Major Problems in Pakistan:

Pakistan

is facing the following problems.

1. Population Explosion:

Population explosion

is a growing problem in Pakistan. The rate of increase in population in Pakistan is 2% more than South Asia. The population is booming, 241 million plus in 2023 with growth rate of 2.55%. The population has increased seven-folds since independence.

o Causes:

Following are some causes of increasing population.

- 1- Early Marriages; are playing greater role in population increase. This leads to high fertility rates and more increase in number of people.
- 2- Cultural Norms; are the major cause of explosion in population. Larger the family, the more it is appreciated by society.

Impacts:

1. Depleting Resources:

Causes.
