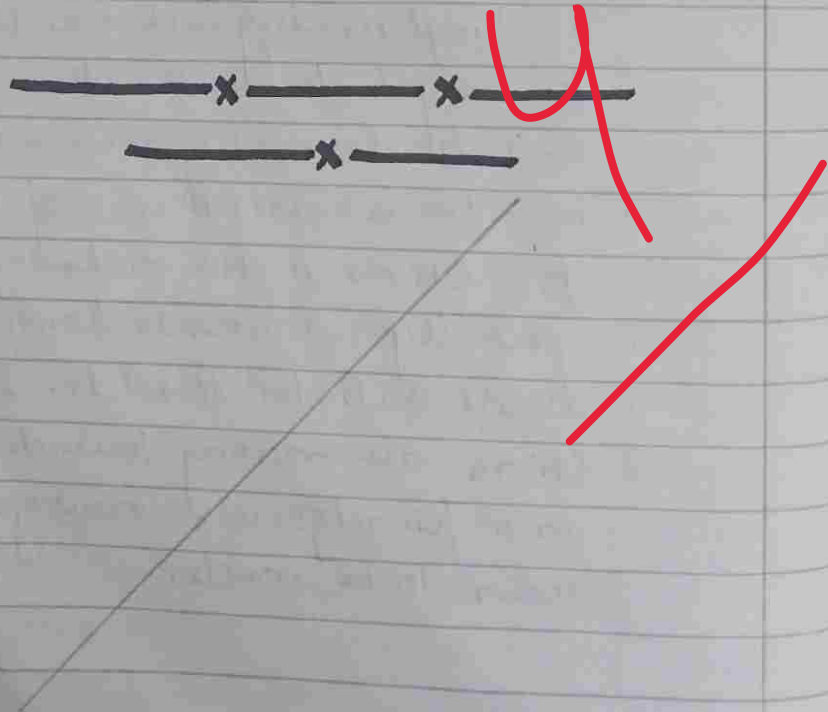
trade tariffs further pose a challenge for China.
