When he ^{ran} was out of argument, he cunningly questioned the wrong wearing style of the shirt of his opponent and this strategy lead him to victory in the case. Similarly, there are numerous examples where the political leaders are pointed out. President Eisenhower was raised concern about his health in the 1956 elections. Franklin Roosevelt in 1944 was also attacked in a similar manner but he was attacked even in a more vicious manner.
