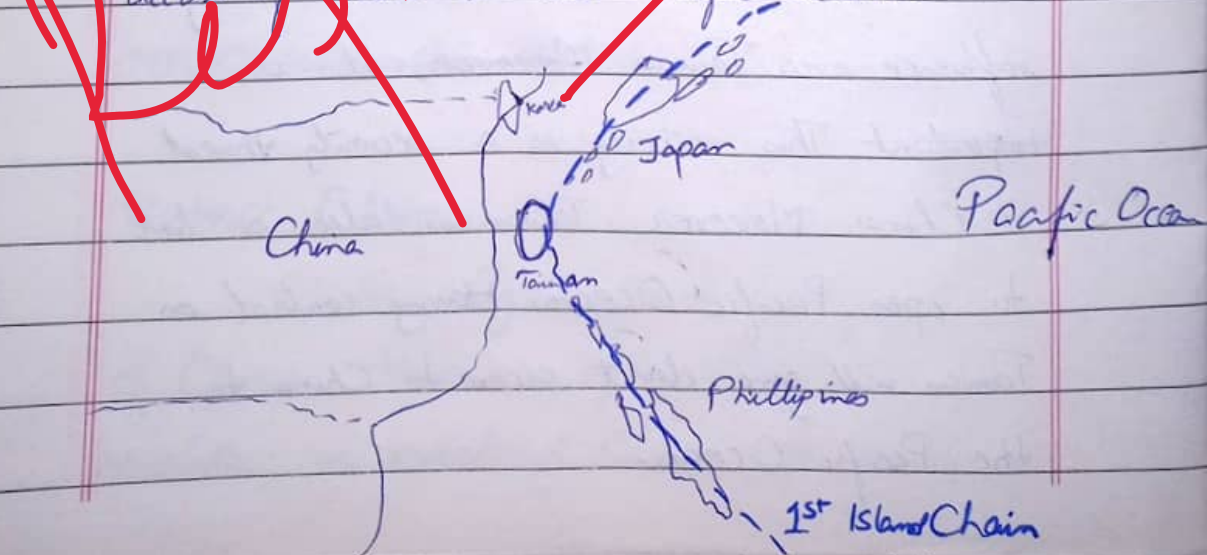
IMPORTANCE FOR USA :
