"A nation's greatness is measured by how it treats its teacher".

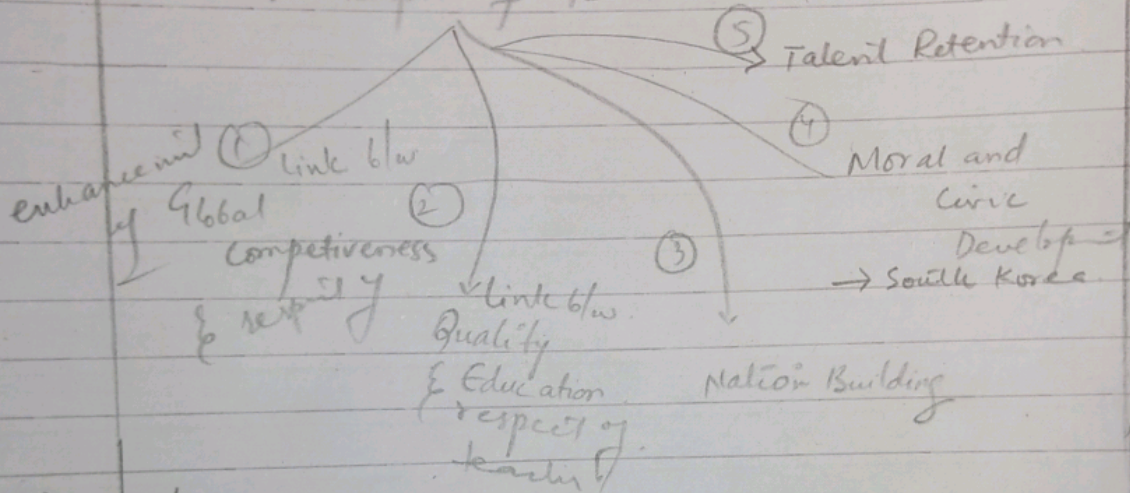

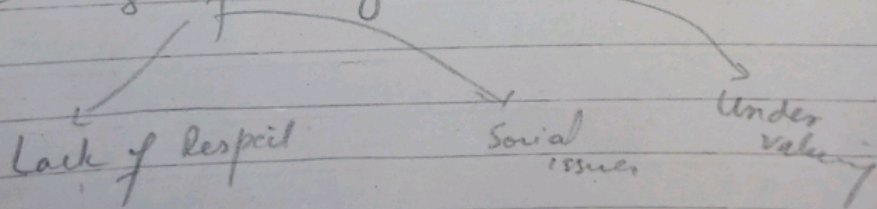
