(1) what is the diff b/w human being's fear of death and Children's fear of darkness?

The fear of death in humans and fear of darkness in children is similar in that they both are influenced by external factors. Children's fear of darkness is increased by hearing the stories of ghost and thieves, while human being's fear of death is increased by hearing stories about the agony of dying man.

(2) what is a religious and sacred view --?
