Challenges faced by women

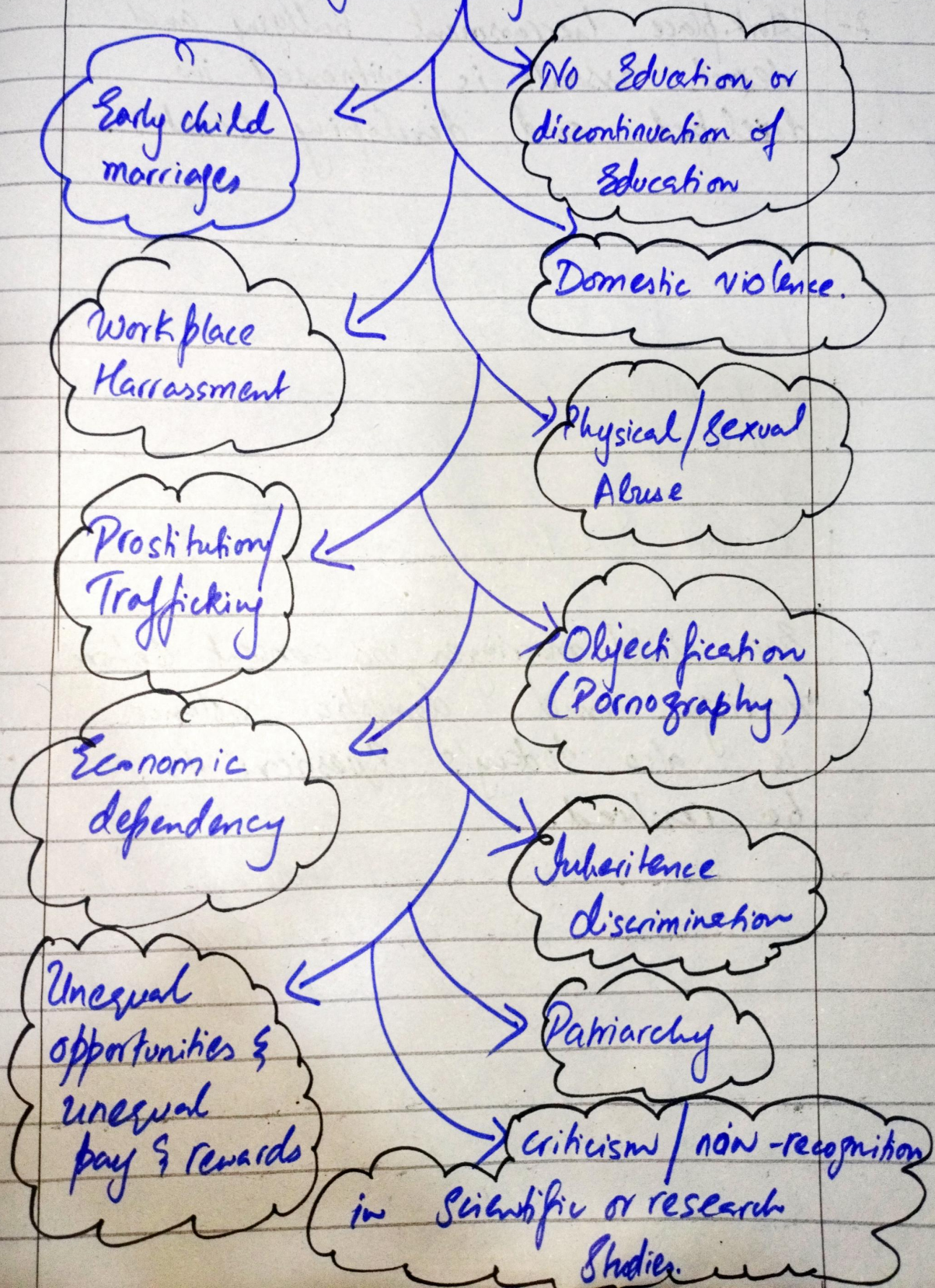
Today

“... we have sent thy for the whole mankind...”

