1 Rising Sectarianism

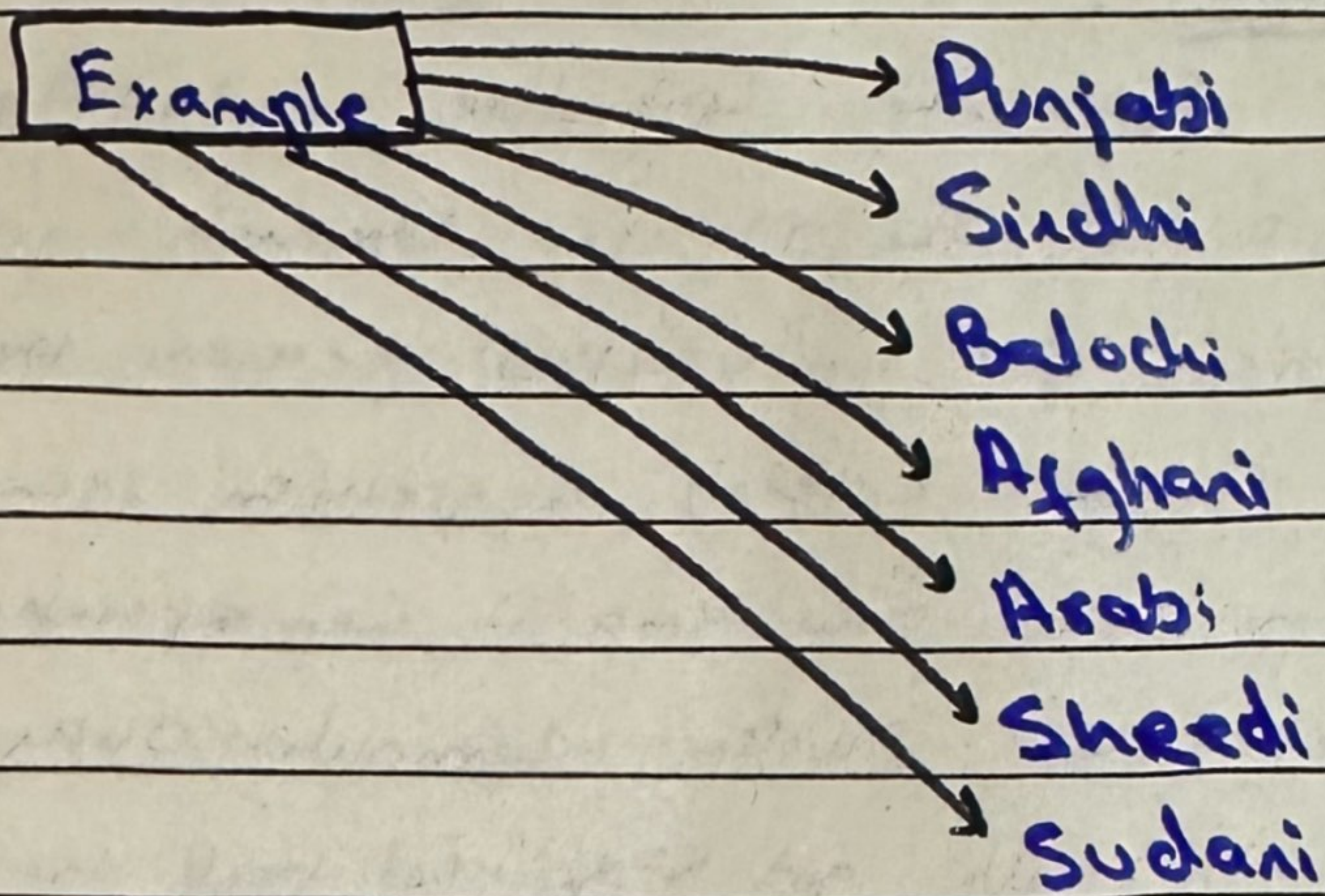

Muslim Ummah is divided based

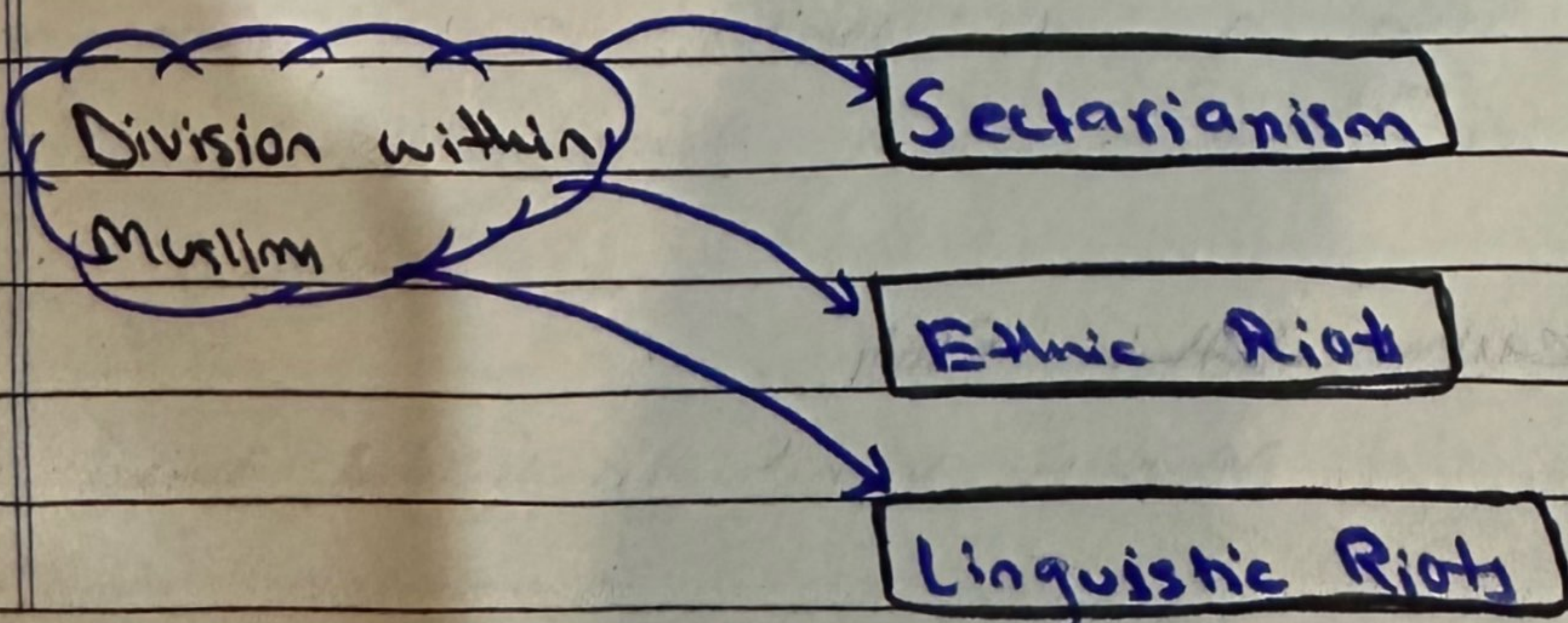
