autonomy of

Taiwan was accommodate as it would allow Taiwan to retain its own government, political systems, legal system and military while still acknowledging China's territorial integrity and sovereignty over the island.

Implications possible & US policy

US maintained unofficial ties with Taiwan in the form arms sales, diplomatic engagement and support for Taiwan's security. China considers Taiwan's affair as its internal matter and opposes any action that could be seen as violating the sovereignty or integrity of China. This has led tensions and occasional crises in US-China relations, which could have broader geopolitical implications.

US-China Relations severity:-

If the problems between United States and China become severe it could result in war which will have serious impact on global trade order, global peace and stability and will result in the initiation of World War III.

Taiwan- A Technical Hub

Also, Taiwan is the biggest exporter and manufacturer of semi-conductors and chips. If US make good ties with Taiwan, it will also help in technological development of United States. As these chips and semi-conductors are used in computers, laptops, mobile phone, smart watches and other electrical appliances.

Taiwan as Proxy

Another implication is that United States can use Taiwan as proxy to maintain global hegemony and to weaken its competitor. US knows that China is going to

be a global power in near future if CPEC and BRI will get its destination. That's why US is using all ways even in the form of IMEEC to counter china's development

Recommendations

USA and China need to take realistic approach as if they confront on any field it will result in Mutual Assured Destruction. Taiwan should play a constructive role and should become a cause for global powers confrontation. Where China should have to provide leverage to Taiwan population as one china two system policy is not widely accepted in Taiwan, US should also carry own to support Taiwan for its sovereignty and autonomy and should not use Taiwan for own national interest. A mutual co-operation is required for global and regional peace.
