This timeless truth resonates profoundly to Palestinian question where Oppression, Occupation and genocide continue under

global gaze. Despite the lofty ideals of human rights and international Law, the world appears to be a pathetic to Palestinian suffering. While thousands killed in Gaza,

millions displaced and generations robbed of dignity, the silence of international community reveals complicity rather than blindness.

Owing to contemporary policies, great powers politics, balance of power calculations, and economic interdependencies, the world exhibits deliberate blindness to Palestinian sufferings.

The primary reason of World's blindness towards plight of Palestinian is the Western complicity. Chief among them is United States. The US positioned itself as protector of Israel since 1948. It provides \$3 billion annually to Israel's military aid. This amount ^{has} increased to \$13 billion as emergency package, amid Israel's bombardment on Gaza. The Britain also provides financial aid to Israel. The United States backing up Israel on war crimes in Gaza, which reveals deliberate blindness and complicity.

Equally, the normalization of Arab States' relations with Israel weakened

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the overall stance on Palestine. The UAE, Bahrain, Sudan and Oman recognized Israel as a state, open embassies and normalize trade and people-to-people ties. Though Saudi Arab did not officially recognize Israel but it also provided airspace for Israel. Justifying under "Abrahamic religion" and stating that the Jews and Muslims has been kins than rivals, historically. Under the immense public pressure UAE and Bahrain scale down diplomatic relations with Israel but Egypt and Jordan, being US allies, did not openly support. This shows their negligence towards Palestinians suffering because of their interests.

Another dimension of the

World's blindness to plight of Palestinians is prioritizing trade security over human security. The Hamas-Israel war disrupts shipping lanes in Red Sea and Persian Gulf. The 20% of the global oil ships pass there on which Asia-Europe and Asia-North America trade depends. Therefore protecting sea routes is more important for them than addressing Palestinian sufferings. Thus, plight of Palestinians is ignored not because it is not evident but on purpose.

Moreover, the world's blindness can also be seen as Western double standards on human

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rights. When Russia invade Ukraine, the US imposed Sanctions on Russia and condemn this act. Also, When China was alleged of crimes in Uyghurs, Western leaders invoke human rights rhetoric. However, When Israel commits war crimes in Gaza, the Western leaders were mute or they defended Israel, calling it self defence. This reveals how world shows selective morality according to the geopolitical convenience.

Furthermore, the world's deliberate ignorance can also be assessed through case study of Hamas - Israel conflict. When Hamas attack

Israel by launching 5,000 rockets on Israel's intelligence bases. This act was called terrorism by West without considering the Israel's occupation and Palestine grievances. This exhibits that West portraying wrong context deliberately to protect Israel's war crimes and its stance on the conflict of Hamas-Israel.

Also, the World's "ignorance" can be judged by the case study of Israel's violation of human rights. After the Hamas attack on Israel, the Israel did extreme war crimes in Gaza: bombing

every school, turned hospitals into graveyards and killed millions including children and women. The footages and reports of these incidents were shown to world through traditional and digital media and people protested against the genocide everywhere. However, the Western leaders specially US president, Donald Trump, called it self-defence while it was clearly violation of human rights as Palestinians were deprived of basic life necessities like, food, shelter, electricity, water and internet representing world's largest open prison - Gaza.

Of course, one can argue

the blindness towards the Plight of Palestinians is simply constrained of realpolitik. Nations, after all, act based on the national interest not moral sympathies. Countries like Pakistan which are dependent on US aid, IMF bailouts and loans have to prioritize their country. Similarly, Arab monarchies are also dependent on America for security umbrella to deter Iran. But, all these reasons cannot justify silence on Israel's war crimes in Gaza. This is nothing but pragmatic approach leading to injustice. Prioritizing oil, trade, and security over human lives is nothing

but injustice.

However, to cater these crisis, essential steps are required. Firstly, global civil society should pressurize governments through boycotts and advocacy like anti-apartheid movement in South Africa. Secondly, Multilateral forums like OIC need to transform from rhetoric body to coordinated bloc. The UNSC needs reforms to prevent US veto abuse on Palestinian issues. Thirdly, Muslim world need to reconcile internal divisions and prioritize Palestine cause. Finally, academic media and civil society should continue to show sufferings of people in Palestine to masses.

To sum up, indeed, the

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World is blind towards the plight of Palestinians, because of contemporary politics, balance of power politics and economic interests. This blindness is not accidental but manufactured. Despite overwhelming evidence of Israel's war crimes, the world remains hostage to its great political powers. Yet, public protests indicate morality still exists among masses if not among elites. As Nelson Mandela once said, "We know too well that our freedom is incomplete without the freedom of Palestinians."