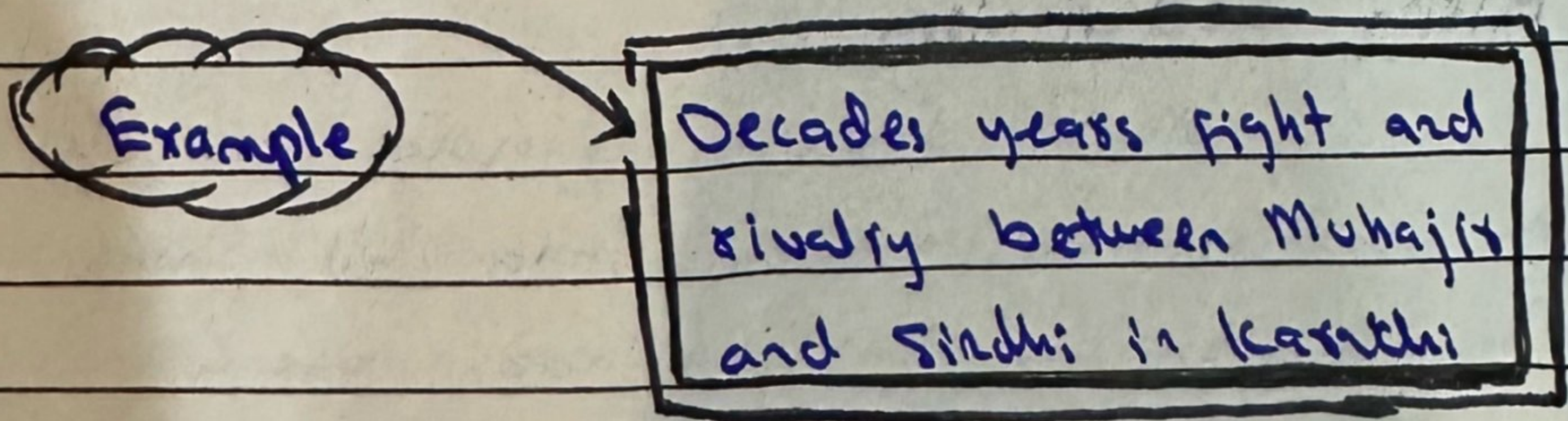
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different