London smog 1952 was the first giant natural disaster that was caused by anthropogenic activities of London city in UK. That severe chemical smog of London deteriorated the public health at such level that 12000 deaths occurred due to this incident alone. The main leading factors for London smog were coal burning to generate energy, lack of regulations, industrial effluents and improper management of factories smoke. The other major event in world history was coal mines waste pipes collapse in Wale in 1967 due to improper management of mines waste. This event caused 144 deaths including 116 children and damaged over 500 houses. The increasing impacts of man made activities on environment initiated

Environmental movement is 1960's. The main purpose of this movement is to conserve environmental resources, promote sustainable development and protect environment from anthropogenic activities. Various courageous people including Rachel Carson, John Muir, Theodore Roosevelt and Al Gore played the role of leadership in the Global environmental movement. They wrote books like *Silent Spring* and articles like *Inconvenient Truth* to spread awareness. Theodore Roosevelt and Al Gore also played important role in promoting "green policies" by planting national parks, forests and forcing world major powers to cut down their carbon emission. Thus the major environmental institutions established including UNEP (United Nations Environmental Programmes), UNFCCC (United Nations Framework convention on Climate change) etc. These institution proposed historical action plans to combat natural and environmental disasters.



The courageous actions took by the peoples and organizations had change the global perspective on environmental concerns. Now the world is more aware of man-made activities and their impacts on environment and making efforts to prevent global temperature rise to cross the limit of  $2^{\circ}\text{C}$  reference to pre-industrial era.

Secondly, human rights violation in the history made human rights activist to emerge on the global front. These human rights activist challenged the rights violation and initiated campaigns of human rights awareness. In 1900's when apartheid was on its peak in South Africa, Nelson Mandela emerged as an anti-apartheid revolutionary and political leader in South Africa. He spent 27 years in prison for opposing South Africa Apartheid system but his courage never dwindles. Due to his efforts, apartheid ended in



Same path has been followed again.

South Africa and Nelson Mandela became first democratic leader in 1994 in South Africa's political history. Due to his firm determination, bravery and good intention, apartheid not only ended in South Africa but anti-apartheid movements also started globally. Hence, his first step of bravery initiated a chain reaction of fearless actions all over the world and shaped world's view. In the same way, Pakistani women educational activist, Malala Yousafzai, who also received Nobel prize is a exemplary figure in human rights activism. She belongs to Swat valley of Pakistan. In 2012, Taliban shot her because she did not accept Taliban's suppression of women educational right. After that incident international human rights organization provided her full support. Now she is also acting as women empowerment organization member. Her courageous story brings global awareness of women right of education. Likewise,



the feminist movement which initiated in 1848 as Suffrage movement proved the impacts of bravery on global order. "Suffrage movement" was started against (women's) lack of women political rights. in New York. From New York, it was spread all over the world, huge protests occurred in favour of feminism. As a repercussion, 19<sup>th</sup> amendment took place in US constitution to allow women to cast a vote and participate in politics. From) with the success of feminism movement second, third and fourth waves of feminism introduced. In the second wave, "The Liberation movement" 1960s, rights of black women questioned. The contemporary fourth movement "Me too" is also very influential in spreading awareness regarding women sexual harassment and promoting gender equality. World including Pakistan has witnessed the success of feminist movement since its emergence. People mindset have

Thirdly, the rise in ~~the~~ terrorist activities in the start of 21<sup>st</sup> century forced World leaders and courageous people to take strong and influential action to combat terrorism. These outspoken actions impact the global politics both positively and negatively. The incident of 9/11 (terrorist attack of taliban, Al Quida terrorist organization on US pentagone and hijacking of US flights on 11<sup>th</sup> sept, 2001) enacted the world super power and peace-security organization to initiate a Global war against terrorism. US used carrot and stick policy to unit world with US in this Global war on terror. US president George bush stated that "either you are with us or with the terrorist". A twenty years long war fought between United states of American and Afghan taliban.



The master mind of 9/11 incident Osama bin Laden killed in 2011 but was not ended till 2020. This severe measure at the one place shows bravery to end terrorism from the world and after this was the surge in terrorism is quite not obvious in developed countries. But on the other side, for the developing countries like Pakistan, this was <sup>has</sup> proved a curse. In the 2020-22, the decrease in terrorist activities and extremist events occurred. But the surge in terrorism again started in 2023. The main reason behind it was the Taliban government in Afghanistan. Taliban's government gives the safe heaven to TTP. According to United Nations report 2024, TTP (Tehrik-i Taliban Pakistan) is the largest terrorist group responsible for terrorism in Pakistan. Because by taking military actions terrorist can be killed but the main factor of terrorism - extremism - multiplies. This Global



war on terror focused on just military actions which multiplied hate in local population of Afghanistan and Pakistan also. Thus the courageous action by US changed the global order both in negative and positive way.

Fourthly, the awareness of right of self determination through nationalist movement terminated the British colonial rule. This nationalist movement by world brave, visionary leaders has changed the world governance system. The founder of nationalist movement in America in 1951 is Samuel Adams. Authoritarianism of British colonials in 13 colonies of America ~~fix~~ blew the fire of nationalist movement and brought American Revolution. This revolution is the main force behind 1776 American Independence. This is the first democratic revolution which not only changed the fate of Americans but also initiated nationalist movement



in the Asia and Africa. It also effect French revolution 1789 and Irish revolution of Independence 1919. With the spread of right of self-determination, visionary leaders in subcontinent included Sir Syed Ahmad Khan, Allama Muhammad Iqbal and Quid-e-Azam. fostered nationalist movement in subcontinent. With the efforts of these brave leaders and enthusiasm of muslims Pakistan came into being after the segregation of subcontinent in 1947. Thus the bravery of these men caused the British colonialism to come to an end in the subcontinent. By inspiring from these courageous actions, world joined to end colonial rule. In 1960's, British colonialism ended ultimately all over the world.

Finally, the formation of United Nations from the ashes of world war two to bring peace and security in the world also shaped the Global scenario. Formation of United



Nations in 1945 as the world largest organisation is a big step in promoting world peace to bring global prosperity. UN peacebuilding operations have resolved conflicts in many countries including Rwanda, Namibia, Tajikistan, Egypt, Somalia, Congo and Cambodia peace keeping operations. The United nation SDG goals 2016-2030 also proved very helpful in combating major hurdles in peaceful and sustainable development. These goals includes Poverty reduction, Zero hunger, Renewable energy resources use, protection of life on land and life below land. Thus the courageous action took by international organization also <sup>has</sup> changed the world view and measure to promote development and prosperity.

In Addition there are contemporary issues that need urgent attention from the world community. These includes Israel genocide in Gaza since 7<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2023, Humanitarian but also intited nationalist movement



crises resulting from Ukraine - Russian war, increasing terrorism in third world countries, and climate change problem.