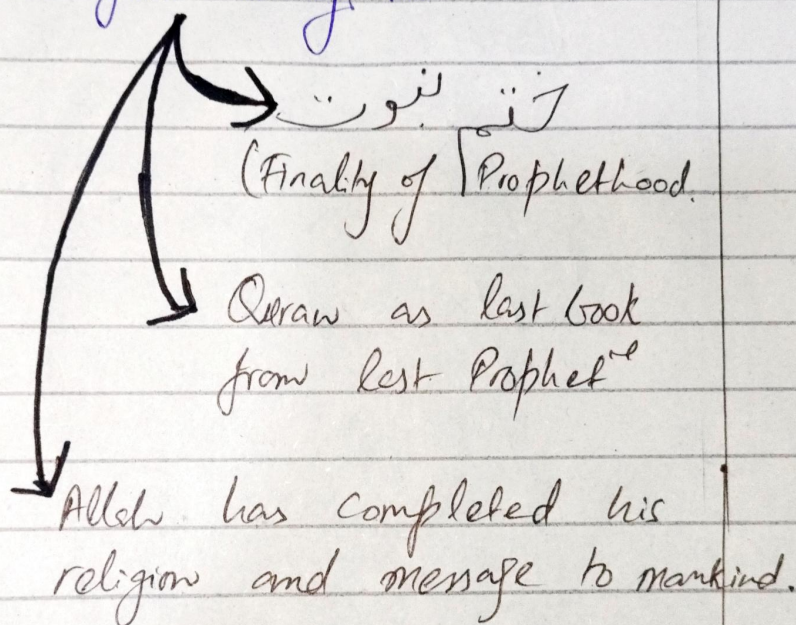

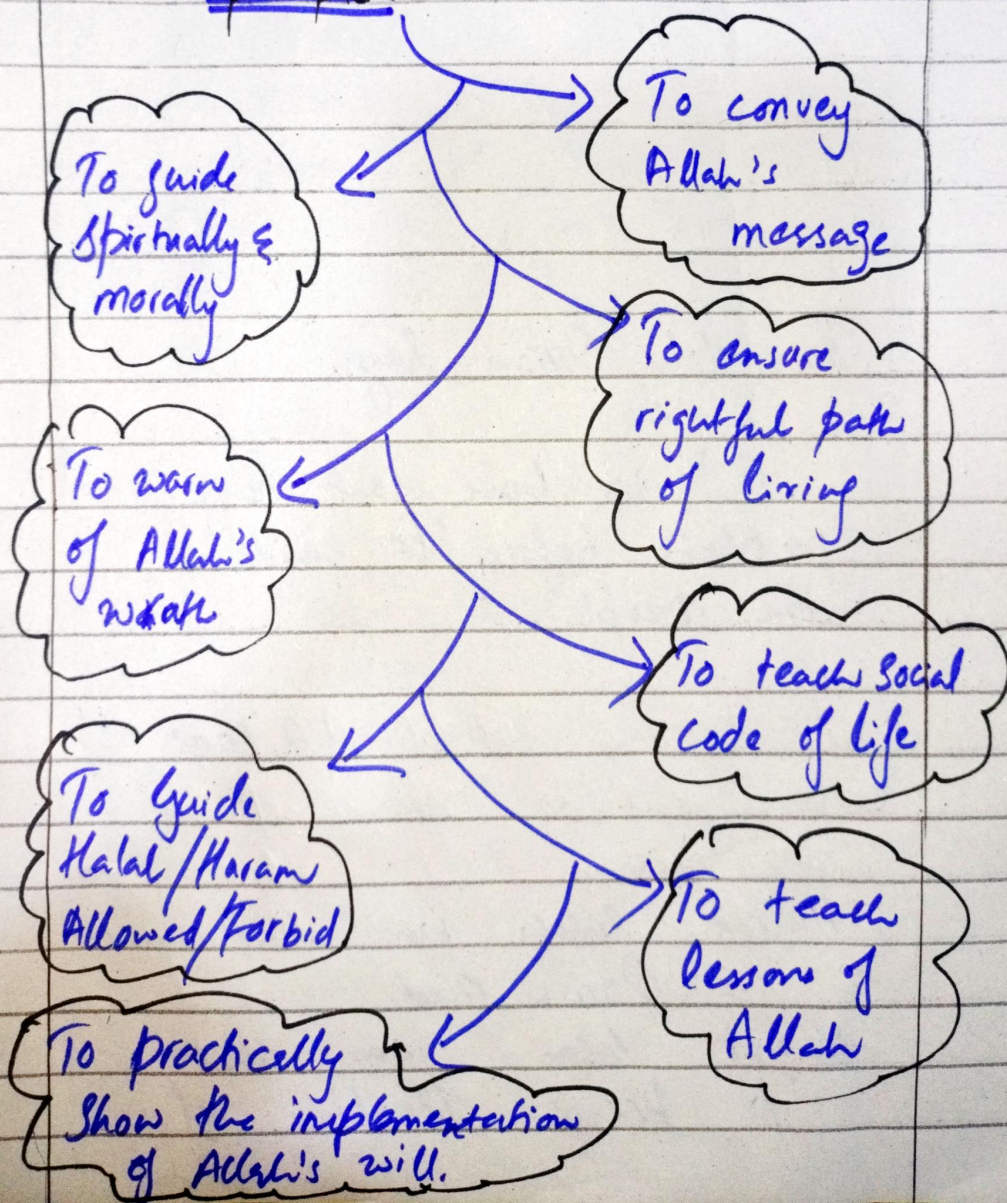
Hazrat Muhammad SAWW was sent to convey Allah's message to every corner of the world. He was sent as mercy and blessing.