ethnicity, that has further aggravated the and fractured the Muslim status in the international level.

Question 5 Rights and Status of Women

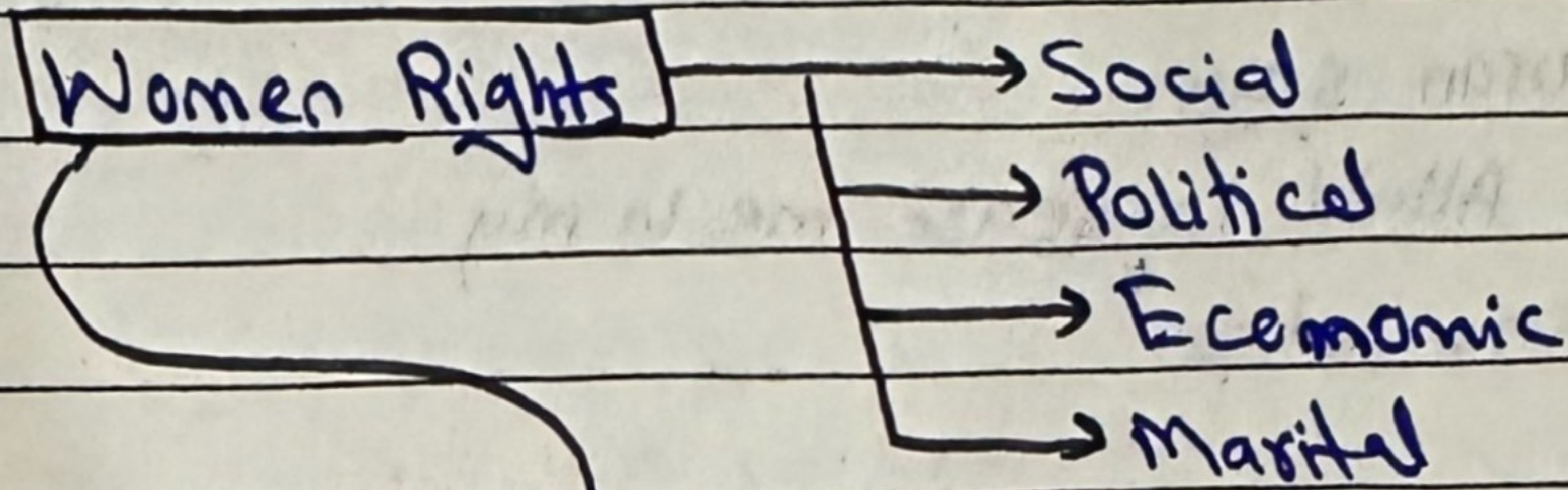
1. Introduction

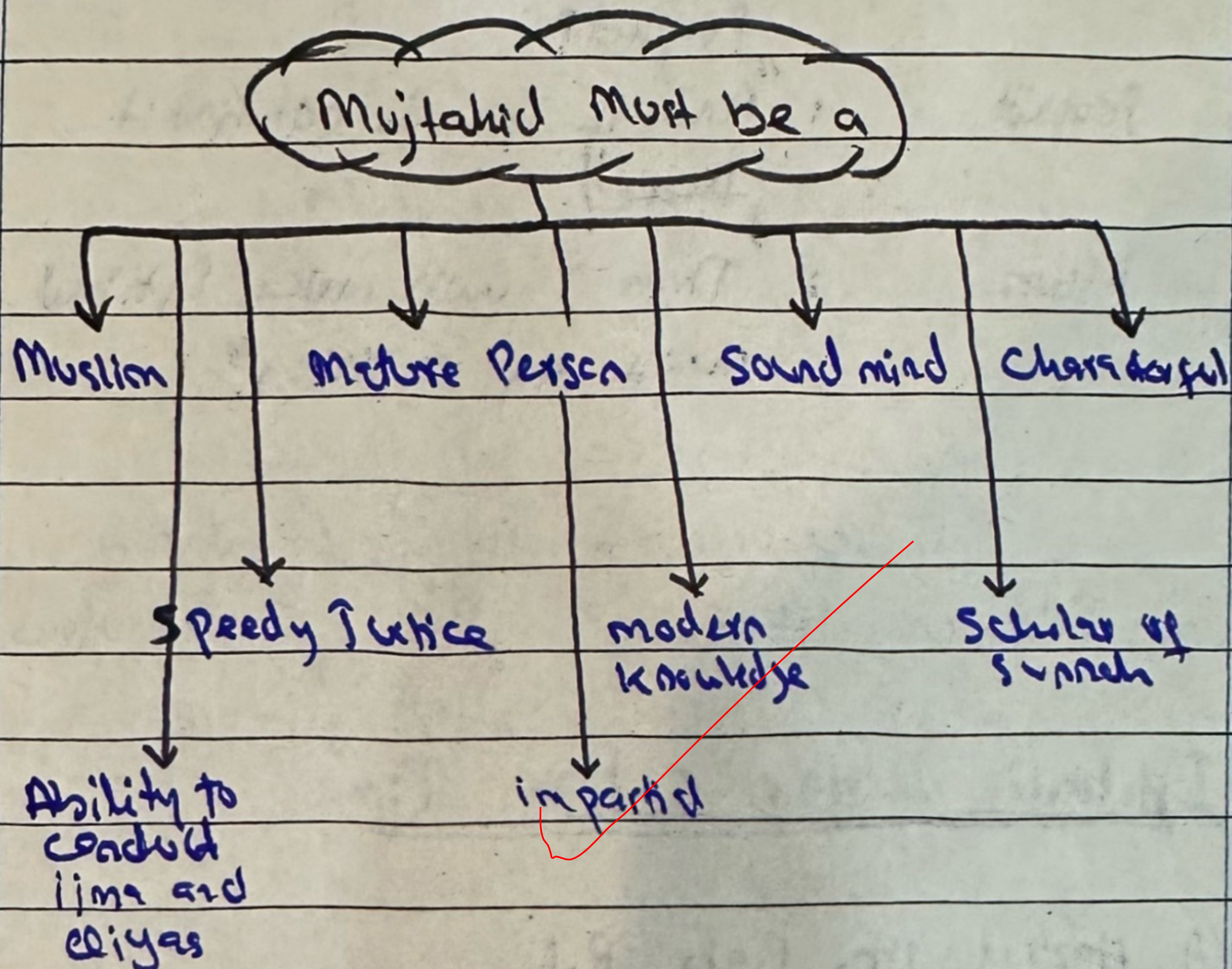
