Seeley defines Democracy as:

"Government in which everyone has a share"

Abraham Lincoln defines as:

"Democracy is the government of the people, by the people and for the people."

Conditions for successful Democracy:-

Certain conditions are necessary for a state to become a successful democratic state.

Such as:-

- ↳ Importance of public opinion
- ↳ Transparency and Accountability
- ↳ Fundamental Rights (Food, health, education)
- ↳ Responsible leadership

- Tolerance / Respect for other opinions
- Maximization of Equality
- Free and Fair election

Contribution of all democratic principles

in a robust democracy:-

① Healthy, Educated and participatory Followership:-

For a robust democracy in a state, a healthy, educated and participatory followership is necessary and it helps in spreading awareness in society, portraying a positive image globally, community organization, petitions and referendums, social movements, and so on.

(a) Awareness and understanding:-

An educated followership is essential - education fosters critical thinking and ability to analyze information, which help them to distinguish between facts and mis-information.

(b) community organization:-

An educated and healthy citizen / followership addresses local issues and implies their voices at various level of government.

(c) petitions and Referendums:-

educated Followership can organize petitions to bring issues directly to ballot or initiate referendums.

② Educated, Morally Grounded Leadership :-

For a successful democratic state, a well-educated and morally grounded leadership is important. If they would, then they can be lead successfully, motivate, and inspire their public.

(a) Integrity and Accountability :-

Morally grounded leader prioritize ethical decision-making and are accountable for their actions. They will make such policies and set some standards for accountability & governance that values transparency.

(b) Vision and Inclusivity :-

Effective leaders articulate a clear vision for the future and work towards inclusive policies that consider the interest of all citizens, particularly marginalized groups.

(c) Empowerment of Citizens :-

Leaders should empower citizens by encouraging their involvement in governance and decision-making process.

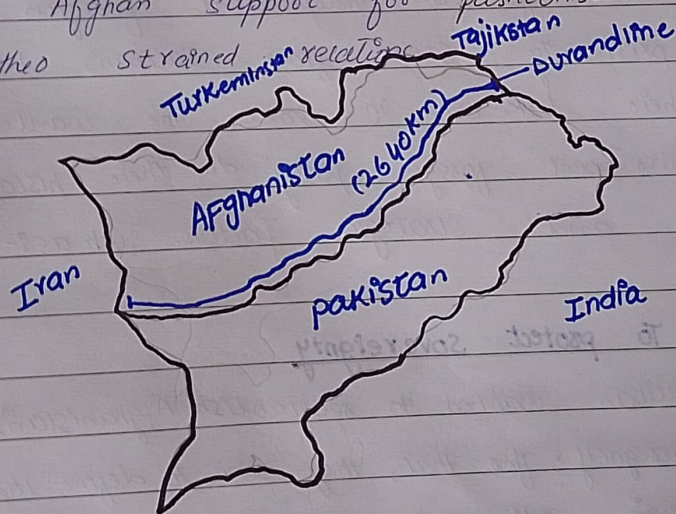
Afghanistan leaders wants to pursue more independent foreign policy and -----?

Historical Background of Pak-Afghan Foreign

Afghanistan foreign policy:-

(i) post Independence (1947):-

Pakistan-Afghanistan foreign policy is marked with a mix of cooperation, conflict. After the formation of Pakistan in 1947, Afghanistan was one of the first countries to oppose "Durand Line" and refused to recognize the border, which became one of the reasons of conflict. Secondly, the Afghan support for Pashtunistan movement further strained relations.



(ii) Cold War Era:-

In Soviet-Afghan war, there was a change in dynamics. Pakistan became a key-player in US-backed effort to resist Soviet forces, providing support to Afghan mujahideen groups. This solidified Pak-Afghan relations.

(iii) post Soviet Era / Rise of Taliban:-

After the withdraw of soviet forces, Taliban rose into power, supported by Pakistan.

(iv) post 9/11 ERA:-

After 9/11, Pakistan faced pressure to cooperate with the US in combating terrorism, which complicated the relationship with Afghanistan.

Afghanistan Independent Foreign Policy in the region:-

The desire for an independent foreign policy primarily stems from Taliban's leadership. As they take over in 2021, they wanted an independent foreign policy due to their historical, political and strategic factors. such as:-

(i) To protect sovereignty

Taliban wanted to reestablish Afghanistan's sovereignty. For that, they seek to define their foreign policy free from regional influence.

(ii) Desire for stability:-

Due to past intervention, Afghanistan suffered from instability, conflict. So that, they promote the regional stability by engaging with multiple countries than with any single power.

iii Economic interests:

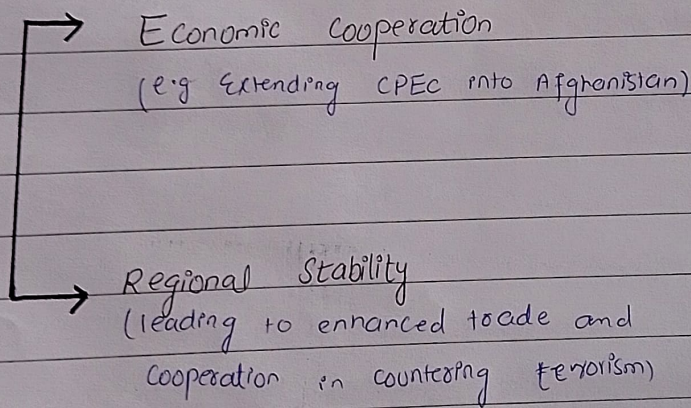
To them, an independent foreign policy can enhance more Afghanistan's appeal to foreign investor by representing a stable state.
