vi) A Source of tackling modern Challenge

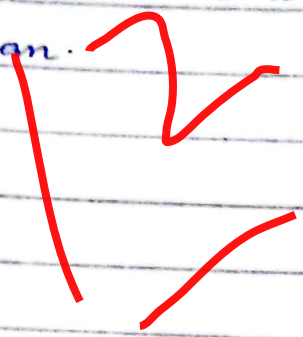

Ijtihad is a prominent source of resolving the challenges of Muslim world. It can ensure unity in muslim world and resolve the modern challenges plaguing Pakistan.



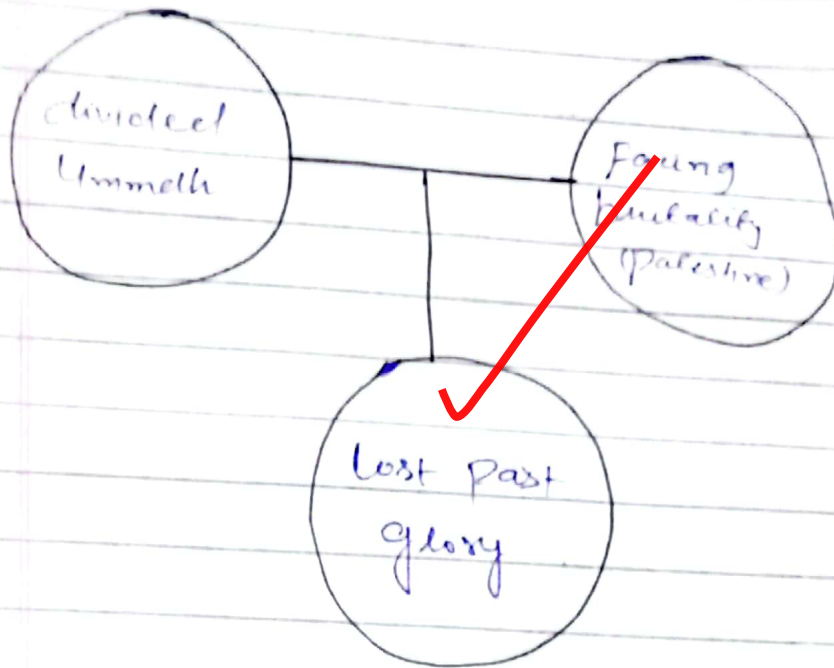

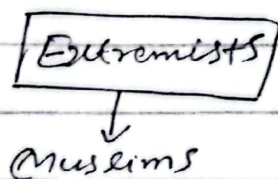
vii) Eradicating Corruption can revive Economic brilliance of Muslim Ummah
