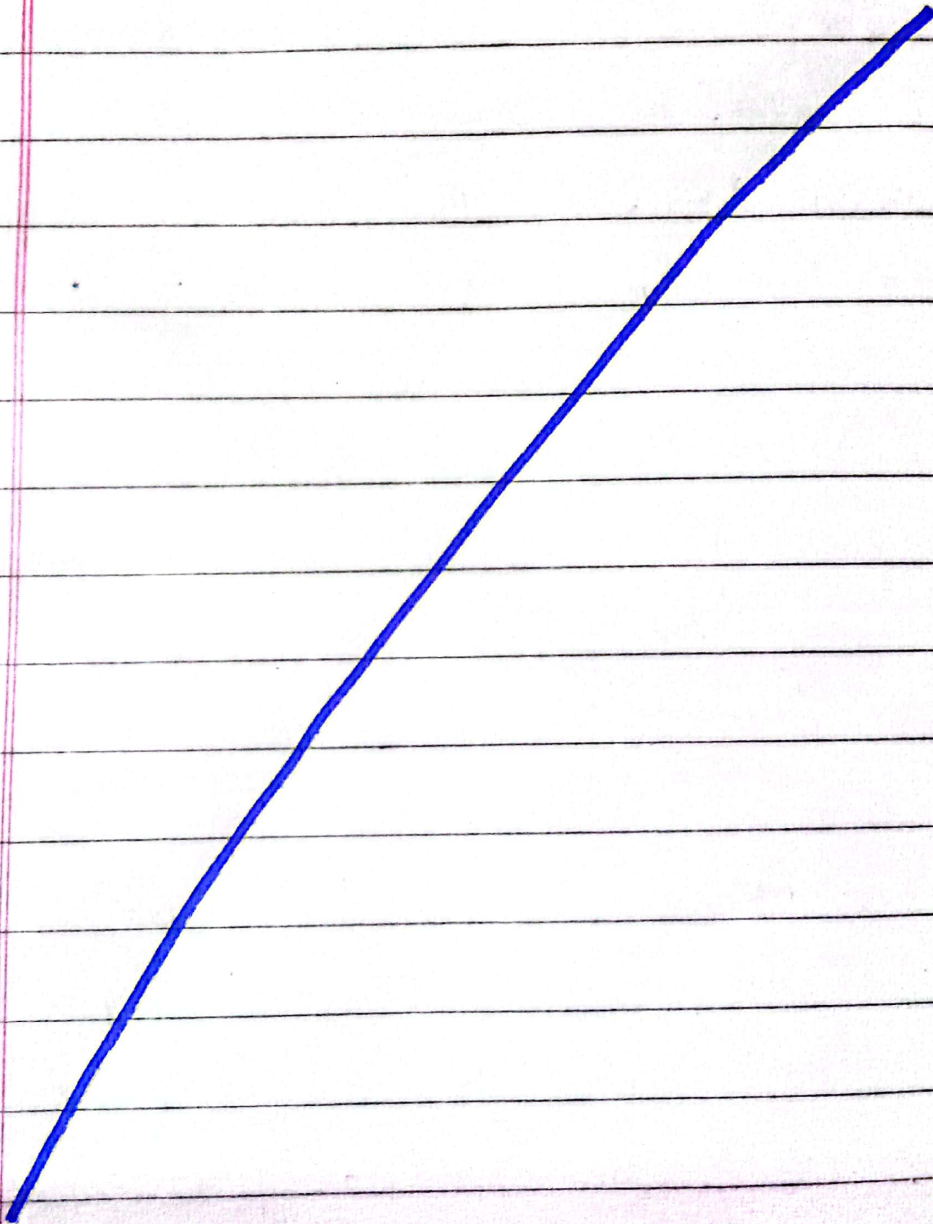
Title: Ephialtes: A Courageous Man

IS there any valuable lesson the leaders may infer such views of Patton?

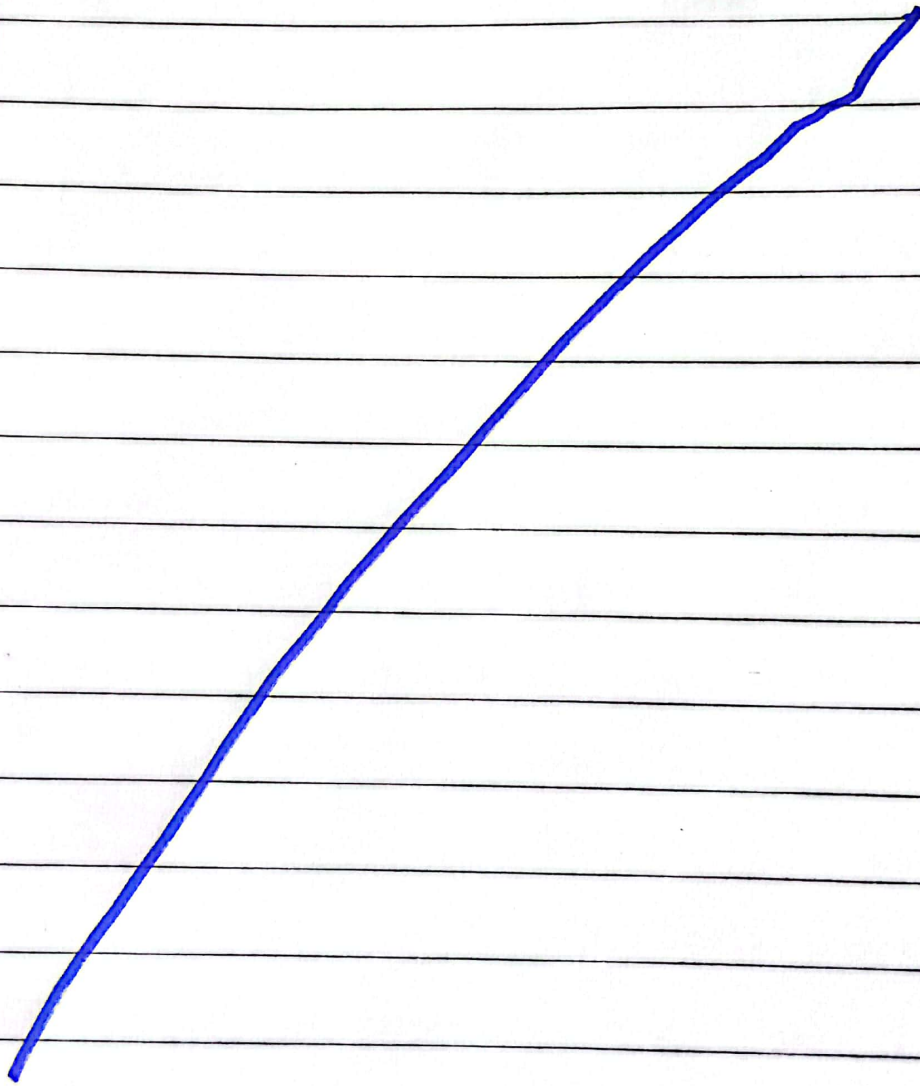
