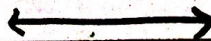

relief unless there's evidence of discrimination or a specific rights violation. The plaintiff said that he felt his right were violated.

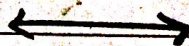
The judge said that he understood but he could not grant relief. Then

Then case was dismissed by the judge.

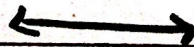
