The peace often achieves much more than a war ~~ever~~ could - Wars on other hand,

cannot be won and should not be fought - as it is not the nations that fight war but it is army - And it always has heart-wrenching consequences.

In addition to the pledges to make in past peace, diplomacy is one of the great powers to resolve conflicts - Diplomacy involves treaty and negotiations between states to reduce tensions with each other and establish peace - Through diplomatic channels, nations can directly engage in communication and work for mutual beneficial efforts - One of the cases is of Iran and USA - In 2015, Iran and USA signed

agreement on the nuclear program of Iran - Negotiations made it possible for both Iran and USA to avoid potential war - There is another event that can be seen in history, is of Germany and France, they reconcile with each other through negotiation after World War 2 - They two countries formed European Union -

Through this, peace has been established in Europe for decades - Official ties among nations can be established through diplomatic relations - It includes the exchange of diplomats and ambassadors between countries - Good diplomatic relations can

Promote cooperation and reduce the possibility of conflict - Alliances are being made to maintain formal agreements for cooperation and support - They also establish nation's standing in international community -

Economic power refers to a nation's ability to control the resources and markets - This can include & control over natural resources, access to technology and attract investment and trade - For example China is striving hard to become the next

Superpower - For this purpose China ~~they~~ initiated the Belt and road Initiative to boost its Economy - And it is said to become ~~the~~ the superpower by 2049 - Moreover, Economic power can also use to exert pressure through sanctions - Sanction are imposed to limit the economic performance of other nations - Sanctions can be imposed by one country to other nations or group of states - Sanctions imposed by USA on North Korea is one of the example of ~~how~~ how sanctions work - USA imposed Sanctions against North Korea in the wake of its Nuclear power program - Through these sanctions
