This wide disparity <sup>in education</sup> poses threat to gender equality and hinders women participation in politics, governance, finance,

technology and environmental management. Pakistan economic Survey 2024-25 report shows literacy gap between male and female, 68% and 52.8% respectively.

Therefore, such a wide disparity and gender gap in literacy hinder the process of achieving gender equality through education.

Secondly, the most visible challenge that pose threat in achieving equality through education is the division of the society in two sphere such as Rural and urban sphere. Such a division also leads to educational division. For instance the education system that provide by the state in the urban sphere is far more better than the rural education system. The infrastructure of schools, curriculum and teaching faculty are well equipped than that of
