Introduction

Nations are like living organisms. From birth to death, it also completes cycle of changes. Nations are complex and evolving, influenced by many factors like moral, social, political, economical, religious and other factors. Just like living organism, the nations are also influenced by these factors. First of all, moral values decide the life of Nation. Secondly, social changes impacts on Nation's success, and failure. Thirdly, political factors are key to make nation greater. Fourthly, Economy decides the fortune of Nation, either failed or succeed. Fifthly, religious relation is the corner stone for nation's success, if it fails, Nation will be called as failed Nation. Lastly, there is other factor also influence the nation, like Demography, Climate etc. If these factors negatively impacts on Nation, it will be failure of Nation.

There is need to address these

challenges if any nation face them, And for this Nations should be nourished like an organism, influential factors must be in positive terms. If it does not do so, would called that Nation: a failed Nation.

Nation is a phenomenon, which refers to a large body of people who share a common identity, culture, language, history, and often a geographic territory. Nation is an evolving concept, and it needs solid foundations for sustainability.

There is multiple factors which causes the Nation's failure. For example, Moral, Social, Political, Economical, religious, and some other factors.

First of all, Moral values are essential for sustainable growth of any nation. If, any nation lose the moral grounds, and its moral values absence damage their foundation, this will leads to the failure of that Nation. Moral

values like truthfulness, tolerance, Justice, equality, Human rights are the foundation of any Nation. If, these values gets damage by any means the social fabric of Nation and society starts diminishing.

Secondly, Social influences creates multiple impacts on Nation's fabric.

To explain this, Nation's concept is based on contract between government and masses. If, this contract gets weakened by any means, either by government side or, by public side, or by both ways, it harms the Nation. For example, if any state does not provide basic rights to citizens, or citizen does not follows the laws. It is the violation of social contract, and it will weaken the social contract. It also damage the trust, which is essential for Nation's health.

Another social factor is, social discrimination. If a nation is facing social discrimination, a gap between

well off people, and poor people. The widened the gap, widened the chances of failure of Nation. This divide weakened the social fabric of society and nation. For example, French revolution 1789, was caused by this social disorder, and manipulation of lower class by upper class which leads to failure of the revolution system.

There is another factor, which is all about recognition of social responsibilities. Social responsibilities means everyone who is part of Nation or society must aware of his rights and duties.

If he or she does not have enough understanding, it will alarming situation for that nation, because without social responsibility and ^{Lack of} understanding of those responsibilities will cause failure of nation. For example, Church rule in Europe was so long, but when people realize their due share, and responsibilities, the old school of thought gets crashing, and Magna Carta 1215 to UN Charter 1948 history speaks louder.

By these three social factors, another prominent, and important factor is weak education system. Education is much needed to teach public about their rights, and duties, and by doing this everyone can contribute to the success of nation. If education is not considered as important, than the fate of that nation is worrying. For example, in third world countries, education is not the preference, hence the status of many nations are called as failed Nations. Countries like Somalia, Sudan are the prime example of failed Nations.

Last social factor, which is most important, but less focused in failed nations, Justice system. Just society always flourish, but unjust society never sustain. Giving everyone his due share is most important, but not properly addressed phenomenon in many countries of the world. Pakistan's Justice sinking in

rule of law is 130th out of 139 countries, and in this sense status of failed nation is imminent.

Thirdly, Political factor is also play key role in success or failure of a nation.

To explain this, First of all, Political awareness is corner stone in making of great and strong nation. Political awareness means, a nation is fully aware of their responsibilities, and their rights. People must know how to influence public policies. They must aware of right to vote, protest and other political rights. But, a nation lack this political awareness the growth of nation becomes weaker, and one day that nation fails. For example, people of third world countries, specially African continent, politically unaware that leads to coup, and other dictatorial aspects.

Another factor which leads to failure of nation, that is institutional breakdowns, and problems relevant to institutions. It means if country or nation has weak institutional structure, the survival of that institution nation is at stake. For example, many third world countries like Pakistan, Somalia, Sudan etc have governance issues, and weak structure of institutions, which make that nation a failed nation.

There is another factor named as draconian laws, and violation of human rights which cause failure of any nation. It means if a nation does not respect the laws related to human rights, it is death of nation's stature. For example, many third world countries like African countries having poor rule of law, and no respect for human rights that's why world sees them as failed nations.
