Pakistan allotted only Rs1674bn for development spending. Not only the poor infrastructure is responsible for poor performance but also the investment in sports too. In

2024 Paris Olympics, Pakistan was with just seven athletes with the allocation of \$350K while India was with 112 athletes with the allocation of \$11.8m for athletes. (Source: international olympics committee report). This shows the minimum budget allocation for youth development. ~~Meanwhile~~ As far as investment is concerned from foreign investors, it is directly related to the security issues in a country. The social unrest and self-suicidal attacks on the foreign investors push the investors to avoid the investment agreements within Pakistan such as the incident in which two Chinese nationals killed in blast near Pakistan's Karachi airport (Source: BBC report).

Thirdly, the reason of the decline of a nation is Brain Drain which led into the dollar reservoir's deficit. As majorly trade in international market is done in USD. Lack of dollar reservoirs result in inflation and unemployment which can lead to social unrest, political instability and less active participation in the fields having a negative impact on sports as well.
