
SCO Conference In

## 2. Successful SCO Conference Conduction in Islamabad:


Pakistan successfully conducted the Annual Summit of SCO in October-2024.

All the Premiers from members state came and honoured Pakistan except Indian Prime-minister rather they sent

their Foreign Minister to attend the SCO Summit. Two days conference was a success and will bring investments in Pakistan.

## QNo.6 IPP's

### 1: Introduction:-

Independent power producers was mostly installed in 1996, 2001, 2004, 2011, 2014. These power producers draw Pakistan out of energy crises which were worse in 2008-2013. IPP's producing expensive electricity which is resulting in overall hike in energy prices.

Transmission and distribution companies have faulty transmission lines leading to lessening of power distribution. Pakistan is dependent mostly on hydrocarbon fuels for power generation therefore the prices of energy are sky-high. These high prices limits the production units, industries. But the energy crises can be made better by overiewing the agreements between IPP's and Govt, shifting from

## 2: Expensive Agreement with IPP's:-

Pakistan has made many contract with IPP's but these agreements are costing too much to Pakistan. The **production Capacity** of IPP's is 21000 MWH but it is producing and distributing only 6130 MWH. The cost of electricity lost during transmission is also bore by consumers. Government has to revive and over review all these agreement. Pak government has decided to quiet agreement with four Independent Power Producers.

## 3:- Over-whelming Dependency on Fuel for power generation: Pakistan

is producing the most expensive electricity. Pakistan is at number One position in South-Asia for making the most expensive electricity and it is at number 3 in the whole world — which produces the most expensive electricity.

slab 1 Domestic → 1-100 units costs Rs. 28 per unit

slab 2 → 200-300 units Rs 33/unit


slab 3 → 300-400 units Rs-58/unit

The major reason for this most expensive electricity production is complete dependence of hydrocarbons for making electricity. Pakistan is making electricity mainly from Diesel almost 61% power generation is based on Diesel, which is the most

expensive fuel for power generation

#### 4:- Transmission And Distribution Faults:-

National transmission and distribution company (NTDC) and many Discos present in

Pakistan have faulty transmission lines - dissipating much of energy as of no use. That loose of energy is also charged from consumers because IPPs are charging government according to their generation capacity not according to delivered power. Old and faulty transmission and power theft also makes the energy crises worst.

### Σ:- Hike In Electricity

Demand and supply Gap, use of expensive hydrocarbons, power theft, old agreement and faulty transmission are all major factors which are responsible for expensive electricity.

Another major factor is de-stabilized economy and devaluation of Rupee against dollars. Increasing

value of dollar makes raw-material import expensive which ultimately leads to expensive electricity.
