Introduction:

Basic concepts of Tawheed:

So, Tawheed means presenting oneself in front of Allah beyond all personal need. However, there are also some other meanings of Tawheed.

Literal Meaning of Tawheed:

Tawheed is also interpreted in local Arabic language as "wahid" which means one from nothing. This could be mean creator who has never been created. So, Allah is a creator who is not being created by anyone.

Interpreted Meanings of Tawheed:

As said earlier, the word Tawheed has been interpreted in different languages, and some of them interpreted the word as follows:

i. Wahid:

one who has never been created by other.

ii. Ahaad:

one and unique

iii. Alone:

He is Alone and sustainer of the entire universes, and other.

Importance of Tawheed in Quran and Hadiths:

1. Quran:

"And there is none coequal
and comparable unto him"
(112:4)

2. Hadith:

It is narrated from Ibn 'Umar (may Allah be pleased with them) that Holy Prophet (PBUH) said;

"The building of Islam is stood
on five pillars: Tawheed,
Salat, Sadaqah, Zakat and
Hajj."

(Saheeh Muslim)

Importance of Tawheed for Building the character of Human Beings:

1. Broad-minded outlook:

Tawheed is important in individual's life because it never lets ~~a believer~~ to narrow his mind. Instead of this, it shows him broader perspective of life. It makes him to believe that this worldly life is temporary and he has to leave this world. One day and after his death new chapter of his life will start. Instead of getting himself stuck with benefits of this

Both are very important to make a person successful in this life and after life. This balance approach constraints a person from ignoring the rights of other people living around him. When a person is modest and humble, he will take care

of basic rights of others that are respect and dignity. He will never say a word and show any

haughty gesture which dishearten people. To conclude, modesty and humbleness are very important along with self-respect and self-esteem.

4. Virtuousness and uprightness:

Tawheed also makes a believer virtuous and upright. He believes that there is no other means of success except turning himself towards God's salvation and being uprighteous. Being virtuous and upright means a person will never surrender himself in front of anyone against the will of God. Similarly, he will try to correct his actions as per Allah rewards from him. In brief, virtuousness and uprightness stand along with all aspects of Tawheed regarding its importance.

5. Profound confidence:

A believer of Tawheed never breaks down in front of hard circumstances. He believes that all these atrocities come to him from Allah and will return to him whenever he wants. As the prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "A Muslim (a true believer) is that whenever, he comes along with difficult time, he faces it by saying, "From Allah it has come and to Allah it will return". (Sahih-Bukhari).

These words of Hadith build a profound confidence in Believers' heart which can never be broken by anyone. So, Tawheed is the only way to achieve profound in

believers' life.

6. Determination, Patient, Persistence and Trust:

Tawheed also produces in a believers' life determination, patient, persistence and trust in Allah. These are the important factors to sustain oneself during the challenges of life. Without these traits, a person is not going to be able to sustain himself during hard time of his life. For instance, if a person does not surrender himself confront of '~~Powerful authority~~, the Most Powerful Authority (Allah), he will be overpowered by the other people of society that will be never satisfied through any other means, it will break his belief one day. So, Tawheed plays an important role to make oneself determined through any challenges of life.

7. Bravery:

This declaration inspires bravery in the man. There are two main factors which make a man coward; one is fear of death and other fear of getting isolated from the society which revolve around wealth, family, and other materialistic things. Such fears make a man coward. Whenever he thinks about losing them. However, a believer of Tawheed knows that the world is temporary and the things on which his life is depended are also temporary. 



Rights Reserved for women to protect their dignity and greatness by Islam:

2. Freed of expression:

Men and women are equally entitled to express their feelings raise their concerns. Women not only allowed to express their feeling but also give their suggestions as proved in the life of prophet (PBUH) and during the time of Khilafat

3. Right to education

women are equal to man in the pursuit of knowledge as said by prophet (PBUH):

"Search for knowledge is a sacred duty impose to every ^{Muslim} man and woman"

4. Right to inherit

Men and women have equal right on whatever is left by their parents in inheritance

"Men shall have a portion of what parents and nearer relatives leave - and women
